This small log structure faced east on the west side of Hipsley Mill Road, located in what is now the Patuxent State Park. The log house was once a two story high, three bay wide (central batten wood door flanked by single windows), one room per floor structure. Two second floor windows were vertically aligned to those of the first floor. Now only the stone foundation of the original structure remains.

The E. front is three bays in length with the centered door of batten design. Directly above the ground floor windows are 2 windows minus their sash.

An A roofed later wing stands to the W. elevation. The foundations of the original structure is of stone.

Practically destroyed by vandals.
