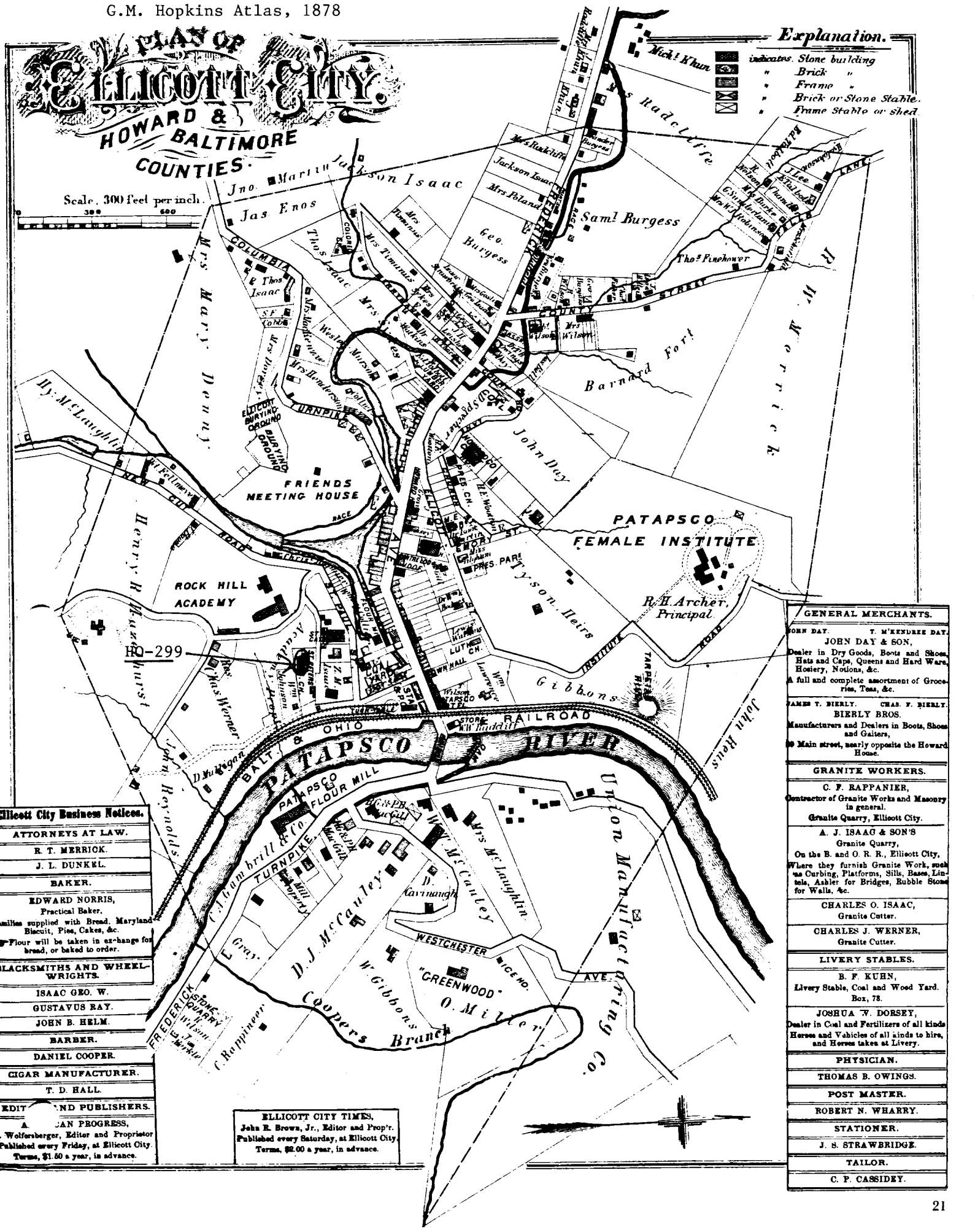
PLAN OF ELLICOTT CITY.

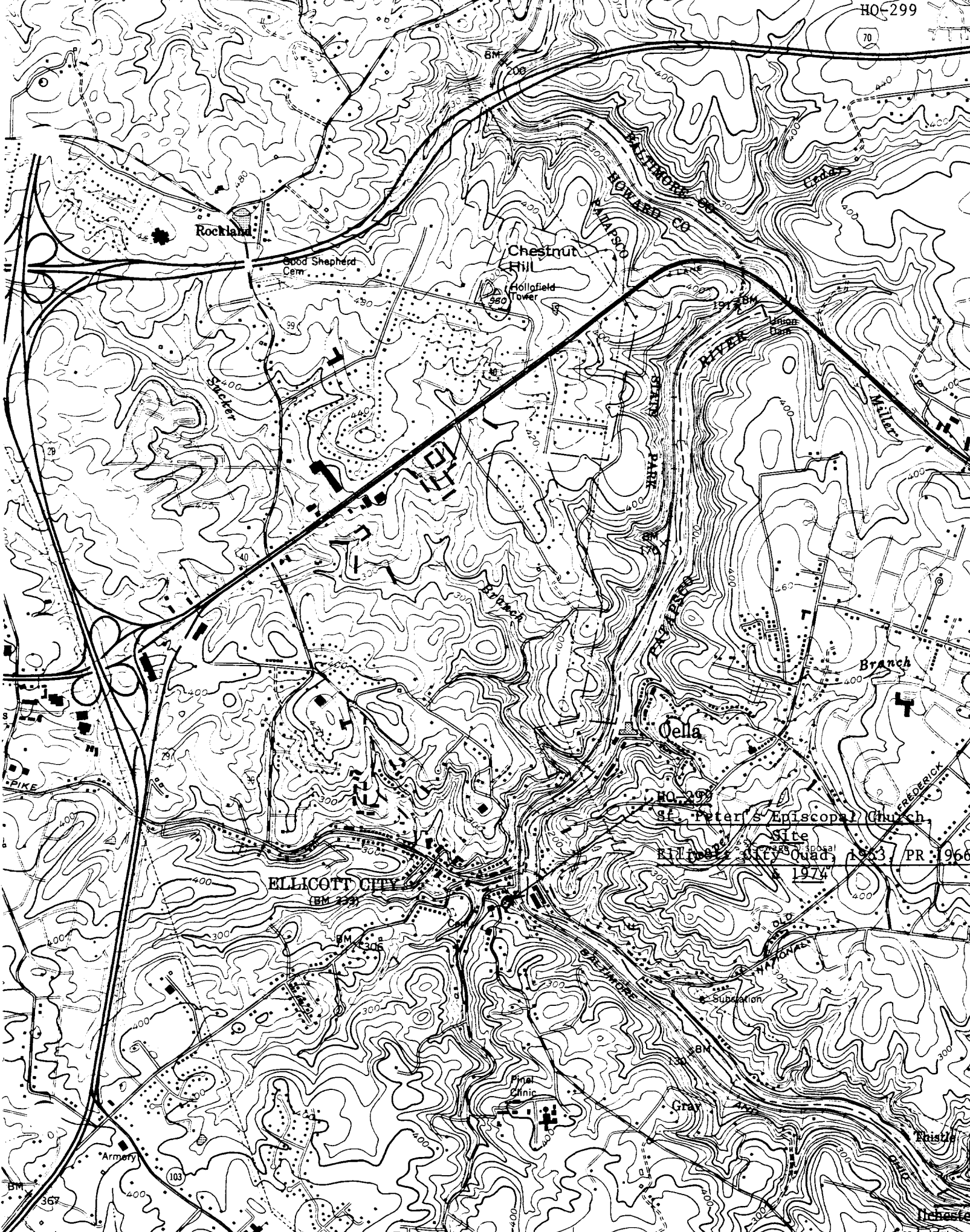
