**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Quilford Log Cabin faces west on the east side of Oakland Mills Road, 2/10 of a mile from its intersection with Route 32. It is a three bay wide, one room deep, two story high, gabled roof (running north-south) log, covered by clapboard and asbestos shingles, structure, with wide brick chimney inset into its north wall. A one story high, one bay wide, one room deep, gabled roof (running north-south) frame addition, resting on a stone foundation, extends north from the north wall of the two story high building.

Fenestration is rectangular vertically aligned, and double-hung, holding six-over-six lights, flanked by flat pilasters and surmounted by flat wooden lintels. The windows are underlined by narrow, projecting, wooden sills.

The building is now boarded up, but a central entrance door is discernible on the west elevation, flanked by windows, similar to those described, which are revealed on the second floor. The east side of the south wall has been uncovered, revealing the original log construction.

A wooden shed lies immediately east of the house.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Guilford Log Cabin is significant to Howard County, the State of Maryland and the nation in two areas.

First, it is architecturally significant to the Guilford area as one of its few log buildings, believed to have been constructed circa 1864. Another log house is located on the west side of Oakland Mills Road, almost opposite to this building, while still another, the Old Rectory at Christ Church, HO-519, is located on the southwest corner of Berger and Oakland Mills Road and stands within an industrial park.

North of the Guilford Log Cabin is located the elementary school, and still north of that, a low income housing area is being constructed. All of this is within the Guilford Redevelopment Area, proposed by the Office of Planning and Zoning. With the development of low income, high density dwelling units in the area, coupled with the large industrial park which lies north, the placement of such a structure on this State-local inventory of historic sites is imperative, and, should the owners so desire, an additional placement on the National Register of Historic Places would also be most beneficial to insure the building's future.

Historically, its most recent use was as the home of Samuel J. Busick for over 20 years. Estella Busick later, on September 22, 1967, acquired the property (518-536) and still owns it.

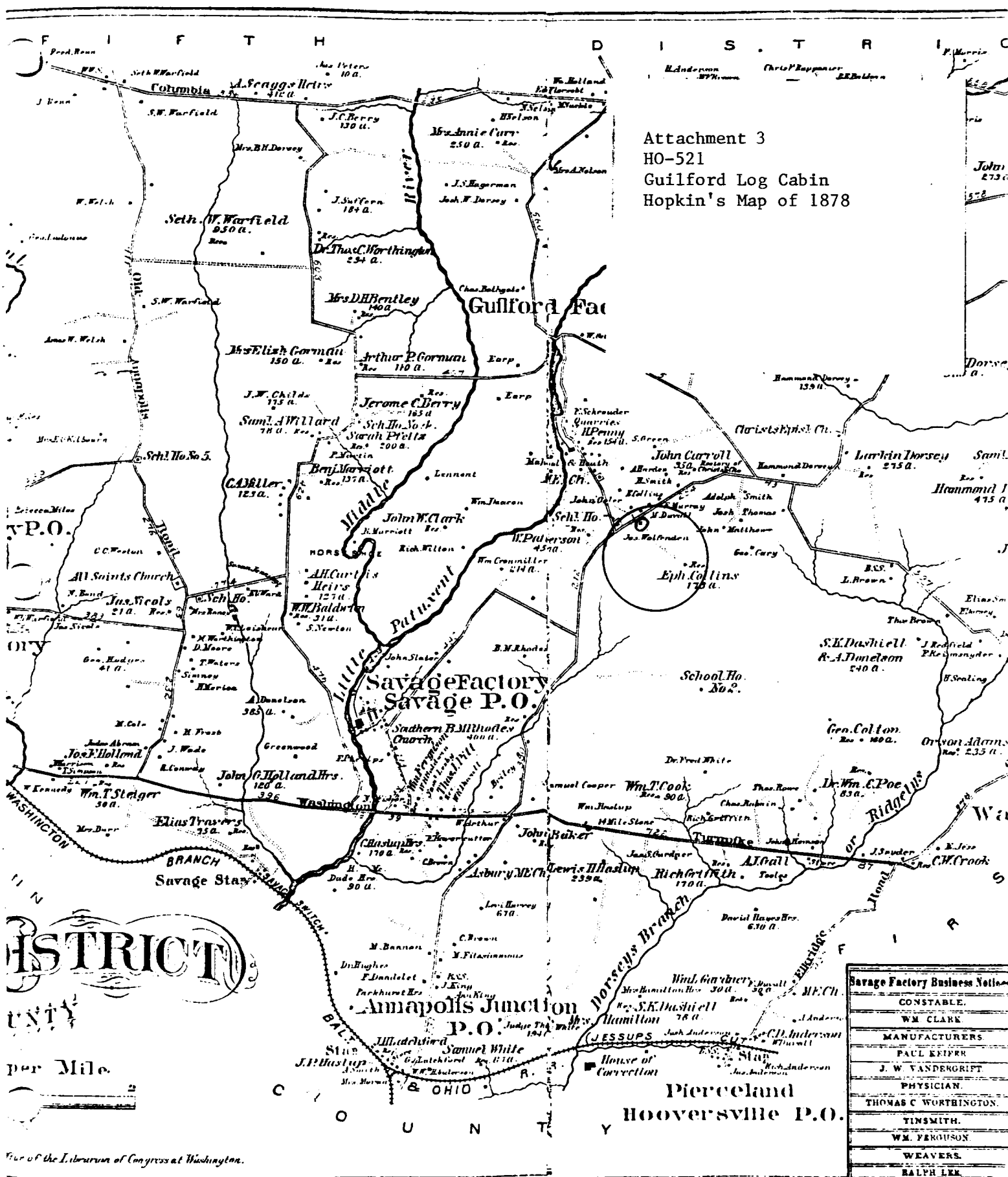

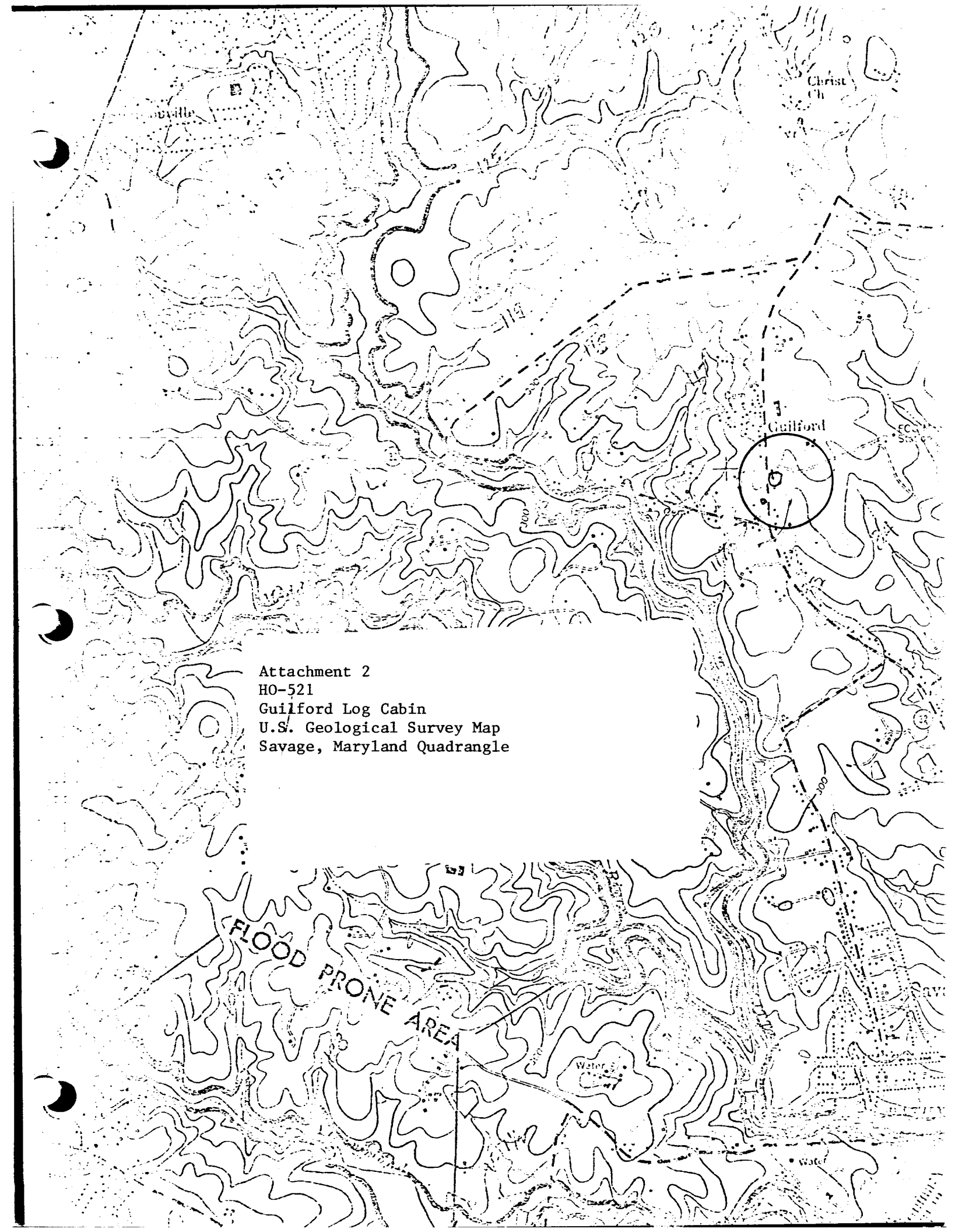
