Section 7.1

The Anderson Farm is located on Long Corner Road about a mile from the Patuxent River on the Howard County side. The farm is reached by taking a long dirt access road that leads to two properties; one is a private house to the left, and to the right is the Anderson Farm. This property contains many farm buildings in good condition that span in age from the mid nineteenth century such as the farmhouse, corn crib, bank barn, stone barn, and spring house; as well as buildings from the mid twentieth century such as the grain silos, dairy barns, tin and wood sheds, and concrete block garage. The main farmhouse is L-shaped, two stories tall, and has porch additions on both the front (west) facade and the side (south) facade. The foundation is stone with the exceptions of the porch additions which have concrete block foundations. Wood shingles painted white cover the entire farmhouse structure. Another notable structure on the farm is the bank barn which has a stone foundation and wood framing on the upper level, but on the lower level has concrete block construction where dairy milking took place. The large number of structures located within such close proximity to one another indicates that this was a very active and profitable farm in the community.









RESOURCE SKETCH MAP





