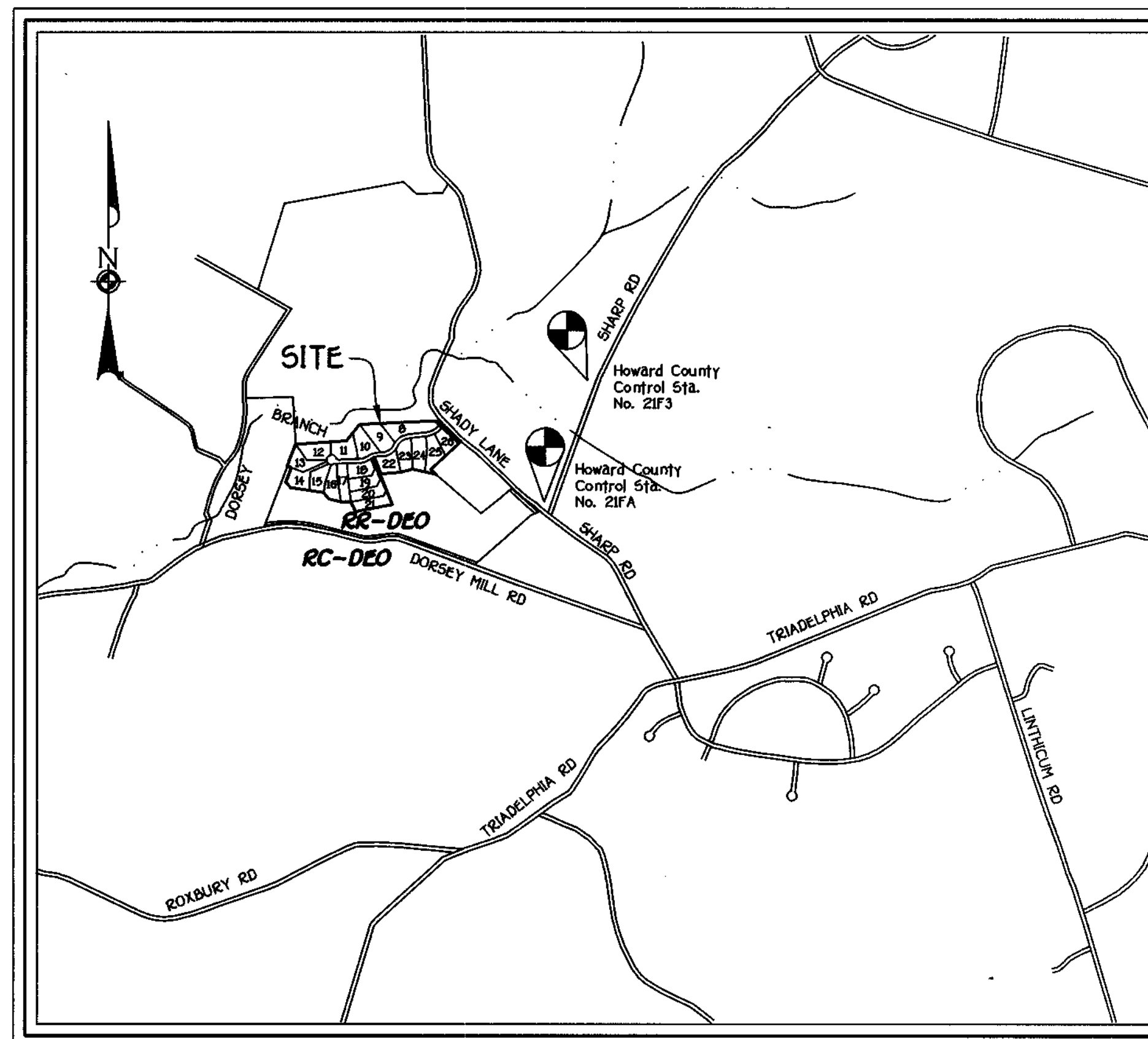

**SHADY LANE AND WINDRIDGE COURT PLAN, PROFILES AND ROADWAY DETAILS**

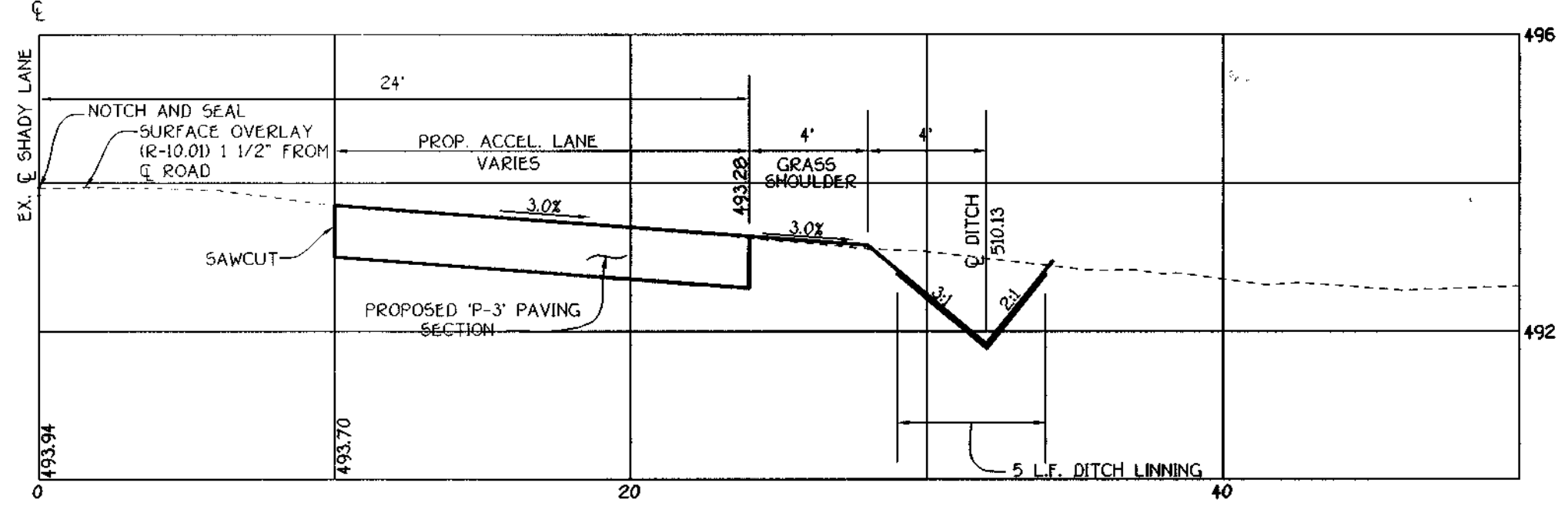

All overlaps whether for repairs or for joining two pieces of geotextile shall be a minimum of one foot.
- Stones for the rip-rap or gabion outlets may be placed by equipment. 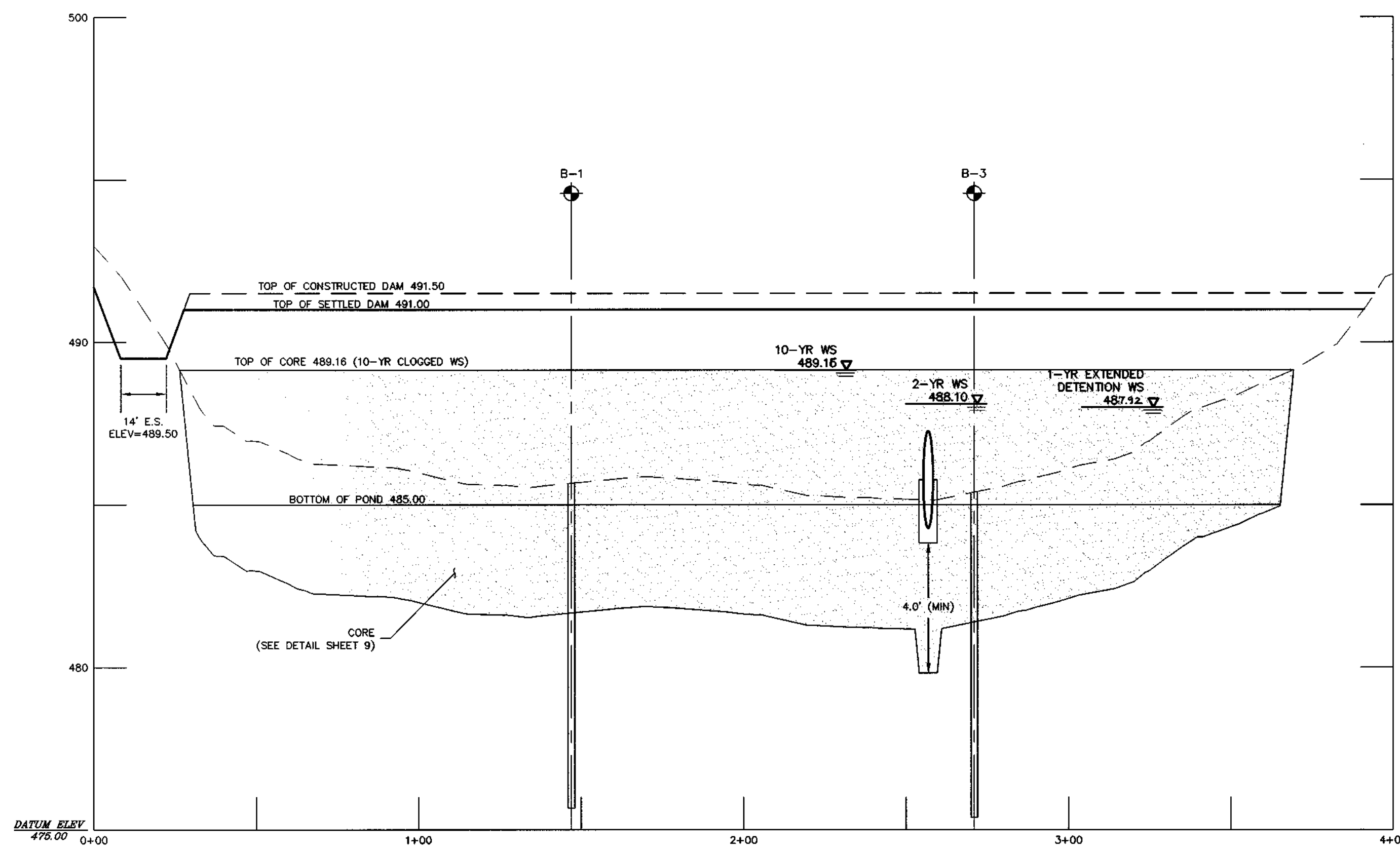

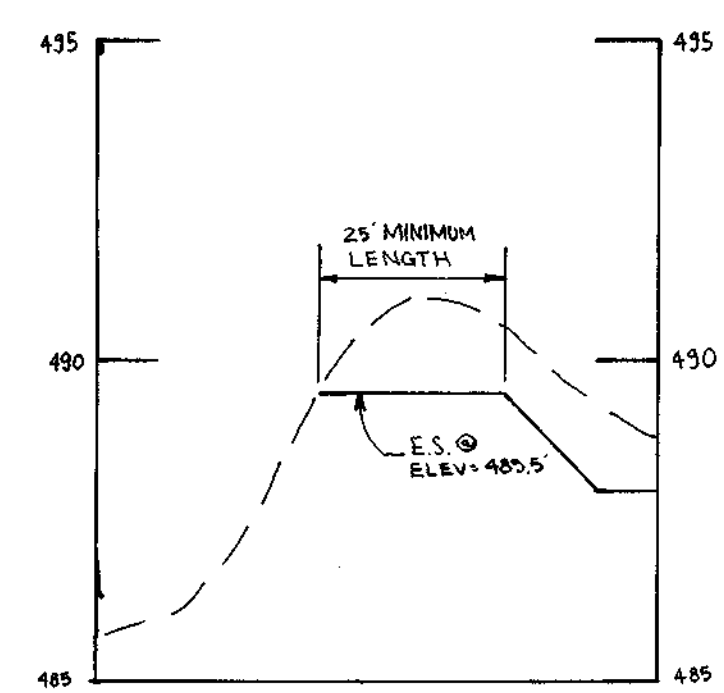

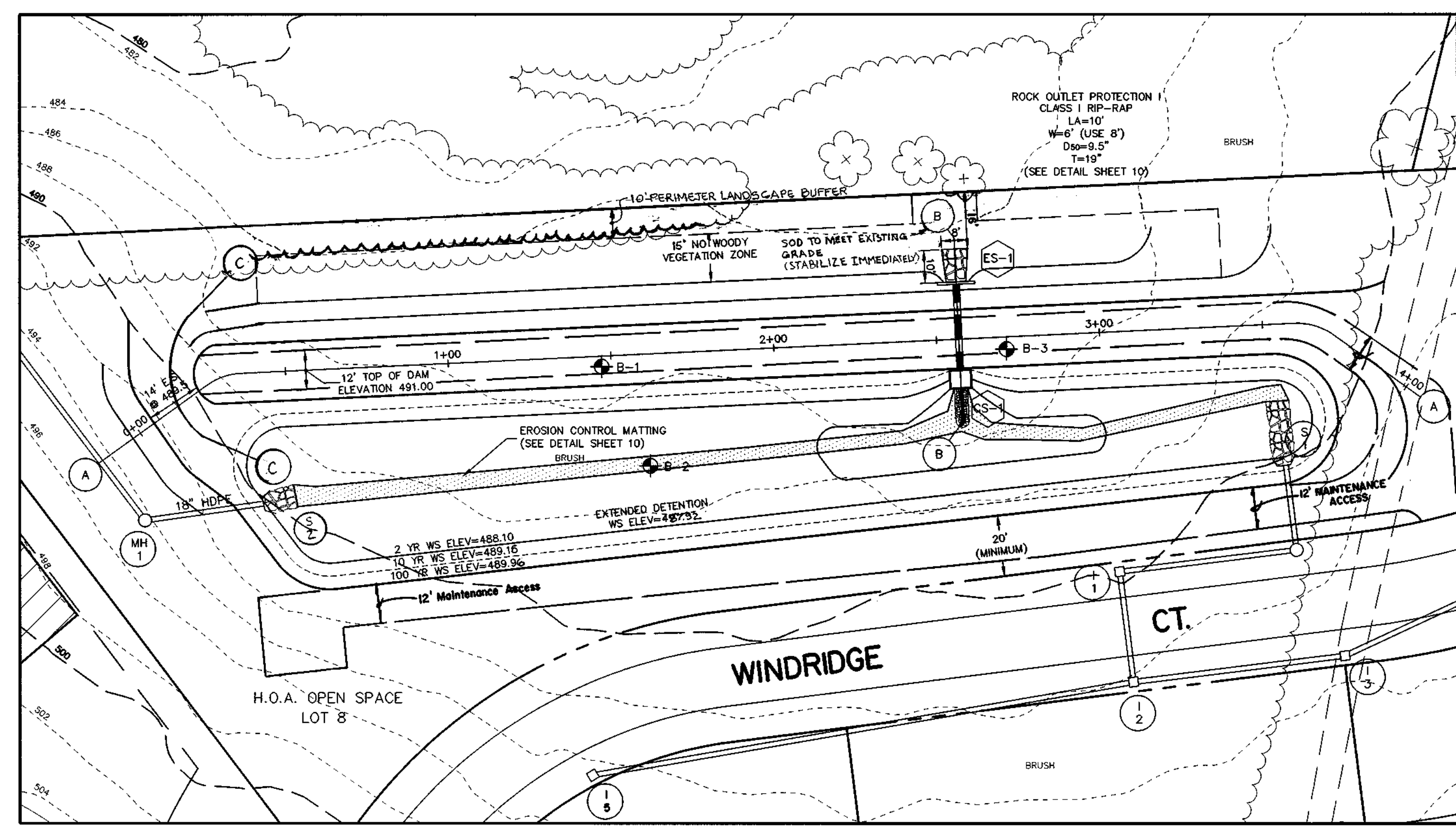
**CENTERLINE EMBANKMENT PROFILE (A-A)**

CONSIDERATION MAY BE GIVEN TO THE USE OF OTHER MATERIALS IN THE EMBANKMENT IF DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION ARE SUPERVISED BY A GEOLOGICAL ENGINEER.

PLACEMENT- AREAS ON WHICH FILL IS TO BE SHALL BE SCARIFIED PRIOR TO PLACEMENT OF FILL. FILL MATERIALS SHALL BE PLACED IN MAXIMUM 8 INCH THICK (BEFORE COMPACTION) LAYERS WHICH ARE TO BE CONTINUOUS OVER THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF THE FILL. THE MOST PERMEABLE BORROW MATERIAL SHALL BE PLACED IN THE DOWNSTREAM PORTIONS OF THE EMBANKMENT. THE PRINCIPAL SPILLWAY MUST BE INSTALLED CONCURRENTLY WITH FILL PLACEMENT AND NOT EXCAVATED INTO THE EMBANKMENT.

COMPACTION- THE MOVEMENT OF AND SPREADING EQUIPMENT OVER THE FILL SHALL BE CONTROLLED SO THAT THE ENTIRE SURFACE OF EACH LIFT SHALL BE TRAVERSED BY NOT LESS THAN ONE TREAD TRACK OF THE EQUIPMENT OR COMPACTION SHALL BE ACHIEVED BY A MINIMUM OF FOUR COMPLETE PASSES OF A SHEEPSFOOT, RUBBER TIRE OR VIBRATORY ROLLER. FILL MATERIAL SHALL CONTAIN SUFFICIENT MOISTURE SUCH THAT THE REQUIRED DEGREE OF COMPACTION WILL BE OBTAINED WITH THE EQUIPMENT USED. THE FILL MATERIAL SHALL CONTAIN SUFFICIENT MOISTURE SO THAT IF FORMED INTO A BALL IT WILL NOT CRUMBLE YET NOT BE SO WET THAT WATER CAN BE SQUEEZED OUT.

WHERE A MINIMUM REQUIRED DENSITY IS SPECIFIED, IT SHALL NOT BE LESS 95% OF MAXIMUM DRY DENSITY WITH A MOISTURE CONTENT WITHIN 2% OF THE OPTIMUM. EACH LAYER OF FILL SHALL BE COMPACTED AS NECESSARY TO OBTAIN THAT DENSITY, AND IS TO BE CERTIFIED BY THE ENGINEER AT THE TIME OF CONSTRUCTION. ALL COMPACTION IS TO BE DETERMINED BY AASHTO METHOD T-99.

CUT OFF TRENCH- THE CUFF OFF TRENCH SHALL BE EXCAVATED INTO IMPERVIOUS MATERIAL ALONG OR PARALLEL TO THE CENTERLINE OF THE EMBANKMENT AS SHOWN ON THE PLANS. THE BOTTOM WIDTH OF THE TRENCH SHALL BE GOVERNED BY THE EQUIPMENT USED FOR EXCAVATION, WITH THE MINIMUM WIDTH BEING FOUR FEET. THE DEPTH SHALL BE AT LEAST FOUR FEET BELOW EXISTING GRADE OR AS SHOWN ON THE PLANS. THE SIDE SLOPES OF THE TRENCH SHALL BE 1 TO 1 OR FLATTER. THE BACKFILL SHALL BE COMPACTED WITH CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT, ROLLERS, OR HAND TAMPERS TO ASSURE MAXIMUM DENSITY AND MINIMUM PERMEABILITY.

## STRUCTURE BACKFILL

BACKFILL ADJACENT TO PIPES OR STRUCTURES SHALL BE OF THE TYPE AND QUALITY CONFORMING TO THAT SPECIFIED FOR THE ADJOINING FILL MATERIAL. THE FILL MATERIAL SHALL BE PLACED IN HORIZONTAL LAYERS NOT TO EXCEED FOUR INCHES IN THICKNESS AND COMPACTED BY HAND TAMPERS OR OTHER MANUALLY DIRECTED COMPACTION EQUIPMENT. THE MATERIAL NEEDS TO FILL COMPLETELY ALL SPACES UNDER AND ADJACENT TO THE PIPE. AT NO TIME DURING THE BACKFILLING OPERATION SHALL DRIVEN EQUIPMENT BE ALLOWED TO OPERATE CLOSER THAN FOUR FEET, MEASURED HORIZONTALLY, TO ANY PART OF A STRUCTURE. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL EQUIPMENT BE DRIVEN OVER ANY PART OF A CONCRETE FILL OF 24" OR GREATER OVER THE STRUCTURE OR PIPE.

## PIPE CONDUITS

ALL PIPES SHALL BE CIRCULAR IN CROSS SECTION.

CORRUGATED METAL PIPE- ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA SHALL APPLY FOR CORRUGATED METAL PIPE:

1. MATERIALS- (STEEL PIPE)- THIS PIPE AND ITS APPURTENANCES SHALL BE GALVANIZED AND FULLY BITUMINOUS COATED AND SHALL CONFORM TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF AASHTO SPECIFICATION M-190 TYPE A WITH WATER TIGHT COUPLING BANDS. ANY BITUMINOUS COATING DAMAGED OR OTHERWISE REMOVED SHALL BE REPLACED WITH COLD APPLIED BITUMINOUS COATING COMPOUND. STEEL PIPES WITH POLYMERIC COATINGS SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM COATING THICKNESS OF 0.01 INCH (10 MIL) ON BOTH SIDES OF THE PIPE. THE FOLLOWING COATINGS OR AN APPROVED EQUAL MAY BE USED: NEXON PLASTI-COTE, BLAC-KLAD, AND BETH-CU-LOY. COATED CORRUGATED STEEL PIPE SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF AASHTO M-245 AND M-246.

MATERIALS- (ALUMINUM COATED STEEL PIPE)- THIS PIPE AND ITS APPURTENANCES SHALL CONFORM TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF AASHTO SPECIFICATION M-190 WITH WATER TIGHT COUPLING BANDS OR FLANGES. ALUMINUM SURFACES THAT ARE TO BE IN CONTACT WITH CONCRETE SHALL BE PAINTED WITH ONE COAT OF ZINC CHROMATE PRIMER. HOT DIP GALVANIZED BOLTS MAY BE USED FOR CONNECTIONS. THE PH OF THE SURROUNDING SOILS SHALL BE BETWEEN 4 AND 9.

MATERIALS- (ALUMINUM PIPE)- THIS PIPE AND ITS APPURTENANCES SHALL CONFORM TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF AASHTO SPECIFICATION M-196 OR M-211 WITH WATER TIGHT COUPLING BANDS OR FLANGES. ALUMINUM SURFACES THAT ARE TO BE IN CONTACT WITH CONCRETE SHALL BE PAINTED WITH ONE COAT OF ZINC CHROMATE PRIMER. HOT DIP GALVANIZED BOLTS MAY BE USED FOR CONNECTIONS. THE PH OF THE SURROUNDING SOILS SHALL BE BETWEEN 4 AND 9.

2. COUPLING BANDS, ANTI-SEEP COLLARS, END SECTIONS, ETC., MUST BE COMPOSED OF THE SAME MATERIAL AS THE PIPE. METALS MUST BE INSULATED FROM DISSIMILAR MATERIALS WITH USE RUBBER OR PLASTIC INSULATING MATERIALS AT LEAST 24 MILS IN THICKNESS.

3. CONNECTIONS- ALL CONNECTIONS WITH PIPES MUST BE COMPLETELY WATER TIGHT. THE DRAIN PIPE OR BARREL CONNECTION TO THE RISER SHALL BE WELDED ALL AROUND WHEN THE PIPE AND RISER ARE METAL. ANTI-SEEP COLLARS SHALL BE CONNECTED TO THE PIPE IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO BE COMPLETELY WATER TIGHT. DIMPLE BANDS ARE NOT CONSIDERED TO BE WATER TIGHT.

ALL CONNECTIONS SHALL USE A RUBBER OR NEOPRENE GASKET WHEN JOINING PIPE SECTIONS. THE END OF EACH PIPE SHALL BE ROLLED AND ADEQUATE NUMBER OF CORRUGATIONS TO ACCOMMODATE THE BAND WIDTH. THE FOLLOWING ARE ACCEPTABLE FOR PIPE LESS THAN 24" IN DIAMETER: FLANGES ON BOTH ENDS OF THE PIPE, A 12" WIDE STANDARD LAP TYPE BAND WITH 3/8" THICK CLOSED CELL CIRCULAR NEOPRENE GASKET; AND A 12" WIDE HUGGER TYPE BAND WITH O-RING GASKETS EXCEEDING THE MINIMUM DIAMETER OF 1/2" GREATER THAN THE CORRUGATION DEPTH. 24" IN DIAMETER AND LARGER SHALL BE CONNECTED BY A 24" LONG ANNULAR CORRUGATED BAND USING RODS AND LUGS. A 12" WIDE BY 3/8" THICK CLOSED CELL CIRCULAR NEOPRENE GASKET WILL BE INSTALLED ON THE END OF EACH PIPE FOR A TOTAL OF 24".

HELICAL CORRUGATED PIPE SHALL HAVE EITHER CONTINUOUSLY WELDED SEAMS OR HAVE LOCK SEAMS WITH INTERNAL CAULKING OR A NEOPRENE BEAD.

4. BEDDING- THE PIPE SHALL BE FIRMLY AND UNIFORMLY BEDDED THROUGHOUT ITS ENTIRE LENGTH. WHERE ROCK OR SOFT, SPONGY OR OTHER UNSTABLE SOIL IS ENCOUNTERED, ALL SUCH MATERIAL SHALL BE REMOVED AND REPLACED WITH SUITABLE EARTH COMPACTED TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE SUPPORT.

5. BACKFILLING SHALL CONFORM TO "STRUCTURE BACKFILL."

6. OTHER DETAILS (ANTI-SEEP COLLARS, VALVES, ETC.) SHALL BE AS SHOWN ON THE DRAWINGS.

REINFORCED CONCRETE PIPE- ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA SHALL APPLY FOR REINFORCED CONCRETE PIPE:

1. MATERIALS- REINFORCED CONCRETE PIPE SHALL HAVE BELL AND SPIGOT JOINTS WITH RUBBER GASKETS AND SHALL EQUAL OR EXCEED ASTM DESIGNATION C-361.

2. BEDDING- ALL REINFORCED CONCRETE PIPE CONDUITS SHALL BE LAID IN A CONCRETE BEDDING FOR THEIR ENTIRE LENGTH. THIS BEDDING SHALL CONSIST OF HIGH SLUMP CONCRETE PLACED UNDER THE PIPE AND UP THE SIDES OF THE PIPE AT LEAST 10% OF ITS OUTSIDE DIAMETER WITH A MINIMUM THICKNESS OF 3 INCHES, OR AS SHOWN ON THE DRAWINGS.

3. LAYING PIPE- BELL AND SPIGOT PIPE SHALL BE PLACED WITH THE BELL END UPSTREAM. JOINTS SHALL BE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MANUFACTURER'S RECOMMENDATIONS. AFTER THE JOINTS ARE SEALED FOR THE ENTIRE LINE, THE BEDDING SHALL BE PLACED SO THAT ALL SPACES UNDER THE PIPE ARE FILLED. CARE SHALL BE EXERCISED TO PREVENT ANY DEVIATION FROM THE ORIGINAL LINE AND GRADE OF THE PIPE. THE FIRST JOINT MUST BE LOCATED WITHIN 2 FEET FROM THE RISER.

4. BACKFILLING SHALL CONFORM TO "STRUCTURE BACKFILL."

5. OTHER DETAILS (ANTI-SEEP COLLARS, VALVES, ETC.) SHALL BE AS SHOWN ON THE DRAWINGS.

POLYVINYL CHLORIDE (PVC) PIPE- ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA SHALL APPLY FOR POLYVINYL CHLORIDE (PVC) PIPE:

1. MATERIALS- PVC PIPE SHALL BE PVC-1120 OR PVC-1220 CONFORMING TO ASTM D-1785 OR ASTM D-2241.

2. JOINTS AND CONNECTIONS TO ANTI-SEEP COLLARS SHALL BE COMPLETELY WATER TIGHT.

3. BEDDING- THE PIPE SHALL BE FIRMLY AND UNIFORMLY BEDDED THROUGHOUT ITS ENTIRE LENGTH. WHERE ROCK OR SOFT, SPONGY OR OTHER UNSTABLE SOIL IS ENCOUNTERED, ALL SUCH MATERIAL SHALL BE REMOVED AND REPLACED WITH SUITABLE EARTH COMPACTED TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE SUPPORT.

4. BACKFILLING SHALL CONFORM TO "STRUCTURE BACKFILL."

5. OTHER DETAILS (ANTI-SEEP COLLARS, VALVES, ETC.) SHALL BE AS SHOWN ON THE DRAWINGS.

## CONCRETE

CONCRETE SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MATERIALS, SECTION 905.

THE RIPRAP SHALL BE PLACED TO THE REQUIRED THICKNESS IN ONE OPERATION. THE ROCK SHALL BE DELIVERED AND PLACED IN MANNER THAT WILL INSURE THE RIPRAP IN PLACE SHALL BE REASONABLY HOMOGENEOUS WITH THE LARGER ROCKS UNIFORMLY DISTRIBUTED AND FIRMLY IN CONTACT ONE TO ANOTHER WITH THE SMALLER ROCKS FILLING THE VOIDS BETWEEN THE LARGER ROCKS. FILTER CLOTH SHALL BE REPLACED UNDER ALL CIRCUMSTANCES TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MATERIALS, SECTION 919.12.

## CARE OF WATER DURING CONSTRUCTION

ALL WORK ON THE PERMANENT STRUCTURES SHALL BE CARRIED OUT IN AREAS FREE FROM WATER. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN ALL TEMPORARY DIKES, LEVEES, COFFERDAMS, DRAINAGE CHANNELS, AND STREAM DIVERSIONS NECESSARY TO PROTECT THE AREAS TO BE OCCUPIED BY THE PERMANENT WORKS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ALSO FURNISH, INSTALL, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN ALL NECESSARY PUMPING AND OTHER EQUIPMENT REQUIRED FOR REMOVAL OF WATER FROM THE VARIOUS PARTS OF THE WORK AND FOR MAINTAINING THE EXCAVATIONS, FOUNDATION AND OTHER PARTS OF THE WORK FREE FROM WATER AS REQUIRED OR DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER FOR CONSTRUCTING EACH PART OF THE WORK. AFTER HAVING SERVED THEIR PURPOSE, ALL TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE WORKS SHALL BE REMOVED OR LEVELED AND GRADED TO THE EXTENT REQUIRED TO PREVENT OBSTRUCTION TO THE FLOW OF WATER. THE REMOVAL OF WATER FROM THE REQUIRED EXCAVATION AND THE FOUNDATION SHALL BE ACCOMPLISHED IN A MANNER AND TO THE EXTENT THAT WILL MAINTAIN STABILITY OF THE EXCAVATED SLOPES AND BOTTOM OF THE REQUIRED EXCAVATIONS AND WILL ALLOW SATISFACTORY PERFORMANCE OF ALL AND CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS. DURING THE PLACING AND COMPACTION OF MATERIAL IN REQUIRED EXCAVATIONS, THE WATER LEVEL AT THE LOCATIONS BEING REFILLED SHALL BE MAINTAINED BELOW THE BOTTOM OF THE EXCAVATION AT SUCH LOCATIONS WHICH MAY REQUIRE DRAINING THE WATER TO PUMPS FROM WHICH THE WATER SHALL BE PUMPED.

## STABILIZATION

ALL BORROW AREAS SHALL BE GRADED TO PROVIDE PROPER DRAINAGE AND LEFT IN A SLIGHTLY CONDITION. ALL EXPOSED SURFACES OF THE EMBANKMENT, SPILLWAY, SPILL AND BORROW AREAS, AND BERMS SHALL BE STABILIZED BY SEEDING, LIMING, FERTILIZING AND MULCHING IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MARYLAND SOIL CONSERVATION SERVICE STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR CRITICAL AREA PLANTING (MD-342) OR AS SHOWN ON THE ACCOMPANYING DRAWINGS.

## EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL

CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS WILL BE CARRIED OUT IN SUCH A MANNER THAT EROSION WILL BE CONTROLLED AND WATER AND AIR POLLUTION MINIMIZED. STATE AND LOCAL LAWS CONCERNING POLLUTION ABATEMENT WILL BE FOLLOWED. CONSTRUCTION PLANS SHALL DETAIL EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES TO BE EMPLOYED DURING THE CONSTRUCTION PROCESS.

## SWM POND MAINTENANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. SILT SHALL BE REMOVED WHEN ACCUMULATION EXCEEDS SIX (6) INCHES IN BASINS WITHOUT FOREBAYS. IN BASIN WITH FOREBAYS, SILT SHALL BE REMOVED WHEN THE ACCUMULATION EXCEEDS FOUR (4) INCHES IN THE FOREBAY.
2. ACCUMULATED GRASS, TRASH AND DEBRIS SHALL BE REMOVED AS NECESSARY.
3. VEGETATION GROWING ON THE EMBANKMENT TOP AND FACES IS NOT ALLOWED TO EXCEED 18 INCHES IN HEIGHT AT ANY TIME.
4. ANNUAL INSPECTION AND REPAIR, IF REQUIRED, OF THE STRUCTURE SHALL BE PERFORMED.

## OPERATION, MAINTENANCE AND INSPECTION

INSPECTION OF THE POND(S) SHOWN HEREON SHALL BE PERFORMED AT LEAST ANNUALLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CHECKLIST AND REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED WITHIN USDA, SOCS "STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR PONDS" (MD-378). THE POND OWNER(S) AND THE HEIRS SUCCESSORS OR ASSIGNS SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SAFETY OF THE POND AND THE CONTINUED OPERATION, SURVEILLANCE, INSPECTION AND ALL ROUTINE AND NON-ROUTINE MAINTENANCE THEREON. THE POND OWNER(S) SHALL PROMPTLY NOTIFY THE SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT OF ANY UNUSUAL OBSERVATIONS THAT MAY BE INDICATIONS OF DISTRESS SUCH AS EXCESSIVE SEEPAGE, TURBID SEEPAGE, SLIDING OR SLUMPING.

## SWM POND MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

### ROUTINE MAINTENANCE:

1. FACILITY SHALL BE INSPECTED ANNUALLY AND AFTER ALL MAJOR STORMS. INSPECTIONS SHALL BE PERFORMED DURING WET WEATHER TO DETERMINE IF THE POND IS FUNCTIONING PROPERLY.
2. TOP AND SIDE SLOPES OF THE EMBANKMENT SHALL BE MOWED A MINIMUM OF TWO (2) TIMES PER YEAR, ONCE IN JUNE AND ONCE IN SEPTEMBER. OTHER SIDE SLOPES AND MAINTENANCE ACCESS SHALL BE MOWED AS NEEDED.
3. DEBRIS AND LITTER SHALL BE REMOVED DURING REGULAR MOWING OPERATIONS AS NEEDED.
4. VISIBLE SIGNS OF EROSION ON THE POND, RIP-RAP, OR GABION OUTLET AREA SHALL BE REPAIRED AS SOON AS IT IS NOTICED.

### NON-ROUTINE MAINTENANCE:

1. STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS OF THE POND (DAM, RISER, AND PIPES) SHALL BE REPAIRED UPON THE DETECTION OF ANY DAMAGE. THE COMPONENTS SHALL BE INSPECTED DURING ROUTINE MAINTENANCE OPERATIONS.
2. SEDIMENT SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE POND AND/OR FOREBAY, WHEN ONE HALF THE TOTAL CAPACITY OF THE POND AND/OR FOREBAY IS FULL OF SEDIMENT, OR DEEMED NECESSARY FOR AESTHETIC REASONS, UPON APPROVAL FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

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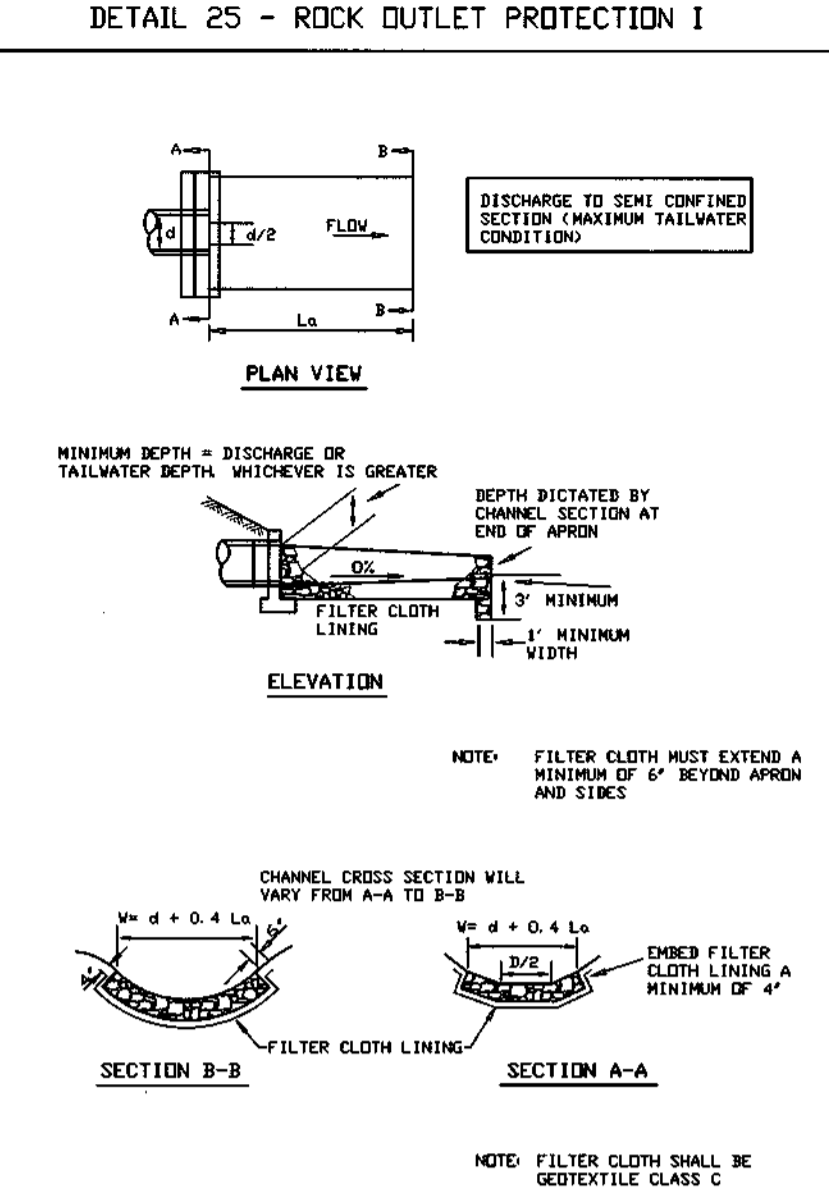
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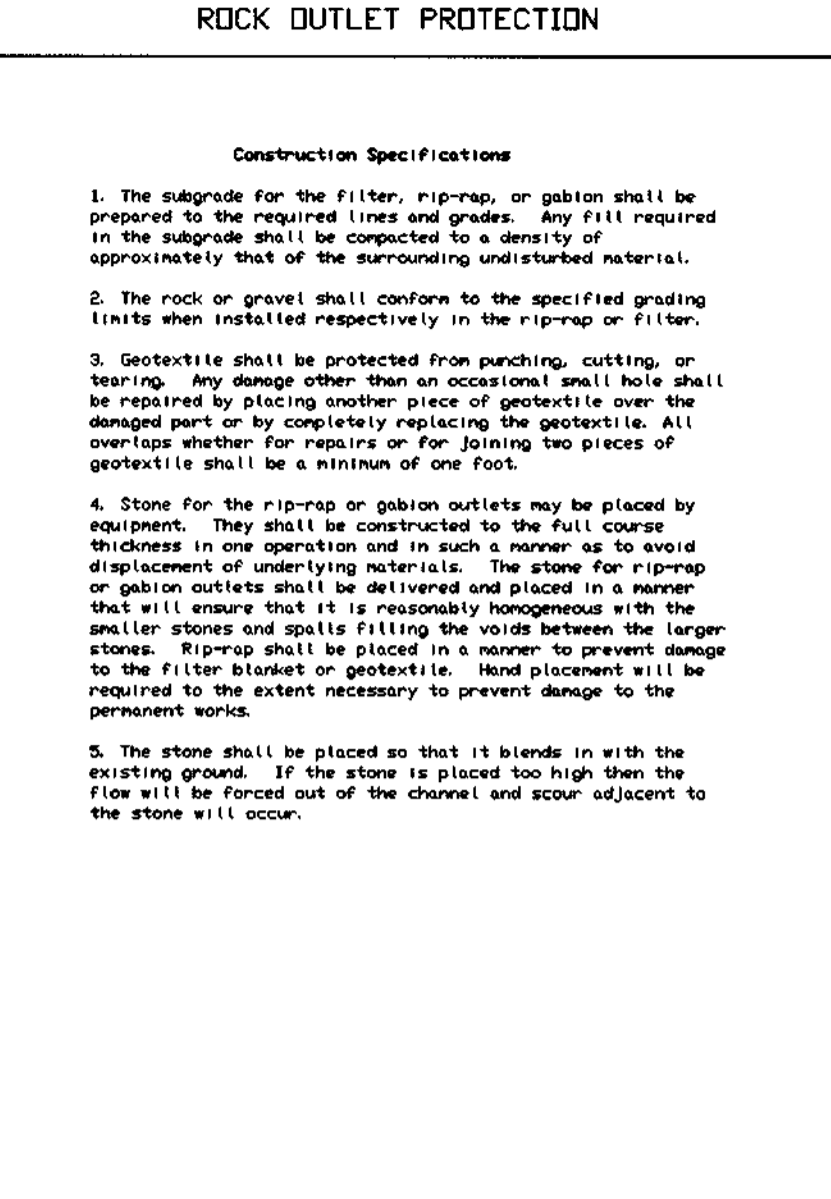
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## DETAIL 25 - ROCK OUTLET PROTECTION I



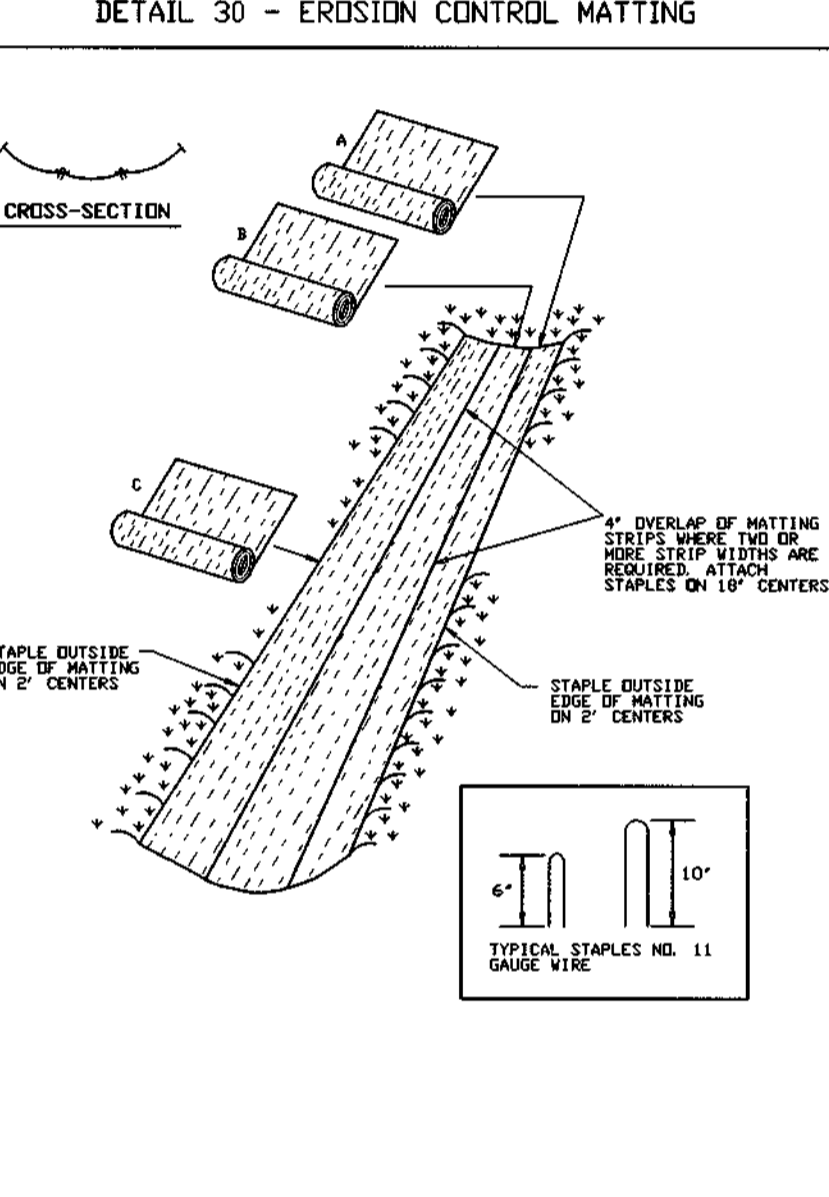

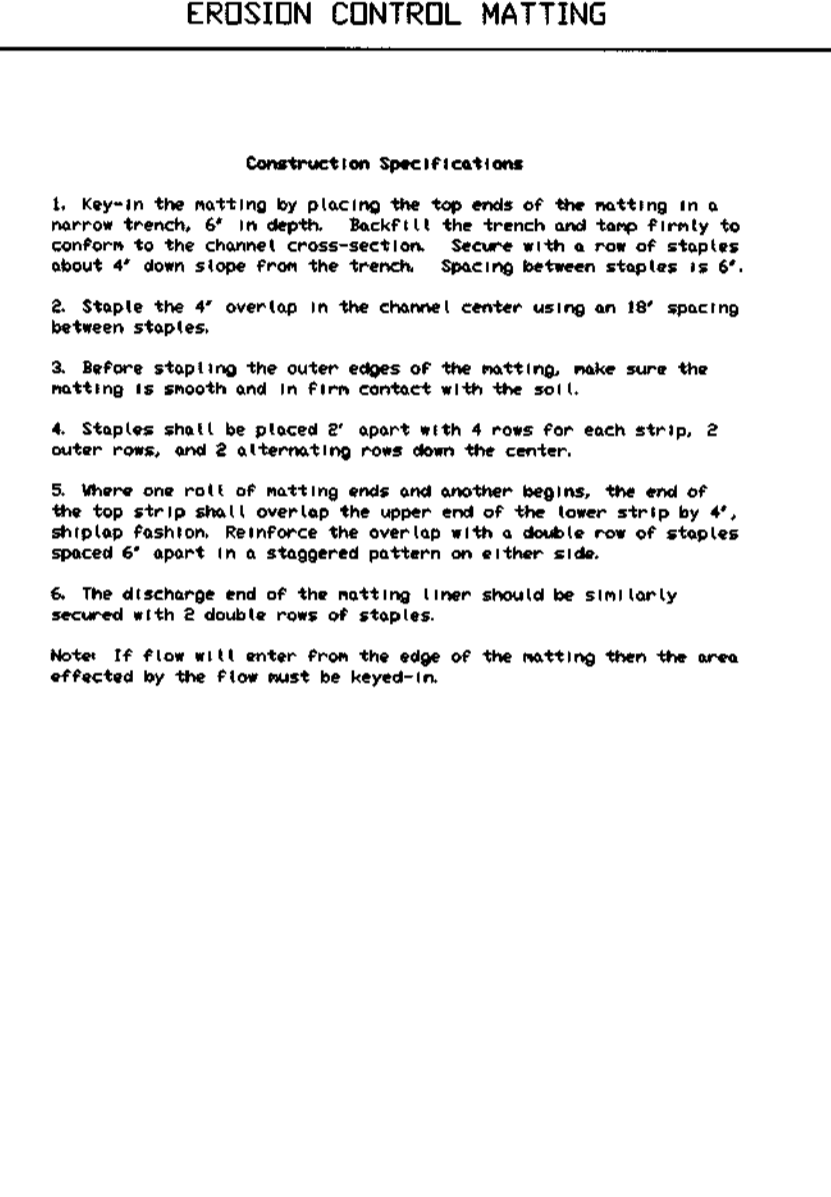

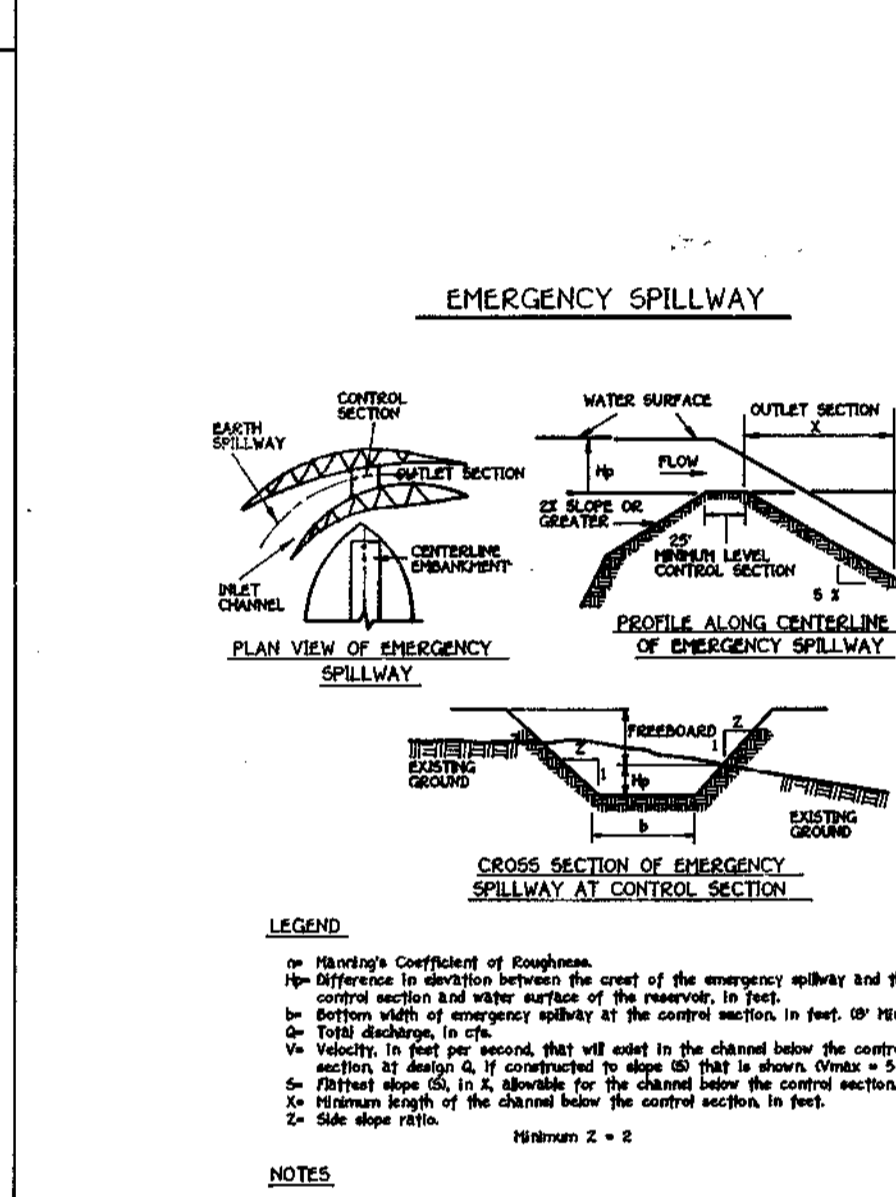

- Construction Specifications**
- Length - minimum of 50' (<math>\leq 30'</math> for single residence lot).
  - Width - 10' minimum, should be floored at the existing road to provide a turning radius.
  - Geotextile fabric (filter cloth) shall be placed over the existing ground prior to placing stone. The plan approval authority may not require single family residence to use geotextile.
  - Stone - crushed aggregate (<math>2' < 3'</math>) or reclaimed or recycled concrete equivalent shall be placed at least 6" deep over the length and width of the entrance.

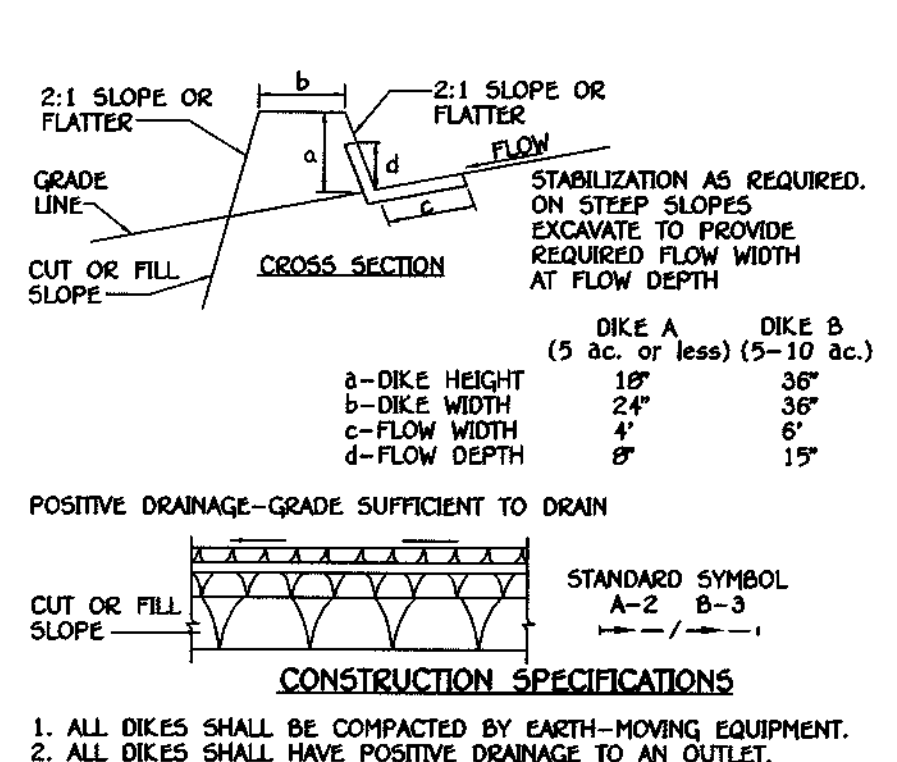
**STABILIZED CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCE - 2**

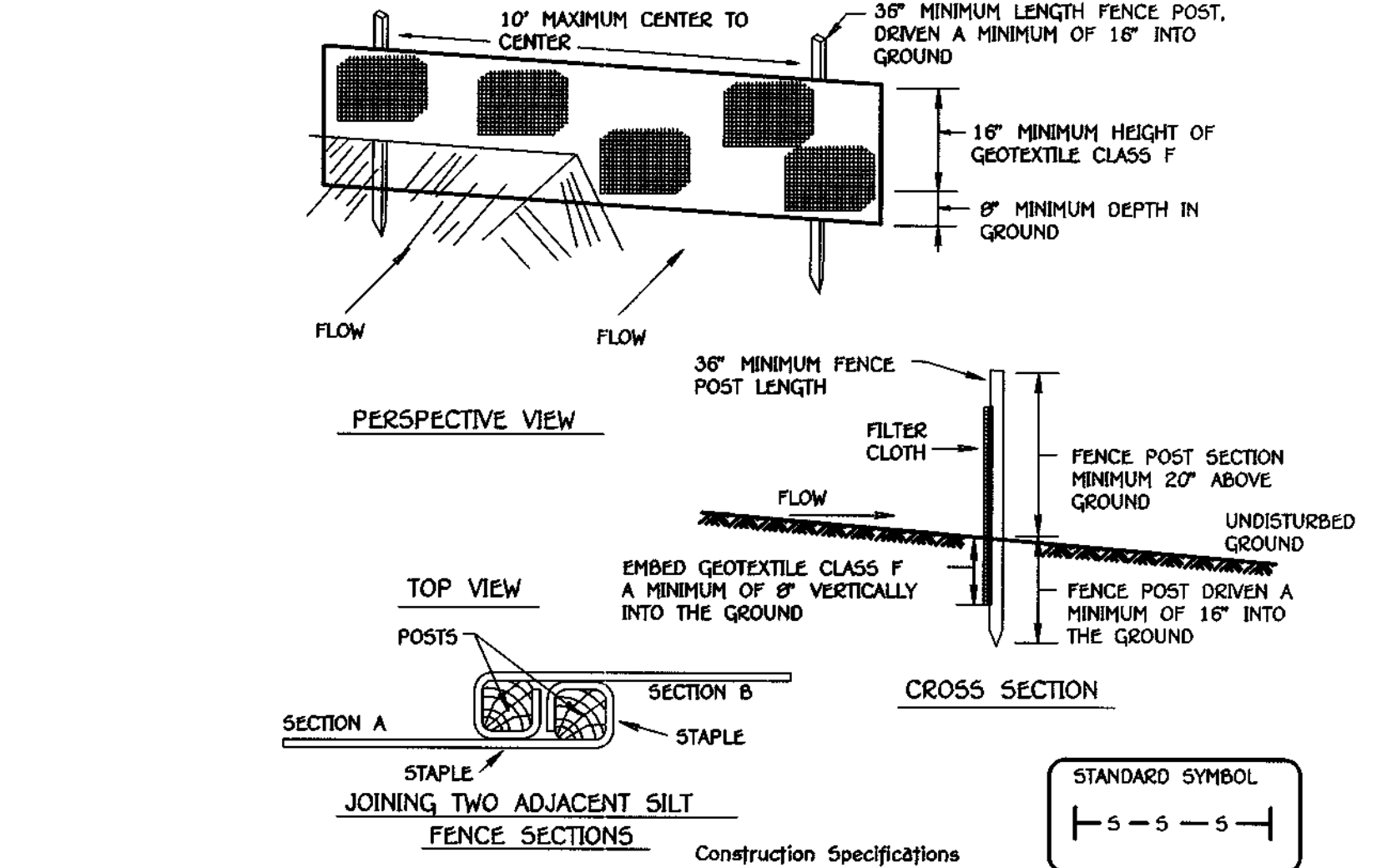

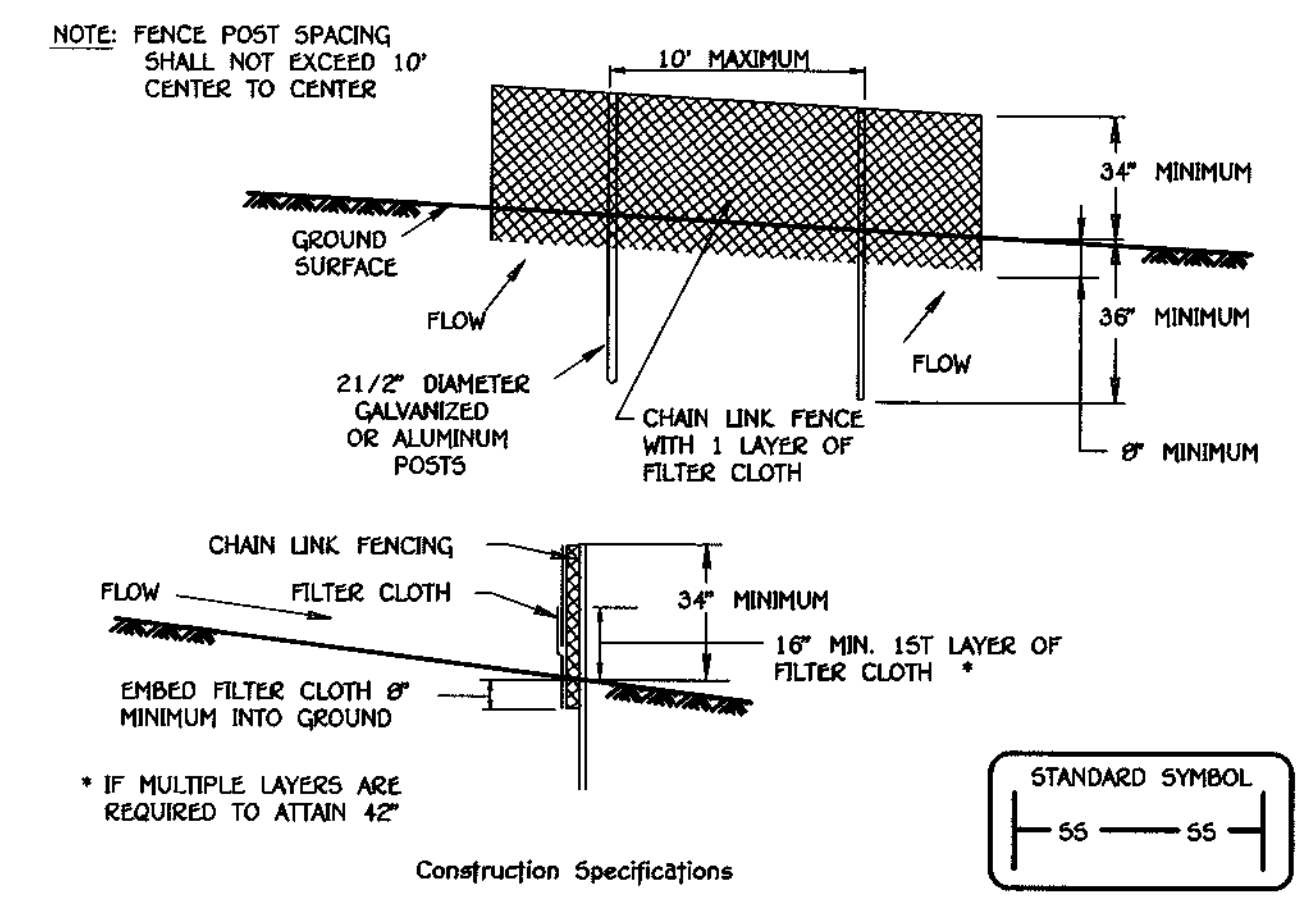
**EARTH DIKE**

- 20.0 STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR VEGETATIVE STABILIZATION**
- Using vegetation as cover for barren soil to protect it from forces that cause erosion.
- PURPOSE:** Vegetative stabilization specifications are used to promote the establishment of vegetation on exposed soil. When soil is stabilized with vegetation, the soil is less likely to erode and more likely to allow infiltration of rainfall, thereby reducing sediment loads and run-off to downstream areas, and improving overall resources.
- CONDITIONS WHERE PRACTICE APPLIES:**
- Site Preparation**
    - Initial erosion and sediment control structures (either temporary or permanent) such as diversions, grade stabilization structures, berms, waterways, or sediment control basins.
    - Perform all grading operations at right angles to the slope. Final grading and shaping is not usually necessary for temporary seeding.
    - Schedule required soil tests to determine soil amendment composition and application rates for sites having disturbed area over 5 acres.
  - Soil Amendments (Fertilizer and Lime Specifications)**
    - Soil tests must be performed to determine the exact ratios and application rates for both lime and fertilizer on sites having disturbed areas over 5 acres. Soil analysis may be performed by the University of Maryland and commercial laboratory. Soil samples taken for engineering purposes may also be used for chemical analyses.
    - Fertilizers shall be uniform in composition, free flowing and suitable for accurate application by approved equipment with prior approval from the appropriate approval authority. Fertilizers shall all be delivered to the site fully labeled according to the appropriate state fertilizer laws and shall bear the name, trade name or trademark and warranty of the producer.
    - Lime materials shall be ground limestone (hydrated or burnt lime may be substituted) which contains at least 90% total oxides (calcium oxide plus magnesium oxide). Limestone shall be ground to such fineness that at least 90% will pass through a #100 mesh sieve and 90-100% will pass through a #20 mesh sieve.
    - Apply fertilizer and lime to the top 3"-5" of soil by diking or other suitable means.
  - Seeded Preparation**
    - Seeded preparation shall consist of loosening soil to a depth of 3" to 5" by means of construction equipment or hand tools. Seeded preparation shall be completed before ripper or rippers mounted on construction equipment. After the soil is loosened it should not be rolled or dragged smooth, but left in the roughened condition. Sloped areas (greater than 3:1) should be tracked leaving the surface in an irregular condition with ridges running parallel to the contour of the slope.
    - Apply fertilizer and lime as prescribed on the plans.
    - Incorporate lime and fertilizer into the top 3"-5" of soil by diking or other suitable means.
  - Permanent Seeding**
    - Minimum soil conditions required for permanent vegetative establishment:
      - Soil pH shall be between 6.0 and 7.0.
      - Soluble salts shall be less than 500 parts per million (ppm).
      - The soil shall contain less than 40% clay, but enough fine grained material (>200 sieve plus clay) to provide the capacity to hold a moderate amount of moisture. An exception is if loess or silt loess is used, in which case the soil may contain up to 60% clay.
      - Soil shall contain 1.5% minimum organic matter by weight.
      - Soil shall contain sufficient pore space to permit adequate root penetration.
      - If these conditions cannot be met by soils on site, adding topsoil is required in accordance with Section 21 Standards and Specifications for Topsoil.
    - Areas previously graded in conformance with the above specifications in a true and even grade, then scarified or otherwise loosened to a depth of 3"-5" to permit bonding of the topsoil to the surface area and to create a rough surface to hold the topsoil to the surface area and to create horizontal erosion check slots to prevent topsoil from sliding down a slope.
    - Apply soil amendments as per soil test or as included on the plans.
    - Mix soil amendments into the top 3"-5" of topsoil by diking or other suitable means. Lawn areas should be rolled to smooth the surface, deep areas should be tracked by a dozer leaving the soil in an irregular condition with ridges running parallel to the contour of the slope. The top 1"-3" of soil should be loose and friable. Seeded loosening may not be necessary on newly disturbed areas.
  - Seed Specifications**
    - All seed must meet the requirements of the Maryland Seed Law. All seed shall be subject to re-testing in a recognized seed laboratory. All seed used shall have been tested within the 12 months immediately preceding the date of sowing such material on the job.
    - Seed tags shall be made available to the inspector to verify type and rate of seed used.
    - Inoculant - The inoculant for treating legume seed in the seed mixtures shall be a pure culture of the rhizobium bacteria for the legume species to be sown. It shall be applied to the seed at the time the seed is placed in the container. Add fresh inoculant as directed on package. Use four times the recommended rate when the seed is treated with inoculant. Do not use inoculant on any seed until used. Temperatures above 75-80° F. can weaken bacteria and make the inoculant less effective.
  - Method of Seeding**
    - Hydroseeding - Apply seed uniformly with hydroseeder (slurry includes seed and fertilizer), broadcast or drop seed in 3" diameter seeder.
    - If fertilizer is being applied at the time of seeding, the application rates amounts will not exceed the following: nitrogen maximum of 100 lbs. per acre total of soluble nitrogen; P2O5 (phosphorous) 50 lbs./acre; K2O (potassium) 200 lbs/acre.
    - Lime - use only ground agricultural limestone. (Up to 3 tons per acre may be applied by hydroseeding at a rate of no more than 2 tons applied in any one pass). Do not use burnt or hydrated lime when hydroseeding.
    - Seed and fertilizer shall be mixed on site and seeding shall be done immediately and without interruption.
    - Dry Seeding: This includes use of conventional drop or broadcast spreaders.



- Construction Specifications**
- Fence posts shall be a minimum of 36" long driven 16" minimum into the ground. Wood posts shall be 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" square (minimum) cut, or 1 3/4" diameter (minimum) round and shall be of sound quality hardwood. Steel posts will be standard T or U section weighing not less than 1.00 pound per linear foot.
  - Geotextile shall be fastened securely to each fence post with wire ties or staples at top and mid-section and shall meet the following requirements for Geotextile Class F:  
Tensile Strength 50 lbs/in (min.) Test: MSMT 509  
Tensile Modulus 20 lbs/in (min.) Test: MSMT 509  
Flow Rate 0.3 gal/ft / minute (max.) Test: MSMT 322  
Filtering Efficiency 75% (min.) Test: MSMT 322
  - Where ends of geotextile fabric come together, they shall be overlapped, folded and stapled to prevent sediment bypass.
  - Silt Fence shall be inspected after each rainfall event and maintained when bulges occur or when sediment accumulation reached 50% of the fabric height.

- Construction Specifications**
- Fencing shall be 42" in height and constructed in accordance with the latest Maryland State Highway Details for Chain Link Fencing. The specification for a 6' fence shall be used, substituting 42" fabric and 6' length posts.
  - Chain link fence shall be fastened securely to the fence posts with wire ties. The lower tension wire, brace and truss rods, drive anchors and post caps are not required except on the ends of the fence.
  - Filter cloth shall be fastened securely to the chain link fence with ties spaced every 24" at the top and mid section.
  - Filter cloth shall be embedded a minimum of 6" into the ground.
  - When two sections of filter cloth adjoin each other, they shall be overlapped by 6" and folded.
  - Maintenance shall be performed as needed and silt buildups removed when "bulges" develop in the silt fence, or when silt reaches 50% of fence height
  - Filter cloth shall be fastened securely to each fence post with wire ties or staples at top and mid section and shall meet the following requirements for Geotextile Class F:

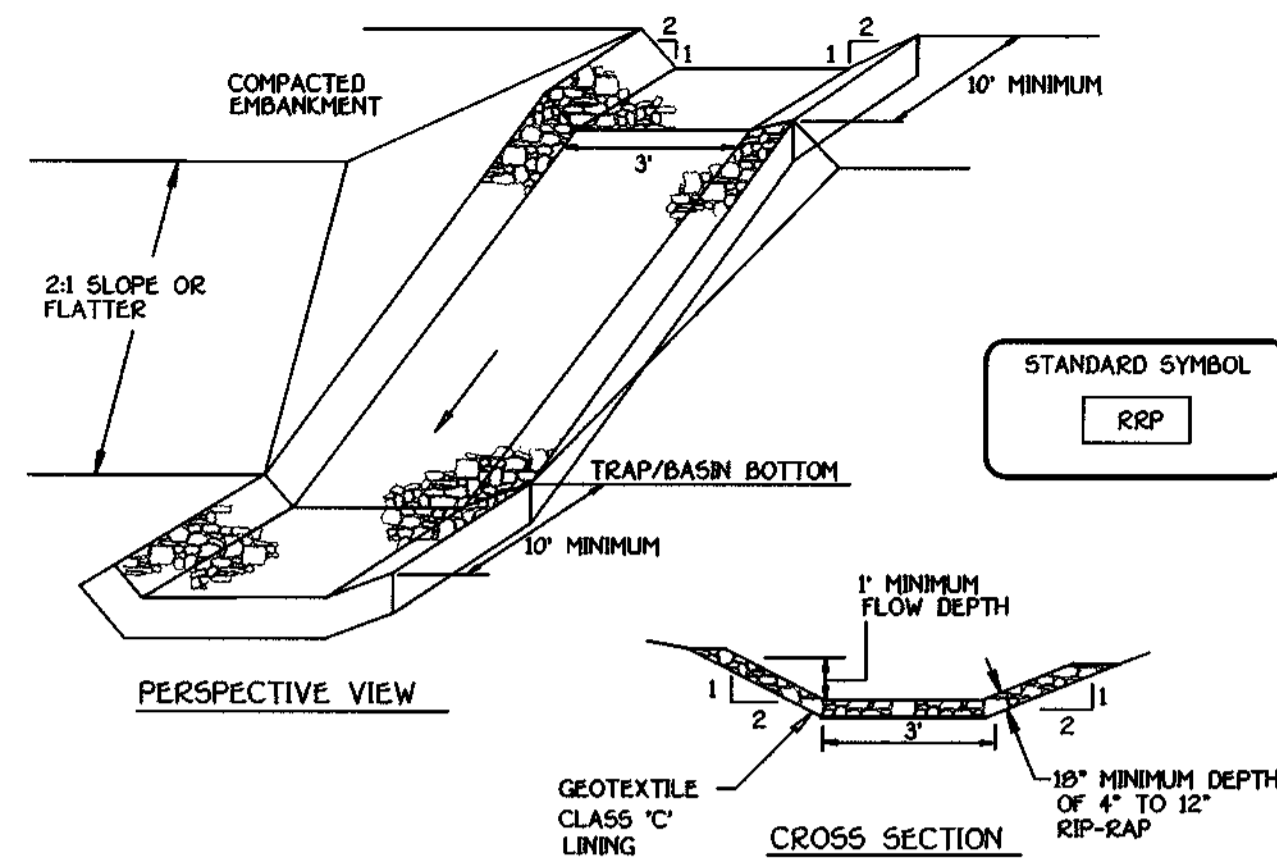
