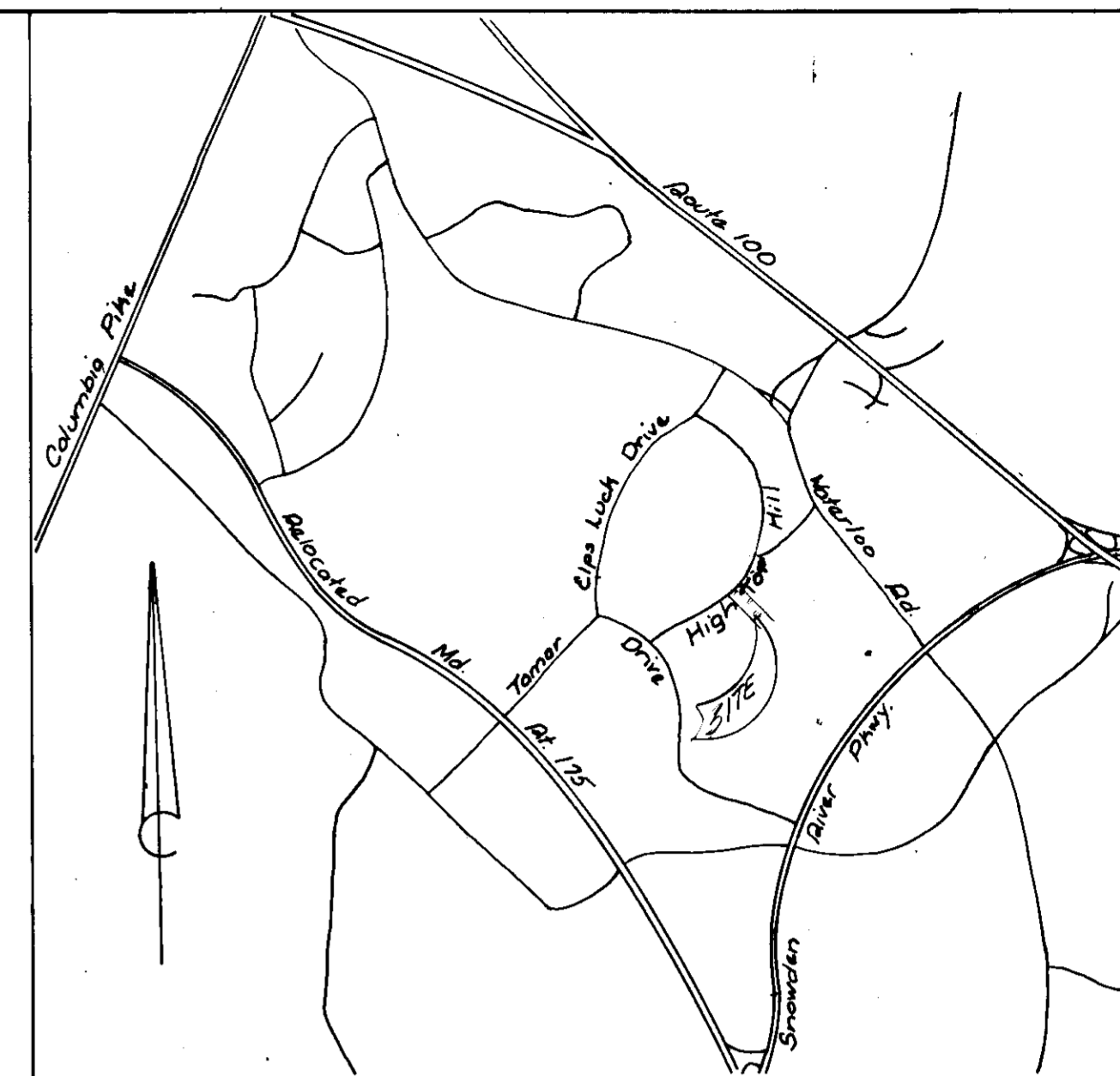
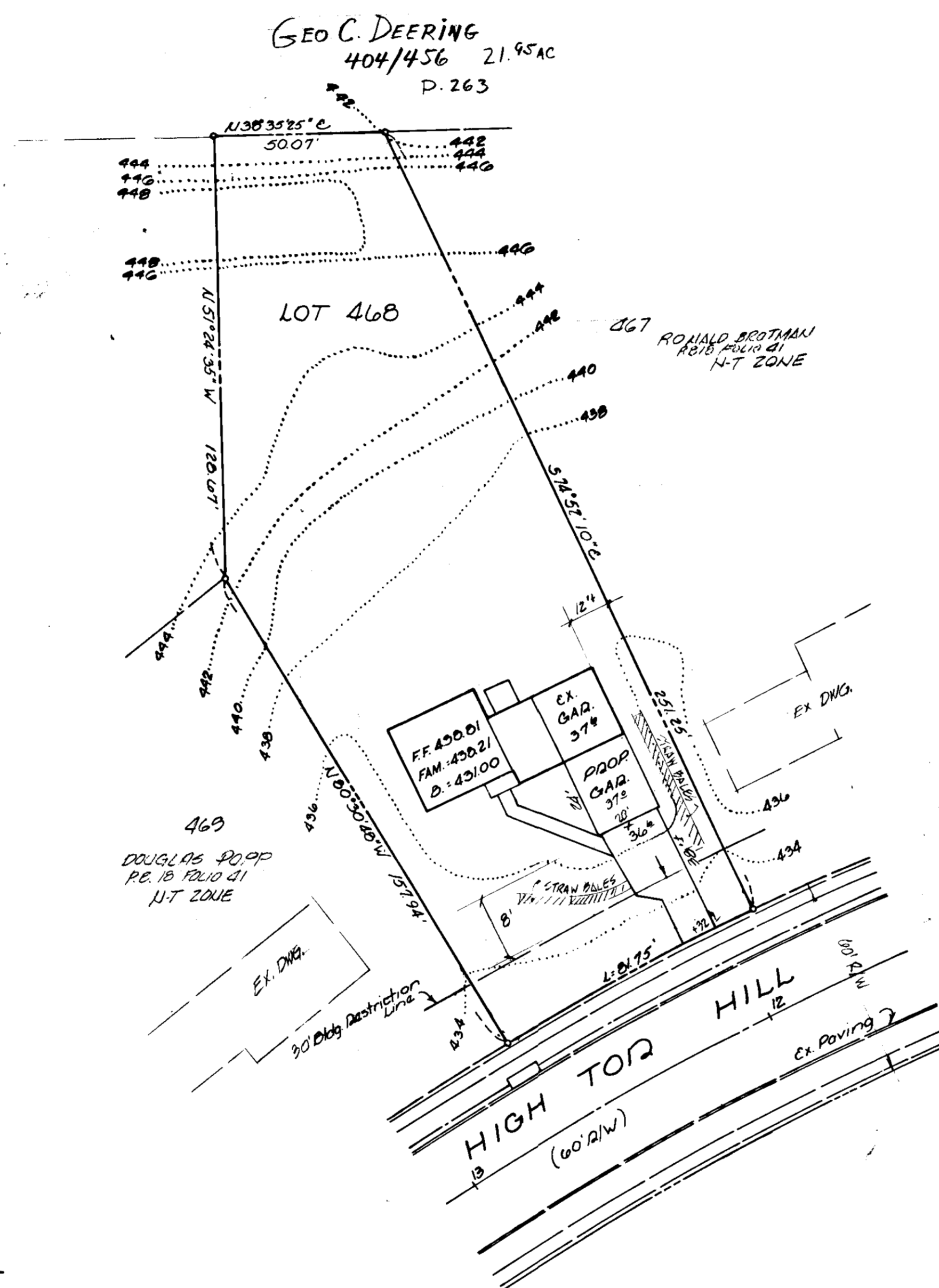


- All Sediment Control to be in accordance with the Howard Soil Conservation District. (Standards and specifications for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control in Urbanizing Areas)
- All areas disturbed by on-site grading that will not be constructed upon within 12 months, are to be stabilized with a semi-permanent type seeding and mulching (Standards and specifications for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control in Urbanizing Areas)
- All areas disturbed by on-site grading on which permanent or semi-permanent seeding (after October 15) or temporary seeding (after November 15) cannot be made, will be treated by mulching (Standards and Specifications for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control in Urbanizing Areas)
- Structural sediment control measures, including their stabilization by seeding or sodding will be installed prior to any other grading on the site.
- All disturbed areas to be stabilized by sodding will be treated in accordance with standards and specifications for soil erosion and sediment control in urbanizing areas.
- Notify the Howard Soil Conservation District at least 24 hours before starting any work phone 445-3100 or 445-5000 ext. 320.
- On-site inspection and maintenance of all sediment control measures, and proper establishment of all planned vegetative measures will be the responsibility of the developer or his representative on the site, on a continuing day to day basis.

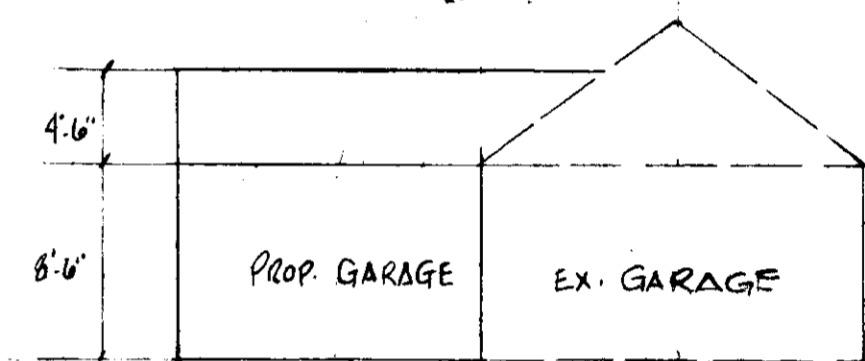


Vicinity Map
