Purpose: to clarify approval does not expire as long as a Site Development Plan, subdivision plan, capital project plan, building or grading permit are in active processing.

Dear Mr. Siew:

The Director of the Department of Planning and Zoning considered your request for an alternative compliance from the Howard County Subdivision and Land Development Regulations.

In accordance with the June 14, 2017 approval letter and the corrected approval letter dated June 19, 2017, the Planning Director approved your request for an alternative compliance of Section 16.155(a)(1)(ii), Section 16.1201(n) and Section 16.1205(a)(7).

Approval is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The applicant shall obtain an approved grading permit to conduct the proposed sewer protection and stream restoration project.
- 2. The applicant shall ensure that no disturbance is permitted beyond the Limit of Disturbance shown on the alternative compliance application exhibit.
- 3. The applicant shall obtain any required State or Federal permits prior to the submission of the grading permit application.
- 5. Any disturbance to an existing Forest Conservation Easement must be restored in accordance with the approved Forest Conservation Plan for that specific parcel.
- 6. Areas which are disturbed and are not part of the permanent sewer easement must be replanted and stabilized within 6 months after completion of the project.

Dear Mr. Siew:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the Director of the Department of Planning and Zoning reconsidered the alternative compliance petition referenced. The reconsideration was necessary since the fee-in-lieu amount found in Condition 4 of the alternative compliance approval of June 14, 2017 was miscalculated.

As of the date of this letter the Planning Director approved the reconsideration, subject to the following revised conditions. Changes are reflected in **bold**:

- The applicant shall obtain an approved grading permit to conduct the proposed sewer protection and stream restoration project.
- 2. The applicant shall ensure that no disturbance is permitted beyond the limit of disturbance shown on the alternative compliance application exhibit.
- 3. The applicant shall obtain any required State or Federal permits prior to the submission of the grading permit application.
- 5. Any disturbance to an existing Forest Conservation Easement must be restored in accordance with the approved Forest Conservation Plan for that specific parcel.
- 6. Areas which are disturbed and are not part of the permanent sewer easement must be replanted and stabilized within 6 months after completion of the project.

Our decision to approve the reconsideration was made since it resulted from a minor miscalculation.
