



*According to the 2012 Green Infrastructure Network Plan, there are 48 corridor connections in the network. The corridor system contains approximately 6,173 acres or 4% of the County's total land area. Approximately 26% of this system is protected in parkland or open space, and 26% is under an agricultural or environmental easement. The remaining 48% of the land is in a variety of uses and approximately 11% is uncommitted.*
