

GENERAL NOTES:

- 1. THE SUBJECT PROPERTY IS ZONED NT NEW TOWN PER THE 2013 COMPREHENSIVE ZONING PLAN. PROPERTY IS ALSO LOCATED WITHIN THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT.
- 2. NO GRADING, REMOVAL OF VEGETATIVE COVER OR TREES, PAVING AND NEW STRUCTURES SHALL BE PERMITTED WITHIN THE LIMITS OF WETLANDS, STREAM(S), OR THEIR REQUIRED BUFFERS, FLOODPLAIN AND FOREST CONSERVATION EASEMENT AREAS.ALL CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LATEST STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS OF HOWARD COUNTY, PLUS MSHA STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS, IF APPLICABLE
- 3. ALL DIMENSIONS ARE TO FACE OF CURB UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
- EXISTING TOPOGRAPHIC AND OUTBOUND INFORMATION IS BASED ON A SURVEY PROVIDED BY MERLYN J. JENKINS & ASSOCIATES, INC. DATED JULY 5, 2016, LAST REVISED NOVEMBER 3, 2017.
- 5. THE LOT IS SERVICED BY PUBLIC WATER (CODE E12) AND SEWER (CODE 5272200).
- 6. APPROXIMATE LOCATION OF EXISTING UTILITIES ARE SHOWN. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE ALL NECESSARY PRECAUTIONS TO PROTECT THE EXISTING UTILITIES AND MAINTAIN UNINTERRUPTED SERVICE. ANY DAMAGE INCURRED DUE TO CONTRACTOR'S OPERATION SHALL BE REPAIRED IMMEDIATELY AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE. EXISTING UTILITIES ARE SHOWN BASED UPON THE BEST AVAILABLE INFORMATION.
- 7. A 100-YEAR FLOODPLAIN STUDY FOR THIS PROJECT IS NOT REQUIRED AS THE PROJECT DOES NOT FALL WITHIN A FLOODPLAIN AS REFERENCED FROM FEMA FIRM MAP 24027C0165D.
- 8. NO WETLANDS ARE PRESENT ON THE SUBJECT PARCEL.
- 9. ALL ELEVATIONS ARE BASED ON NAVD88.
- 10. THE EXISTING TACO BELL TO BE REMOVED IS THE ONLY EXISTING ONSITE PERMANENT STRUCTURE AND IS NOT CONSIDERED TO BE OF ANY HISTORICAL VALUE. AN EXISTING SHED SHALL BE REMOVED AS WELL AND IS NOT CONSIDERED TO BE OF ANY HISTORICAL VALUE.
- 11. THIS PROPERTY IS ZONED NT (NEW TOWN) AND IS THEREFORE EXEMPT FROM FOREST CONSERVATION REQUIREMENTS PER SECTION 16.1202(b)(1)(iv) FOR A PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT WHICH HAS PRELIMINARY DEVELOPMENT PLAN APPROVAL AND IS 50% OR MORE DEVELOPED BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1992.
- 12. FROM INSPECTION OF THE SITE, THERE ARE NO CEMETERIES OR BURIAL GROUNDS LOCATED WITHIN THE TRACT AREA.
- 13. APPROVAL OF THIS ECP DOES NOT CONSTITUTE APPROVAL OF SUBSEQUENT AND ASSOCIATES SITE DEVELOPMENT PLANS OR RED-LINE REVISIONS. REVIEW OF THIS PLAN FOR COMPLIANCE WITH HOWARD COUNTY SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AND THE HOWARD COUNTY ZONING REGULATIONS SHALL OCCUR DURING THE SITE DEVELOPMENT PLAN OR RED-LINE REVISION REVIEW PROCESS. THE APPLICANT AND CONSULTANT SHOULD EXPECT ADDITIONAL AND MORE DETAILED REVIEW COMMENTS (INCLUDING COMMENTS THAT MAY ALTER THE OVERALL SITE DESIGN) AS THIS PROJECT PROGRESSES THROUGH THE PLAN REVIEW PROCESS.

DESIGN NARRATIVE

NATURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION AND ENHANCEMENT
THE SUBJECT PROPERTY IS CURRENTLY FULLY DEVELOPED. THEREFORE, THERE ARE NO EXISTING NATURAL RESOURCES THAT MUST BE PROTECTED. THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT WILL RESULT IN ADDITIONAL WATER QUALITY MEASURES, WHICH WILL BENEFIT THE DOWNSTREAM FACILITIES. NO IMPACTS TO STREAMS, STREAM BUFFERS, WETLANDS, WETLAND BUFFERS, COUNTY REGULATED STEEP SLOPES OF 20,000 SF CONTIGUOUS OR GREATER, OR FLOODPLAINS ARE PROPOSED WITH THIS PLAN. WITHIN THE LOD, THERE ARE NO COUNTY REGULATED STEEP SLOPES OF 20,000 SF CONTIGUOUS OR GREATER. CURRENTLY, THERE ARE NO FORESTED AREAS LOCATED ON-SITE.

MAINTENANCE OF NATURAL FLOW PATTERNS THE EXISTING SITE IS CURRENTLY DEVELOPED AND THE MAJORITY OF THE

THE EXISTING SITE IS CURRENTLY DEVELOPED AND THE MAJORITY OF THE EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS DISCHARGE TO A WATER QUALITY BASIN LOCATED BETWEEN THE DRIVE-THRU QUEUE LANE AND SNOWDEN RIVER PARKWAY. THE DESIGN OF THE WATER QUALITY BASIN WAS APPROVED AS A PART OF SDP-92-066. THE REMAINDER OF THE SITE FLOWS OVERLAND TOWARDS SNOWDEN RIVER PARKWAY TO THE SOUTH OR TOWARDS THE GAS AND ELECTRIC EASEMENT TO THE EAST. THE OUTFALL WOULD BE CONSTRUCTED IN A MANNER TO MINIMIZE OFFSITE DRAINAGE IMPACTS.

REDUCTION OF IMPERVIOUS AREAS

THE PROPOSED SITE IMPROVEMENTS WILL DECREASE THE SITE'S IMPERVIOUS FOOTPRINT BY 319 SF. THE PRE-DEVELOPMENT IMPERVIOUS COVER IS 31,512 SF AND THE POST-DEVELOPMENT IMPERVIOUS COVER IS 31,193 SF. CURRENT USGS SOILS MAPS IDENTIFY THE PARCEL AS UNDERLAIN BY GLENELG-URBAN LAND COMPLEX (GhB), HYDROLOGIC TYPE 'B' SOIL, AND GLENVILLE-URBAN LAND-UDORTHENTH COMPLEX, HYDROLOGIC TYPE 'C' SOIL. THE EXISTING WATER QUALITY BASIN IS LOCATED WITHIN THE GhB SOILS AND IS CURRENTLY PERFORMING AS DESIGNED.

INTEGRATION OF SEDIMENT CONTROL FEATURES


SEDIMENT CONTROL FOR THIS SITE WILL BE PROVIDED BY A STABILIZED CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCE, SEDIMENT TRAPS LOCATED AT THE DOWNHILL SIDE OF THE PROJECT SITE, AND SILT FENCE. STOCKPILE AREAS WILL BE PROVIDED ADJACENT TO THE PROPOSED BUILDING. SEDIMENT CONTROL DESIGN WILL INCLUDE A DETAILED SEQUENCE OF CONSTRUCTION TO MINIMIZE OFFSITE IMPACTS AND TO REQUIRE THE INSTALLATION OF THE STORMWATER FEATURES IN SUCH A MANNER THAT THEY WILL FUNCTION FULLY UPON COMPLETION OF CONSTRUCTION


HOWARD COUNTY ZONING MAP


