The Linda Byrd Stone and Log House faces south on the north side of River Road one and a half miles north of its intersection with Route 32.

It is a three bay wide, one room deep, one story high gabled roof (running east-west) stone house, resting on a stone foundation, featuring fine stone quoining and flat stone lintels, over central door and flanking rectangular windows, around which has been constructed a modern log and frame house, constructed in several, one room, interconnecting, one story high intersecting gable and shed roofed sections, blending old hand hewn logs found in an adjoining house with materials, such as stone, which havebeen found on the property.

An old log smoke house, converted into a bedroom unit, has been incorporated into the overall building complex, through a one story high living-sitting room addition, off its north wall, featuring a west wall bay window, and east wall exterior stone chimney, and a north entrance from this sitting room area onto the brick patio, which runs along the south elevation of the stone house.

Interesting terraced levels, with steps and paths leading from one to another surround this house, connecting units to one another, to create variety and interest, as well as a degree of unity to the overall building complex.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Linda Byrd Stone-Log House faces south on the north side of River Road, ane and a half miles north of its intersection with Route 32.

It is a three bay wide, one room deep, one story high gabled roof (running eastwest) stone house, resting on a stone foundation, featuring fine stone quoining, and flat stone lintels, over central door and flanking rectangular windows, as well as newly constructed exterior east stone chimney, around which has been constructed a modern log and frame house, constructed in several one room, interconnecting, one story high, intersecting gable and shed roofed sections, blending old materials, such as hand hewn logs with those such as stone, found on the surrounding property.

Along the south or front facade of this old stone house, which was in a dilapidated condition, with no roof and crumbling walls, and no exterior stone chimney, when acquired by the Eareckson family, runs a brick patio with steps on the east leading to the higher sloped driveway. This brick patio acts as a connecting unit to the old one story high rectangular gabled roof (running east-west) log smoke house, resting on a stone foundation, (formerly used as a root cellar), which now has been created into an interesting bed room unit with one story high, hipped roof, closet addition, centered on its east wall and large sky light cut into its gable roof.

The patio borders the north wall and rectangular entrance to an old, one story high, gabled roof (running east-west) frame shed, which extends from the north wall of the log smoke house. This old shed is in the process of being completely modernized for use as a sitting area, featuring a one story high bay window on its west elevation and a large exterior stone chimney centered into its east elevation.

Connected to the north wall of the original old stone house is, on the west side an "I" shaped, one story high, shed roofed, new log kitchen unit and, on the east side a one story high, rectangular, gabled roof (running north-south) hand hewn log house bedroom section, the logs of which were found in another old frame and log tenant house, which burned and was located east of this stone house.

Extending from the west wall of the old stone house is a one story high, frame den unit, off whose north wall is one further rectangular, one story high, gabled roof, (running north-south) new log bedroom unit.

Interesting terraced levels, with steps and paths leading from one to another surround this house, connecting units to one another, to create variety and interest, as well as a degree of unity to the overall building comples.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Linda Byrd Stone-Log House is significant architecturally to Howard County and the State of Maryland for its blending and mixing of a gabled roof, one story high, stone building (believed to be the stone dairy of Joshua Warfield's Salopha, See HO-533) and an old log smoke house belonging to the log-frame tenant house on the property, with a modern design, incorporating frame and log additions which utilize old building materials, such as hand hewn logs (found in the burned out tenant house on the property) as well as other natural materials found on the property, such as field stone.

The old stone building, which was in a state of disrepair and around which the other buildings, sections and additions cluster, is believed to be the old stone dairy of Salopha, the property of Joshua Warfield in the mid-nineteenth century. Please see Significant Statement of HO-533, Salopha. Several other auxiliary farm buildings were once located here, among them this log smoke house* with root cellar, converted by the present owners into a charming bedroom unit connected to a frame shed, resting on a stone foundation, which is in the process of being completely rehabilitated and modernized, with wide exterior stone chimney, constructed on its east wall and a one story high bay window added to its west wall, all of which is crowned by a new shake roof. New exterior, vertical frame siding has also been added to this building unit, once a modest frame shed, connected to the smoke house. A brick patio runs between the south elevation of the stone building and the north elevation of the frame shed, creating a unity of design.

The imaginative use of what were once modest farm buildings into a general transformation for residential use, as part of a larger building complex, with the stone building acting as a focal point, is quite unique and gives these log and stone structures added importance and significance.

Not only are the old log and stone buildings united into a design, but further additions have been constructed along the stone building's north and west elevations, most notable of which is the one story high, gabled roof (running north-south) log

*This log smoke house should not be confused with another constructed close to the residence of Joshua Warfield, mentioned in the Significance Statement of HO-533, Salopha.

(constructed of old hand hewn logs found in a burned out tenant house) bedroom wing off the east side of the north wall of the stone building.

None of these additions detract from the fine south facade of the stone section, which features a central door, flanked by rectangular windows, all of which are surmounted by flat stone lintels. The stone building also features fine stone quoining.

As once part of Salopha, the holdings of Joshua Warfield, a Commissioner for Howard County in the nineteenth century, the building has significance in the field of local history.

For these reasons the Linda Byrd Log-Stone House should be considered for inclusion to the National Register of Historic Places, the State Critical Areas Program and any local landmark ordinance the citizens of Howard County may seek to initiate, should its owners so desire.




