The Alvin Leaman House faces south on the north side of Route 144, some 100 feet east of the new intersection of Routes 94 and 144.

It is a three bay wide, two to three room deep, shed roofed, frame (covered with red asbestos tile) house, which features a rectangular entrance in the east bay of the south wall and a wide cornice, decorated with scrolled brackets,

Constructed late in the nineteenth century, it provides an architectural anchor to the streetscape on the north side of Route 144 in the old village of Lisbon.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

H0-200 faces south on the north side of Route 144, just west of H0-201, the Mathis House. It is a three bay wide, two room deep, two story high, shed roofed frame (covered with red asbestos shingles) house, resting on a stone foundation. Its entrance is located in the east bay of the south wall. This south facade is decorated with a wooden cornice held by scrolled brackets. A one story high, open porch, supported by wooden posts runs along this elevation which holds two rectangular, double-hung first floor windows with six-over-six lights in its central and west bays. Three vertically aligned and proportionally scaled second floor windows lie above, holding one-over-one lights.

A rectangular one-over-one light window has been placed in the building's north wall, to which has been added a two bay wide, one room deep, two story high, shed roofed addition, holding a six-over-six light second floor east window.

The west elevation of the house holds a first floor one-over-one light window and a vertically aligned second floor six-over six light window. The west wall of the two story high, north wing lies flush with the west wall of the front section of the house holds a central square brick chimney.

A further one story high, shed roofed appendage is located on the east wall of the kitchen wing and holds a rectangular north entrance, covered by an enclosed gabled roof vestibule.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Alvin G. Leamon House, HO-200, is significant architecturally and historically to the village of Lisbon, to Howard County and to the State of Maryland.

Architecturally it is representative of the shed roofed row houses constructed in Baltimore and its environs in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. The houses feature great depth and are almost always three bays wide with end bay entrance and hall. Interior floor plan is double pile in organization, two rooms deep. Their interior plan is radically different from the three or five bay wide, one room deep, central hall house found in the beginning and middle of the nineteenth century in Lisbon and throughout Howard County, Maryland. This house plan is representative of the row house plan which is concerned with the greatest utilization of space on a narrow lot with great depth. This house is a departure from such wide, one room deep houses generally found in the village of Lisbon, to which were added back appendages. One other house, however, has similar characteristics and that is attached to the west wall of Lee's Market, located on the southwest corner of Old Route 94 and Route 144. The latter is another such late nineteenth century departure from the ordinary architectural styles found in Lisbon. It features similar stylistic detail to the Leamon House in its deep cornice and scrolled brackets.

Architecturally the Leamon House is of the utmost importance for it is the architectural anchor of the northwest corner of the new intersection of Routes 94 and Route 144. Though a new house has replaced one previously existing on this corner, it does not lend itself to maintaining the architectural integrity of the streetscape on the north side of Route 144. Such a function is thus transferred to the Leamon House.

Historically, lots #24 and #74, on which the building stands were acquired in 1846 for \$20.00 by Ellen Buckingham, noted as owner in the 1878 Hopkin's Atlas. They were later inherited by John and Jesse Buckingham, who on May 18, 1880 sold them to Alvin G. and Ann Catharine Leamon for \$95. Some twenty four years later they were sold to Marian A. Woodward for \$1,350. It is probable that the present house, as it stands today, was constructed during the tenure of Alvin Leamon, sometime in the late nineteenth century.

Architecturally and historically significant, the Alvin Leamon House, along with the entire village of Lisbon should be placed on the National Register of Historic Places and the State Critical Areas Program.
