The Ridgely-Mercier House faces north on the southwest corner of Church Alley and Route 144, It is a three bay wide, one room deep, two story high, gabled roof (running east west) frame building, with square, corceled brick chimneys inset into the center of its east and west walls. Initially the building was constructed in a "T" plan with a two story high, one bay wide, one bay deep, later extended, intersecting gable roof (running north-south) frame addition extending south from the central bay of the building's south wall. This has been filled in on the east elevation by a two story high, simi-enclosed, shed roofed porch, creating the building's present "L" plan. This building is notable historically as the residence of Miss Elsie Pearl Mercier, who according to Mrs. Celia Holland, local historian served Howard County as educator for over forty years and was the granddaughter of Charles Woods of New York, one of three original contractors (Mathew, Woods & Hall) who laid the first B & O railroad tracts from Baltimore to Ellicotts Mills in 1828-29.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Ridgel y-Mercier House faces north on the southwest corner of Church Alley and Route 144. It is a three bay wide, two bay deep, two story high, gabled roof (running east-west) frame house, built on a stone foundation with square brick chimneys inset into its east and west walls. Several additions have been made to its south wall, which originally formed a "T" plan and later an "L" plan.

The north elevation features a central, one light rectangular entrance surmounted by a two light transom, flanked by single, double-hung, rectangular windows with two-over-two lights, decorated with shutters. A one story high, flat roofed, open porch, held by four scrolled posts with scrolled brackets runs along this elevation. Three vertically aligned and proportionally scaled, second floor windows rest above.

The west elevation of the house holds no apertures, while the east elevation holds two first and second floor, two-over-two, light windows and a four light attic casement window.

Initially a one bay wide, one room deep, two story high intersecting gable roof (running north-south) frame south wing extended from the central bay of the south wall, which held a first and second floor window in its west bay. Later a one bay wide, one room deep, two story high, gabled roof extension to the south wall of the base of the "T" was constructed, while along both these additions was constructed a two story high, shed roofed open porch, whose south side was enclosed, leaving the north side open. The first floor of this open section has recently been blocked in by cinder block and it remains open on the second floor, secured by a wooden railing. First and second floor rectangular entrances are located on its east wall.

The interior features open transoms above entrances from one room to another, decorated with scrolled spindles. A fine central staircase leads to the second floor.

The building stands on three/fourths of an acre of ground and except for some cosmetic facelifting is in good condition.

The Ridgely-Mercier House is important architecturally and historically to the town of Lisbon and Howard County, Maryland.

Architecturally it is representative of a turn of the century frame house, blending earlier elements of the three or five bay wide, one room deep, two story high, gabled roof house with attached kitchen wing forming an "L" plan with later more elaborate interior work, such as the scrolled wood spindles which fill the transoms over interior doors. Not only is its scale and architectural integrity important individually but collectively with the Joggereit and Eswortny House it forms an important element of the building fabric of the early nineteenth century town of Lisbon as well as an important element of the streetscape on the south side of Route 144 between the old Lisbon School and the present Exxon Garage and Service Station. Located on the southwest corner of Church Alley and Route 144, it forms the architectural anchor for the two earlier log houses west and provides a protective barrier for them.

Historically the house is associated with a well beloved lady, the late Miss Elsie Pearl Mercier, who taught in the Howard County school system for over forty years. According to Celia Holland, local historian, she came to Lisbon when the first two-room school was erected and taught at the presently standing old Lisbon Elementary School for some seventeen years between the years 1918-1935. Not only was she a legend in her own right, through the fine service rendered the County as educator but she was also the recipient of a fine family heritage, being the granddaughter of Charles Woods of New York, one of the three original contractors of Matthews, Woods and Hall, who laid the first B & O railroad tracks from Baltimore to Ellicott Mills in 1828 - 1829. Mrs. Holland relates in her article, "Out of the Past: Lisbon" that when passenger service was discontinued in 1949 those who took part in the trip from Ellicott City to Mt. Airy - the B & O's final passenger run.

According to the present owner, Mrs. Poole, the house is said to have been constructed c. 1890, was one of the showplaces of Lisbon and was always available to St. Paul's Episcopal Church as the site for their Annual Silver Tea.

The house is believed to have been built, initially, as a summer residence. Lisbon, for many years was a summer resort for people in Baltimore and Washington. There were no heating facilities until later for the present house, which further substantiates this theory on the part of the owner.

Architecturally and historically significant, the Ridgely-Mercier House, along with the entire town of Lisbon should be placed on the National Register of Historic Places.






FIGURE 1 HO-249 THE RIDGELY-MERCIER HOUSE


