The Howard Chapel United Methodist Church faces east on the west side of Long Corner Road, one and a half miles south of its intersection with Penn Shop Road.

It is composed of two major building blocks; a three bay wide, three bay deep, one story high, gabled roof (running east-west) frame(covered with aluminum siding) north wing, resting on a stone foundation, and a three bay wide, three bay deep, one story high, intersecting gable roof (running north-south) south wing, resting on a stone foundation, creates an "L" plan. A tall, square, tent roofed, entrance-campanile, is located in its southeast corner. To this has been added a three bay wide, eight bay deep, one story high, gabled roof (running east-west) brick (laid in running bond) Sunday School building, connected to the original structure by a gabled roof (running east-west) frame addition.

A corner stone is located on the northeast corner of the north wing with the inscription, "Howard Chapel - 1884."

The building is notable for its tripartite fenestration on the east and west walls of the north wing, repeated on the south wall of the south wing: a double, rectangular, double-hung, stained glass window, flanked by single, similar, stained glass windows. The windows all bear the same general blue and purple, stained glass border, with curvilinear central insets. They are framed by flat, wooden lintels and pilasters with ears.

Prior to 1860, the congregation of this church attended Brown's Chapel, off Route 27. In 1860, a general falling out occured between members of the congregation and each went their separate ways. Half the congregation left to form the Montgomery Church in Montgomery County and the other half formed the Howard Chapel M.E. Church in Howard County.

Between 1860 and 1884, an earlier building was used for Howard Chapel, south of the present church, which was initially constructed in 1884 with later additions.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Howard Chapel United Methodist Church faces east on the west side of Long Corner Road, three tenths of a mile south of its intersection with New Cut Road, and one and a half miles south of its intersection with Penn Shop Road. It is composed of two major building blocks; a three bay wide, three bay deep, one story high, gabled roof (running east-west) frame (covered with aluminum siding) north wing, resting on a stone foundation, and a three bay wide, three bay deep, one story high, intersecting gable roof (running north-south) south wing which creates an "L" plan, with a tall, square, tent roofed entrance - campanile, located in its southeast corner.

To this has been added a three bay wide, eight bay deep, one story high, gabled roof (running east-west) brick (laid in running bond) Sunday School building, connected to the original structure by a gabled roof, (running east-west) frame addition.

THE EAST ELEVATION

Four wide, poured in place concrete steps, flanked by an iron railing lead to the open bible, cross paneled, double, rectangular entrance door of the entrance-campanile section of the building. is surmounted by a concave lintel, decorated with a row of dentils and a row of beading, above which rests a rectangular, stained glass transom with the words "Howard Chapel M.P. Church" inscribed in its Flat pilasters flank the entrance and its transom, surmounted by a flat wooden lintel.

The major stylistic motif of the building occurs on the east elevation of the north wing. It is repeated on the west elevation of this wing and on the south elevation of the south wing. The wall holds a tripartite division with a central double, stained glass, double-hung, rectangular window, flanked by single, similar windows. The windows all bear the same general, blue and deep purple, stained glass border, with curvilinear central insets, each of which features a different theme. On the east wall is represented from north to south: the compass, the bible, the lamp of knowledge, the cross. The south bay of the south transcent's east wall features an open bible. inset into a one bay wide, one bay deep, flat roofed, one story high, square addition to the east wall's central bay also features an open bible.

THE WEST ELEVATION

The west wall of the north wing holds this same tripartite window arrangement. On the west, starting from north to south, the following motif occurs: cross and anchor in the north bay and the grape and

sheath of wheat in the two central windows of the double window. No window occurs in the south bay. Instead a new shed roofed entrance vestibule has been constructed on this section of the west wall and the bottom panel of the original south bay window used for the west wall of this small vestibule. A rectangular entrance with five cross shaped, central lights, is placed in the center of the north wall of this small vestibule.

All of the windows are flanked by flat, wooden pilasters with ears at top and bottom, underlined by flat, wooden, projecting sills and surmounted by pediments.

THE SOUTH ELEVATION

The south elevation holds the similar tripartite window arrangement, found on the east elevation of the north wing.

The building is in excellent condition.

NORTH ELEVATION

The north elevation features a central, hipped roof, one story high, bay window, which holds single east and west windows, similar to those already described. The west window features a dove, symbol of the Holy Spirit, while the east window features an interesting separation of the firmament with either the sun or moon above. The east and west bays of this north wall also hold similar windows, depicting an anchor cross and a crown, respectively.

A corner stone is located on the northeast corner of this north wing. Its east face reads, "Howard Chapel" and its north face is inscribed with the date "1884."

The building is situated on a high ridge of land overlooking the Pat-uxent River.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Howard Chapel Methodist Episcopal Church is significant architecturally and historically to Howard County and the State of Maryland.

Architecturally, it is representative of verncaular frame, church architecture in the late nineteenth century. Howard Chapel M.E. Church retains its original rectangular, one room building block in its north wing with the original entrance bell-tower on its southeast corner. Architecturally, the building is significant for retaining its original structure and additionally, for the manner in which extensions were made and original components, i.e. the stained glass windows, utilized to integrate the old with the new. wall of the north wing remains unchanged. This window treatment was used on the west wall also, and probably on the north and south Today, the south bay window of the west wall was removed to provide an additional entrance vestibule. The pulpit was located on the west wall at first, but later, in 1910, was changed to the north wall with a small extension provided by the construction of a central bay window, which provided a recessed area for the pulpit. of the original four windows of this north wall were placed on the east and west sides of the bay. The other two, which composed the central double window, may well be the two windows found on the east wall of the south wing, believed to have been constructed circa 1910, and its small extension, which was built later.

The south wall of this south wing holds the same tripartite window treatment, a double, rectangular, stained glass window, flanked by identical, single, stained glass windows.

One other alteration was made to the building. Its steeple, which was slightly different from what we see today, (higher, with an open breezeway so the bell could ring out) was struck by lightning and caught on fire. The steeple was lowered and enclosed because of this.

In 1966, an educational building was added to the church, but was burned in 1977. It has since been completely rebuilt.

In the past two years, the sanctuary, contained in the original north wing, has been totally restored and its solid oak pews refinished. No change was made, however, to the bark on the very large log joists

underneath the church. The lumber used to construct the main part of the sanctuary was cut from trees on surrounding properties. Where there normally would be wallpaper or plain walls, a pressed metal has been used, pressed into a design and painted. This was prevalent in Victorian times and is featured in the Molly Brown House in Denver, Colorado, a National Historic Landmark.

Historically, the roots of the congregation go back prior to 1860, to an earlier church off Route 27, called Brown's Chapel, of which nothing is left except a few bricks in the ground. This church is not to be confused with Brown's Chapel M.E. Church at Dayton, which still stands and serves a predominantly black congregation.

Church history reveals that there was a general falling out between members of the congregation circa 1860, and that each went their separate ways. Half of the congregation left and formed the Montgomery Church in Montgomery County, and the other half went and formed the Howard Chapel M.E. Church in Howard County.

Circa 1860, land was given to the Howard Chapel M.E. Church. Some sort of an earlier building was used between the years 1860 and 1884 by the congregation, where the cemetery is now located.

The older church, utilized by the congregation between the years 1860 and 1884, stood south of the present building.

Today, new families have built homes in the area and attend church here. They, in conjunction with the older parishioners, bring the membership roll to some 155 souls, averaging 70-80 people in attendance on Sundays.

Presently a great deal of work is being done on the history of the congregation with members visiting the archives of the Lovely Lane Methodist Church in Baltimore and investigating the Old Newspapers of the 1860's for news of the Church.

Architecturally, historically and religiously significant to Howard County and the State of Maryland, the Howard Chapel M.E. Church should be considered for inclusion to the National Register of Historic Places, the State Critical Areas Program and any local landmark ordinance the citizens of Howard County may seek to initiate, should its owners so desire.
