

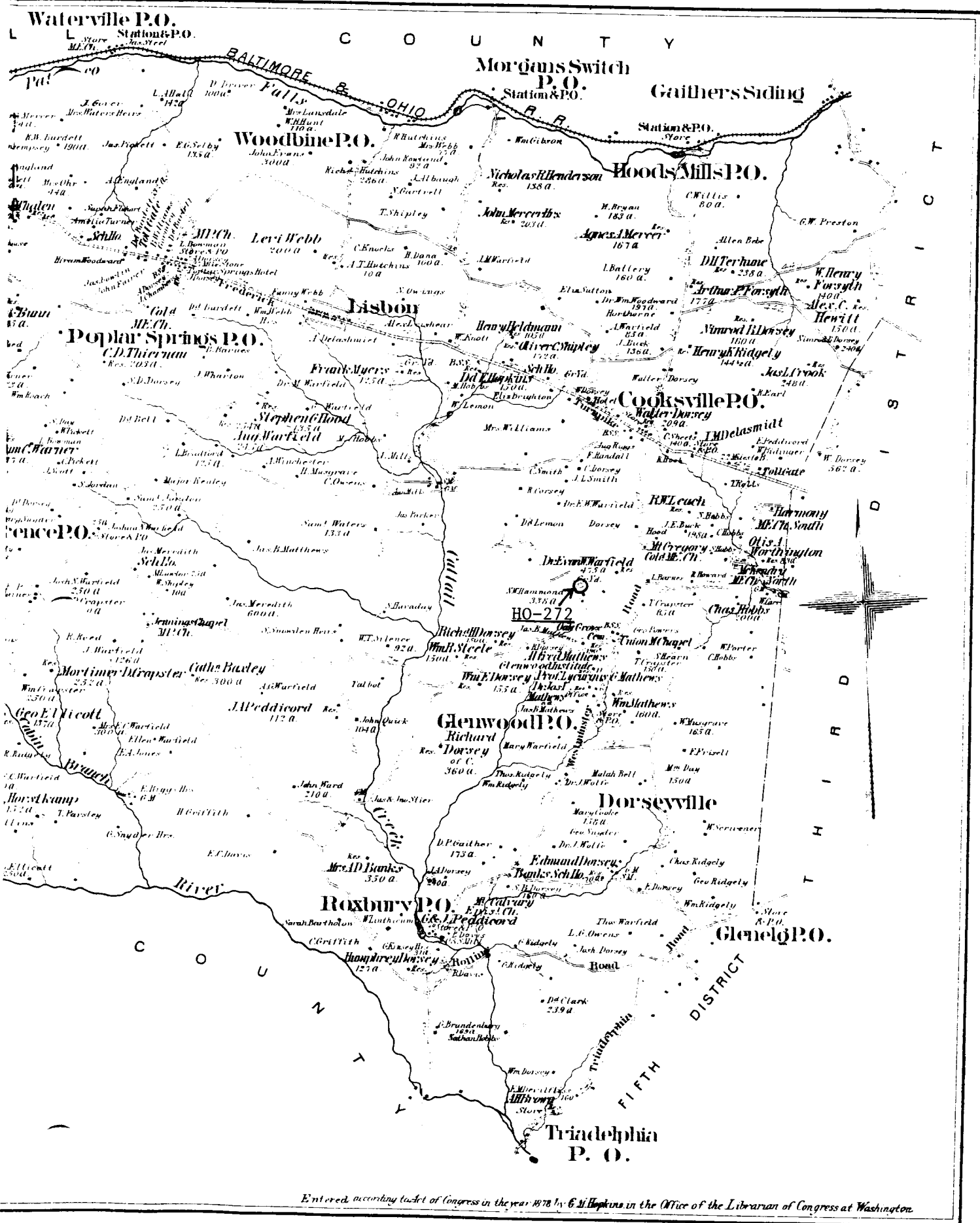
HO-272

The cemetery is surrounded by a stone wall. A nearby sign (near Route 97) reads:

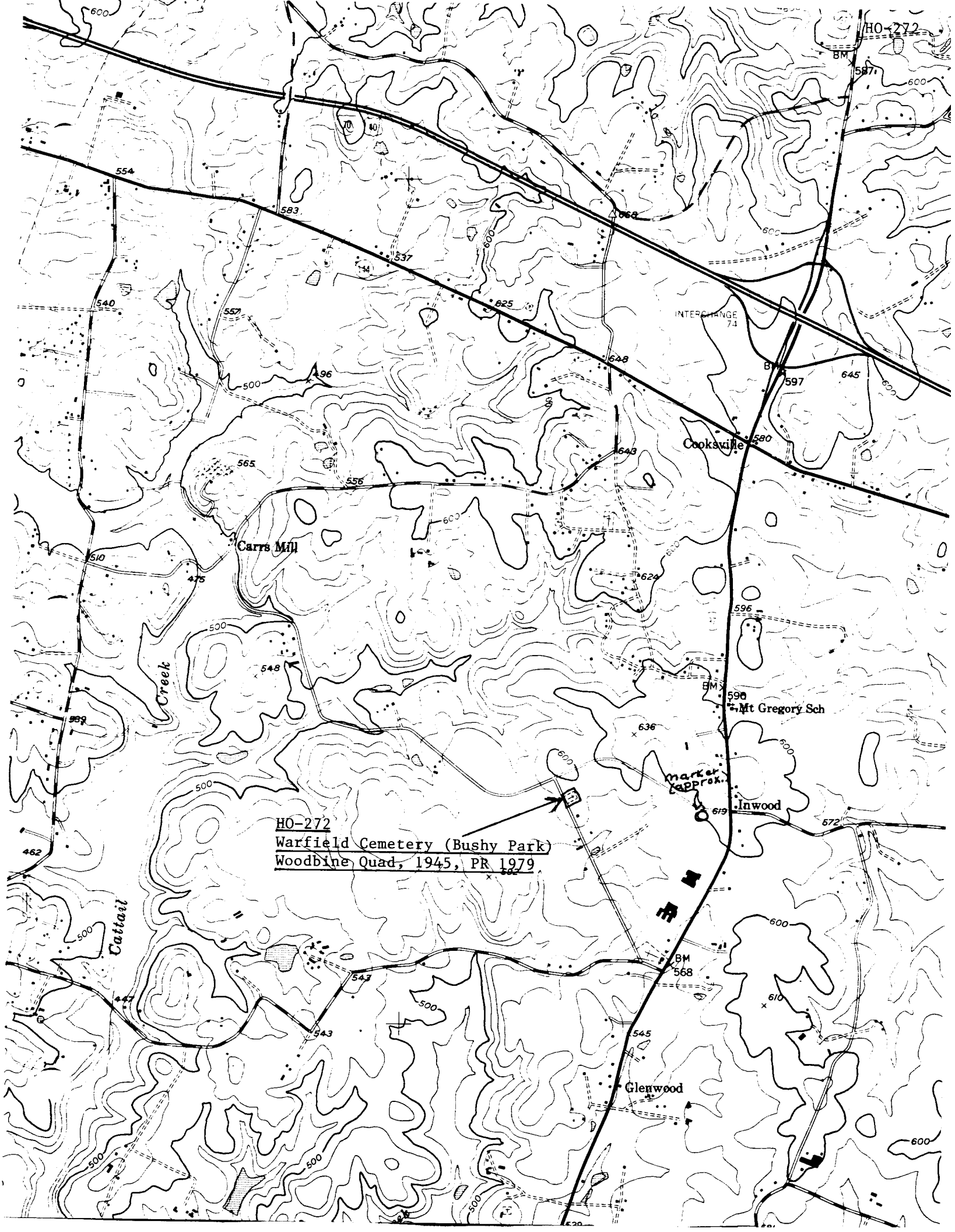
Dr. Charles Alexander Warfield

The grave of this Revolutionary War patriot is near this site. A member of the Sons of Liberty, he participated in the burning of the brig "Peggy Stewart," at Annapolis October 19, 1774, and also served as a Major in the Elkridge Battalion during the war.
