Rebel Trading Post & The Arms Room (Ijams Shop)
3744-3748 Tongue Row
Ellicott City

This two-story, four-bay, stone commercial duplex has a central brick chimney serving both halves of the structure. Doors are in the first and fourth bays. The corners of the building have large granite quoins. Slightly shorter than its southern neighbor (HO-309), the two halves of the front facade have different height roofs.


The northernmost half, 3744, has a slightly lower roofline, and an added central cross gable with imbricated shingles. The 2/2 second floor windows extend up into this cross gable. The first floor window, also 2/2, is in the south bay, with a door in the north bay.

The southernmost half, 3748, has 6/6 windows on both floors. There is a door in the south bay.

The rear facade is three stories high, with 6/6 windows on the south half and a door in the southernmost ground floor (basement) bay. The 3rd floor has about 2 feet of German siding below the eave line, beginning about 1 foot in from the south side. All the windows in the stone part of the building have massive granite sills and lintels.


The northern half has a shed-roofed frame addition, which has 2/2 windows on the 2nd and 3rd floors on both the back and side (north), and a door in the north bay of the ground (basement) floor, with a 6/6 window in the next


bay. The ground floor of the north facade of this frame addition has a small 6-pane window. The south facade of the frame addition has two 6/6 windows on the first floor and 1 2/2 window centered on the second floor.
