



Facing south on Main Street, this brick commercial building has an extremely shallow gable roof. The front facade is stone, while the rest of the building appears to be 7-course brick. The first floor has three large Romanesque-style semicircular arches with keystones, forming a central doorway and two large shop windows. A lighter-colored belt course appears just below the stone arches, at about the level of the top of the double doors. The interiors of all three arches are filled with a half circle of 16 small square panes of glass, down to the level of the belt course. Below each of these windows are two 2-light windows to the cellard, below a watertable. Another belt course appears between the two floors. The second floor has a group of five connecting Romanesque-style semicircular arched windows, smaller than the ones below, with a common stone sill, and 1/1 lights.

The west facade of the building, which is exposed to an alley, is six bays deep, and has six tall, narrow 9/9-sash windows on the second floor with segmental arches with double rowlock courses. The first floor has a small 6-light casement window below each of the first (southernmost) three 2nd floor windows. The rear (north) half of this facade has a large doorway with double doors with 4 lights each. To the right (south) of this is a 6/6 sash window. To the far left is a paneled door. Above the spaces between these openings and

the central large door are small 6-light casement windows, matching the ones on the south half of this facade.

A shed-roofed 1-bay long modern brick addition (also 7-course) has been built onto the northern (rear) end of the building. A 6/6 sash window in the second floor is in keeping with the older parts of the building, despite the other, more modern, apertures on the rest of this facade.


