St. John's Cemetery Lodge was built between the years 1871 when St. John's Cemetery was established through a gift from Sallie Elizabeth Dorsey and 1886 when it was used as a marker for the property deed conferring the old St. John's Rectory from Reuben Dorsey to the vestry of St. John's Episcopal Church. The by-laws of the Act of Incorporation in 1877 are noteworthy. No smoking, large assemblies, unaccompanied children or noise are allowed within the grounds.

Architecturally Cemetery Lodge is one of the most unique and charming buildings in Howard County, reminiscent of the English Cottage with its high pitched intersecting jerkin roofs. This Lodge is composed of a north and south wing with entrances located on the east and south facades of the north wing and centered into the south wall of the south wing.

Central high pitched, slate, gabled roof dormer windows are centered into the roof at each elevation of each section holding similar rectangular casement windows.

St. John's Lodge is the home of the caretaker for St. John's cemetery. It is situated east of St. John's church and is built of granite and rests on a stone foundation. The building features fine stone quoining and twelve twelve lite first floor rectangular casement windows decorated with flat stone lintels and projecting wooden sills, and high pitches pabled roof dormer windows on each elevation decorated with scrolled barge boards and holding 10-10 lite casement windows.

It is constructed in two sections, a north and south wing with eighteen inch thick walls, and intersecting high pitched hipped roofs.

The south elevation holds a central entrance door, approached by three stone stairs and covered by a shed roof which drops from the roof line. A central rectangular high pitched gabled roof dormer window decorated with scrolled barge boards rests above with a 10-10 lite casement window. This south section provides for the large living room. The north section springs from the north wall and its intersecting patterned slate hipped roof runs north-south.

The east and west facade of this section holds single first and second floor casement windows, holding twelve -12 and 10-10 lites respectively, centered into the east and west walls of the south section. A main rectangular entrance door rests in the south bay of the north section with a first floor two-two lite casement window resting in its north bay. A steeply pitched gabled roof dormer window rests between, holding separate 10 lite casement windows decorated with scrolled barge boards.

The north elevation of the north section of the house which holds the large dining room and litchen holds two first floor two-two lite casement windows with gabled roof dormer windows lying above. A cellar door rests under the window of the east bay while a tall square corbeled brick chimney is centered between the dormers providing flues for kitchen stove.

The west wall of the north section is similar to the east wall with a single first floor 2-2 lite casement window centered into the wall and a 10-10 lite rectangular high pitched gabled roof casement window lying above.

* A one baywide, two bay deep, one story high shed roofed addition is used as an office in the south west intersection of the two sections. A double rectangular window, each with one-over-one lites rests in the west wall, while a rectangular entrance lies in the west bay of the south wall.




