The house at 10787 Scaggsville Road is not eligible due to the fact that it does not meet National Register Criteria A, B, C, or D. Preliminary research has not revealed any association between the dwelling and events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of our history (Criterion A) or the lives of persons significant in our past (Criterion B). Although the building provides an example of the Craftsman-Bungalow style, it is neither unusual nor distinguished; it does not represent the work of a master or display high artistic merit (Criterion C). There is no evidence that the property is likely to yield information important in history or prehistory (Criterion D). Thus, the property is not National Register-eligible.

**CAPSULE SUMMARY**  
10787 Scaggsville Road  
(HO-711)

Constructed in 1941, the residence at 10787 Scaggsville Road was designed as a Craftsman-style bungalow. The 1-1/2-story, side gable frame house is set on a panel-faced concrete block foundation. The building's rectangular footprint is interrupted by a one-story, enclosed frame porch set at the center of the rear elevation and by a shallow, projecting rectangular box-bay with a shed roof. Matching gable front dormers pierce the front and rear roof planes, and a full-width, one-story, three-bay porch is incorporated under the main roof at the front. The porch is supported on Craftsman-style columns consisting of dwarf Doric columns set atop brick piers. The building has been only minimally altered by the addition of aluminum siding and the enclosure of the rear porch.

The property has remained in the Scaggs family since the construction of the dwelling. The house passed from its original owners, Arthur and Bessie Scaggs, to their two children Melvin Scaggs and Elsie L. Souder, who was married to Eugene Souder. Eventually, Elsie and Eugene Souder became sole owners of the property. Until the end of 1978, the house was retained by various members of the Souder family. At that time it was passed to a family company, Souder Builders, Inc.

Constructed in 1941, the residence at 10787 Scaggsville Road was designed as a Craftsman-style Bungalow. The 1-1/2-story, side gable frame house is set on a panel-faced concrete block foundation. The building's rectangular footprint is interrupted by a one-story, enclosed frame porch set at the center of the rear elevation and by a shallow, projecting rectangular box-bay with a shed roof. Matching gable front dormers pierce the front and rear roof planes, and a full-width, one-story, three-bay porch is incorporated under the main roof at the front. The porch is supported on Craftsman-style columns consisting of dwarf Doric columns set atop brick piers. The building has been only minimally altered by the addition of aluminum siding and the enclosure of the rear porch.

The dwelling at 10787 Scaggsville Road occupies a large lot on the southwest side of Scaggsville Road. Facing northeast, the house is set back approximately sixty feet from the road. The property, which consists of 26,339 square feet, is dotted with mature trees at the front. Pine trees demarcate the southeast boundary of the site, and a long paved drive, Cairn Wind Way, extends past the house to the rear where several newer dwellings stand.

**EXTERIOR DESCRIPTION:**

A one-story, three-bay front porch dominates the facade of the dwelling at 10787 Scaggsville Road. The facade or northeast elevation is divided into three bays, the center of which contains the main entry. This central opening is filled with a single-leaf, Craftsman-style, panel-and-light door. The main entrance is flanked on either side by window bays. The southeastern of these two bays holds a pair of 3/1 windows, while the northwest bay contains a single window with the same light pattern. The upper half-story is marked by a group of three 3/1 windows. The windows and the door on this elevation are trimmed with simple square-edged wood moldings.

The northwest wall of the building contains three stories, each pierced by a combination of openings. The concrete block foundation contains three openings. One of these openings holds an overhead metal rolling garage door that is paneled and lighted. Two three-light, casement windows provide light to the basement on the northwest. The first story contains three 3/1 windows of varying sizes. Above these, in the upper half story, a pair of 3/1 windows pierces the wall. With the exception of the basement windows and garage door, the windows of this elevation feature the

same square-edged wood molding appearing on the facade.

The rear of the building is dominated by a projecting porch which appears to have been enclosed. A single metal sliding glass door has been added to the porch, while a single 3/1 window is located within the enclosed porch, having been moved from another location. The second story dormer contains a pair of the same 3/1 sash windows surrounded with square-edged wood trim.

The building's southeast elevation is divided into four openings at the first story. The center two of these openings are located within the rectangular box-bay that projects from the principle plane of the southeast elevation. All four openings contain 3/1 windows of varying sizes. A pair of 3/1 windows marks the half-story above. The windows are all trimmed in square-edged wood moldings.

**OUTBUILDINGS:**

One outbuilding associated with 10787 Scaggsville Road stands southwest of the main dwelling. Constructed of concrete block, this one-story, side gable, three-car garage appears to have been built in the 1960s. Each bay is filled with a metal, overhead rolling door. The interior is lit by 2/2 windows, and the roof covered in asphalt shingles.

The modest Craftsman-style Bungalow dwelling at 10787 Scaggsville Road was erected in 1941 for Arthur E. Scaggs and his wife Bessie L. Scaggs. The building is representative of the Bungalow form which was popular in this area during the 1920s, 1930s, and 1940s. The Bungalow form offered the homeowner an economical dwelling easily erected and maintained.
