Description of Property and Eligibility Determination

This structure is a standard concrete rigid frame, with six-foot span. It lacks the requisite integrity as well as a sufficient degree of intact character-defining characteristics to be considered eligible for inclusion in the National Register as a type of small rigid frame.. To be considered for listing, according to the Small Structures on Maryland's Roads, Historic Context Report (p. 4-10) these structures should retain parapets, abutments and wingwalls as primary character defining elements of the substructure. Although this structure retains these elements, they are in very poor condition, compromising the integrity of the structure. Due to spalling, there has been a severe loss of section in these features.


