





LIVE-WORK UNITS ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS SETBACK REQUIREMENT. VISITOR PARKING AND OVERFLOW PARKING MAY ALSO BE ACCOMMODATED AS ON STREET AND PARALLEL PARKING WITHIN THE PUBLIC


DETAIL E-9-3 CURB INLET PROTECTION


DETAIL E-9-2 AT-GRADE INLET PROTECTION
