


TYPICAL WIDENING SECTION ALONG FOLLY QUARTER ROAD

PERMANENT SEEDING NOTES APPLY TO GRADED OR CLEARED AREA NOT SUBJECT TO IMMEDIATE FURTHER DISTURBANCE WHERE A PERMANENT LONG-LIVED VEGETATIVE COVER IS NEEDED. SEEDBED PREPARATION: LOOSEN UPPER THREE-INCHES OF SOIL BY RAKING, DISCING OR OTHER ACCEPTABLE MEANS BEFORE SEEDING.

SOIL AMENDMENTS: IN LIEU OF SOIL TEST RECOMMENDATIONS, USE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING 1) PREFERRED - APPLY 2 TONS PER ACRE DOLOMITIC LIMESTONE (92 LBS/1000 SQUARE FT) AND 600 LBS PER ACRE 10-10-10 FERTILIZER (14 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) BEFORE SEEDING. HARROW OR DISC INTO UPPER THREE-INCHES OF SOIL. AT TIME OF SEEDING, APPLY 400

LBS. PER ACRE 30-0-0 UREAFORM FERTILIZER (9 LBS/1000 SQ.FT. 2) ACCEPTABLE - APPLY 2 TONS PER ACRE DOLOMITIC LIMESTONE (92 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) AND 1000 LBS PER ACRE 10-10-10 FERTILIZER (23 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) BEFORE SEEDING. HARROW OR DISC INTO UPPER THREE-INCHES OF SOIL.

DING: FOR THE PERIODS MARCH 1 THRU APRIL 30, AND AUGUST 1 THRU OCTOBER 15, SEED WITH 60 LBS PER ACRE (1.4 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) OF KENTUCKY 31 TALL FESCUE. FOR THE PERIOD MAY 1 THRU JULY 31, SEED WITH 60 LBS KENTUCKY 31 TALL FESCUE PER ACRE AND 2 LBS PER ACRE (.05 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) OF WEEPING LOVEGRASS. DURING THE PERIOD OF OCTOBER 16 THRU FEBRUARY 28, PROTECT SITE BY: OPTION (1) 2 TONS PER ACRE OF WELL ANCHORED STRAW MULCH AND SEED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE IN THE SPRING. OPTION (2) USE SOD. OPTION (3) SEED WITH 60 LBS/ACRE KENTUCKY 31 TALL FESCUE AND MULCH WITH 2 TONS/ACRE WELL ANCHORED STRAW. MULCHING: APPLY 112 TO 2 TONS PER ACRE (70 TO 90 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) OF UNROTTED SMALL GRAIN STRAW IMMEDIATELY AFTER SEEDING. ANCHOR MULCH IMMEDIATELY AFTER APPLICATION USING MULCH ANCHORING TOOL OR 218 GALLONS PER ACRE (5 GAL/1000 SQ.FT.) OF EMULSIFIED ASPHALT ON FLAT AREAS. ON SLOPES 8 FEET OR HIGHER, USE 348 GALLONS PER ACRE (8 GAL/1000 SQ.FT.) FOR ANCHORING.


MAINTENANCE: INSPECT ALL SEEDED AREAS AND MAKE NEEDED REPAIRS, REPLACEMENTS AND TEMPORARY SEEDING NOTES:


APPLY TO GRADED OR CLEARED AREAS LIKELY TO BE REDISTURBED WHERE A SHORT-TERM VEGETATIVE

SEEDBED PREPARATION: LOOSEN UPPER THREE-INCHES OF SOIL BY RAKING, DISCING OR OTHER ACCEPTABLE MEANS BEFORE SEEDING.


SOIL AMENDMENTS: APPLY 600 LBS PER ACRE 10-10-10 FERTILIZER (14 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) SEEDING: FOR PERIODS MARCH 1 THRU APRIL 30 AND FROM AUGUST 15 THRU NOVEMBER 15, SEED WITH 21/2 BUSHEL PER ACRE OF ANNUAL RYE (3.2 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.). FOR THE PERIOD MAY 1 THRU AUGUST 14, SEED WITH 3 LBS PER ACRE OF WEEPING LOVEGRASS (.07 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.). FOR THE PERIOD NOVEMBER 16 THRU FEBRUARY 28, PROTECT SITE BY APPLYING 2 TONS PER ACRE OF WELL ANCHORED STRAW MULCH AND SEED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE IN THE SPRING, OR USE SOD. MULCHING: APPLY 11/2 TO 2 TONS PER ACRE (70 TO 90 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) OF UNROTTED SMALL GRAIN STRAW IMMEDIATELY AFTER SEEDING. ANCHOR MULCH IMMEDIATELY AFTER APPLICATION USING MULCH ANCHORING TOOL OR 218 GAL PER ACRE (5 GAL/1000 SQ.FT.) OF EMULSIFIED ASPHALT ON FLAT AREAS. ON SLOPES, 8 FT. OR HIGHER, USE 348 GAL PER ACRE (8 GAL/1000 SQ.FT.) FOR ANCHORING.

REFER TO THE 1983 MARYLAND STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL FOR RATE AND METHODS NOT COVERED.





- 1. BALES SHALL BE PLACED AT THE TOE OF A SLOPE OR ON THE CONTOUR AND IN A ROM WITH
- 2. Each bale shall be embedded in the soil a minimum of (4) inches, and placed so 3. Bales shall be securely anchored in place by either two stakes or re-bars driven through the bale. The first stake in each bale shall be driven toward the previously laid bale at an angle to force the bales together. Stakes shall be
- 4. Inspection shall be frequent and repair replacement shall be made promptly as

TYPE OR 2" HARDHOOD 1. Noven wire fence to be fastened securely 2. FILTER CLOTH TO BE FASTENED SECURELY TO MOVEN WIRE FENCE WITH TIES SPACED EVERY 24" AT TOP AND MID SECTION.

3. WEN TWO SECTIONS OF FILTER CLOTH ADJOIN EACH OTHER THEY SHALL BE OVER-LAPPED BY SIX INCHES AND FOLDED.

4. MAINTENANCE SHALL BE PERFORMED AS NEEDED AND MATERIAL REMOVED HIEN BULGES" DEVELOP IN THE SILT FENCE. PREFABRICATED UNIT: GEOFAB, ENVIROFENCE, OR APPROVED

CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCE:

1. OBTAIN GRADING PERMIT. 2. REMOVE EXISTING HEADWALL AND INSTALL THE METAL END SECTION

AND 18" CMP AS SHOWN ON SHEET 1. 3. GRADE SHOULDER AND DITCH ALONG FOLLY QUARTER ROAD.

4. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PLACE STRAW BALE DIKES OR SILT FENCE ALONG FOLLY QUARTER ROAD DOWNGRADE OF ANY DISTURBED AREA AT THE END OF EACH WORKING DAY.

5. DURING CONSTRUCTION AND AFTER EACH RAINFALL, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL INSPECT AND PROVIDE NECESSARY MAINTENANCE ON THE SEDIMENT AND EROSION CONTROL STRUCTURES SHOWN HEREON. 6. ALL DISTURBED AREAS DUE TO REMOVAL OF SEDIMENT CONTROL

MEASURES SHALL BE GRADED AND STABILIZED BY PERMANENT SEEDING. 7. FOLLOWING INITIAL SOIL DISTURBANCE OR REDISTURBANCE. PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY STABILIZATION SHALL BE COMPLETED WITHIN: a) 7 CALENDAR DAYS FOR ALL PERIMETER SEDIMENT CONTROL STRUCTURES, DIKES, SWALES, DITCH PERIMETER SLOPES AND ALL SLOPES GREATER THAN 3:1; b) 14 DAYS FOR ALL OTHER DISTURBED-OR GRADED AREAS ON THE PROJECT SITE.

SEDIMENT CONTROL NOTES:

1) A MINIMUM OF 24 HOURS NOTICE MUST BE GIVEN TO THE HOWARD COUNTY OFFICE OF INSPECTIONS AND PERMITS PRIOR TO THE START OF ANY CONSTRUCTION

2) ALL VEGETATIVE AND STRUCTURAL PRACTICES ARE TO BE INSTALLED ACCORDING TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS PLAN AND ARE TO BE IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE 1983 MARYLAND STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL.

3) FOLLOWING INITIAL SOIL DISTURBANCE OR REDISTURBANCE, PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY STABILIZATION SHALL BE COMPLETED WITHIN: a) 7 CALENDAR DAYS FOR ALL PERIMETER SEDIMENT CONTROL STRUCTURES, DIKES, PERIMETER SLOPES AND ALL SLOPES GREATER THAN 3:1, b) 14 DAYS AS TO ALL OTHER DISTURBED OR GRADED AREAS ON THE PROJECT SITE.

4) ALL SEDIMENT TRAPS/BASINS SHOWN MUST BE FENCED AND WARNING SIGNS POSTED AROUND THEIR PERIMETER IN ACCORDANCE WITH VOL. 1, CHAPTER 12. OF THE HOWARD COUNTY DESIGN MANUAL, STORM DRAINAGE.

5) ALL DISTURBED AREAS MUST BE STABILIZED WITHIN THE TIME PERIOD SPECIFIED ABOVE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 1983 MARYLAND STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL FOR PERMANENT SEEDINGS (SEC. 51) SOD (SEC. 54), TEMPORARY SEEDING (SEC. 50) AND MULCHING (SEC. 52). TEMPORARY STABILIZATION WITH MULCH ALONE CAN ONLY BE DONE WHEN RECOMMENDED SEEDING DATES DO NOT ALLOW FOR PROPER GERMINATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF GRASSES.

6) ALL SEDIMENT CONTROL STRUCTURES ARE TO REMAIN IN PLACE AND ARE TO BE MAINTAINED IN OPERATIVE CONDITION UNTIL PERMISSION FOR THEIR REMOVAL HAS BEEN OBTAINED FROM THE HOWARD COUNTY SEDIMENT CONTROL INSPECTOR.

7) SITE ANALYSIS: TOTAL AREA OF SITE AREA DISTURBED ACRES AREA TO BE ROOFED OR PAVED ACRES AREA TO BE VEGETATIVELY STABILIZED ACRES CU.YDS. ____ CU.YDS. OFFSITE WASTE/BORROW AREA LOCATION

8) ANY SEDIMENT CONTROL PRACTICE WHICH IS DISTURBED BY GRADING ACTIVITY FOR PLACEMENT OF UTILITIES MUST BE REPAIRED ON THE SAME DAY OF

9) ADDITIONAL SEDIMENT CONTROLS MUST BE PROVIDE, IF DEEMED NECESSARY BY THE HOWARD COUNTY DPW SEDIMENT CONTROL INSPECTOR.

10)ON ALL SITES WITH DISTURBED AREAS IN EXCESS OF 2 ACRES, APPROVAL OF THE INSPECTION AGENCY SHALL BE REQUESTED UPON COMPLETION OF INSTALLATION OF PERIMETER EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROLS, BUT BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH ANY OTHER EARTH DISTURBANCE OR GRADING. OTHER BUILDING OR GRADING INSPECTION APPROVALS MAY NOT BE AUTHORIZED UNTIL THIS INITIAL APPROVAL BY THE INSPECTION AGENCY IS MADE.
