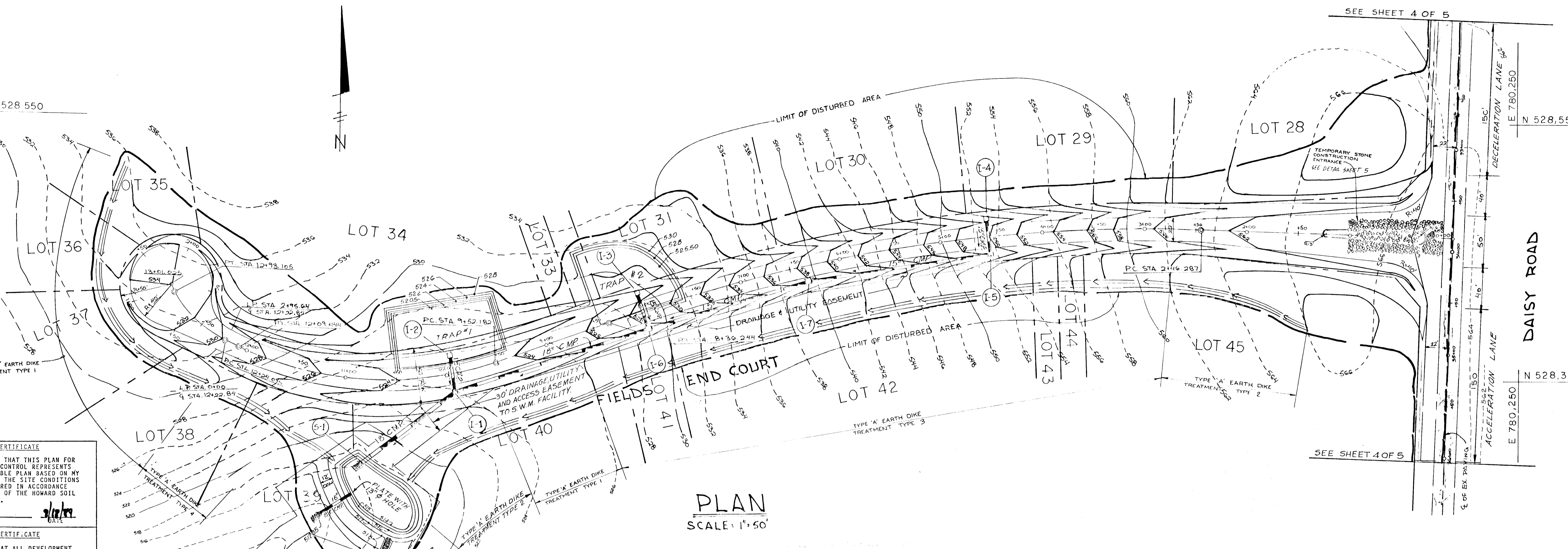

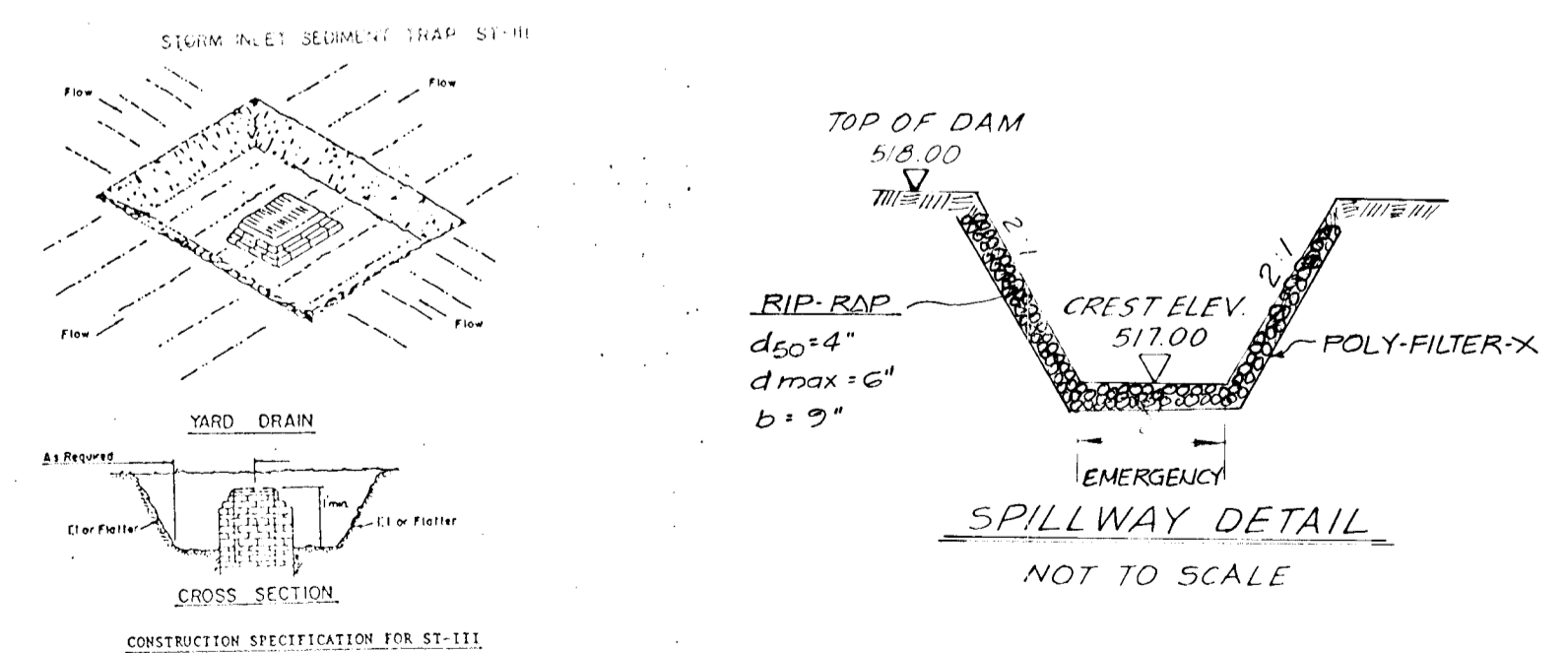

- OBTAIN GRADING PERMIT.
 - EXTEND EX. 18" C.M.P. AT STA. 38+65 DAISY ROAD AND INSTALL 6" SHOW ON SHEET 4.
 - INSTALL STRAW BAIL DIKES AND OR SILT FENCE ALONG DAISY ROAD AS SHOWN ON SHEET 4.
 - WIDEN AND GRADE DAISY ROAD ACCORDING TO TYPICAL WIDENING SECTION AND PLAN VIEW AS SHOWN ON SHEET 4.
 - CONSTRUCT STORM DRAIN SYSTEM FROM S-1 TO I-5.
 - CONSTRUCT STORM DRAIN SYSTEM FROM S-1 TO I-5.
 - INSTALL EARTH DIKES AS SHOWN ON SHEET 3.
 - INSTALL STORM INLET, SEDIMENT TRAPS #1 AND #2, AS SHOWN ON SHEET 3.
 - INSTALL S.W.M. FACILITY.

- Sediment shall be removed and the trap restored to its original dimensions when the sediment has accumulated to the design depth of the trap. Removed sediment shall be deposited in a suitable area and in such a manner that it will not erode.
- The volume of sediment storage shall be 1800 cubic feet per acre of contributory drainage.
- The structure shall be inspected after each rain and repairs made as needed.
- Construction operations shall be carried out in such a manner that erosion and sediment pollution shall be minimized.
- The sediment trap shall be removed and the area stabilized when the contributory drainage area has been properly stabilized.
- All out slopes shall be 1:1 or flatter.

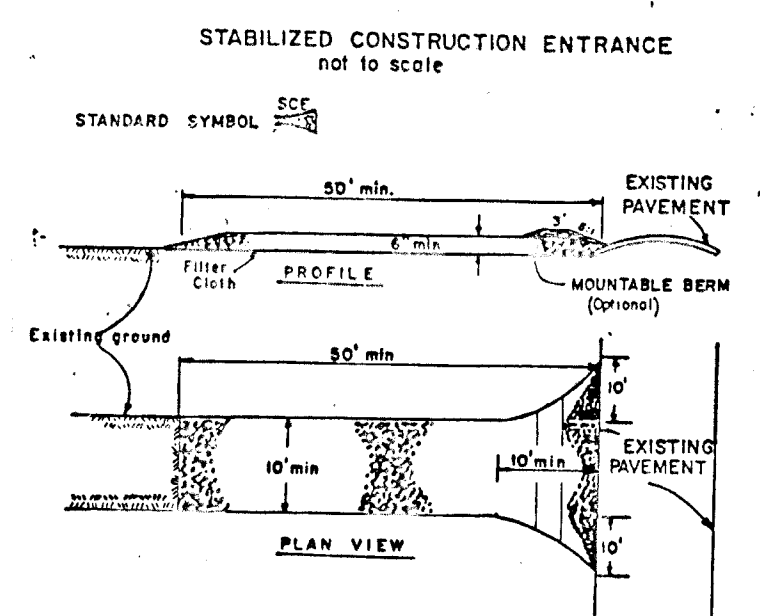

- A MINIMUM OF 24 HOURS NOTICE MUST BE GIVEN TO THE HOWARD COUNTY OFFICE OF INSPECTIONS AND PERMITS PRIOR TO THE START OF ANY CONSTRUCTION TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS PLAN AND ARE TO BE IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE 1983 MARYLAND STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL.
 - FOLLOWING INITIAL SOIL DISTURBANCE OR REDISTURBANCE, PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY STABILIZATION SHALL BE COMPLETED WITHIN: a) 7 CALENDAR DAYS FOR ALL PERIMETER SEDIMENT CONTROL STRUCTURES, DIKES, PERIMETER SLOPES AND ALL SLOPES GREATER THAN 3:1, b) 14 DAYS AS TO ALL OTHER DISTURBED OR GRADED AREAS ON THE PROJECT SITE.

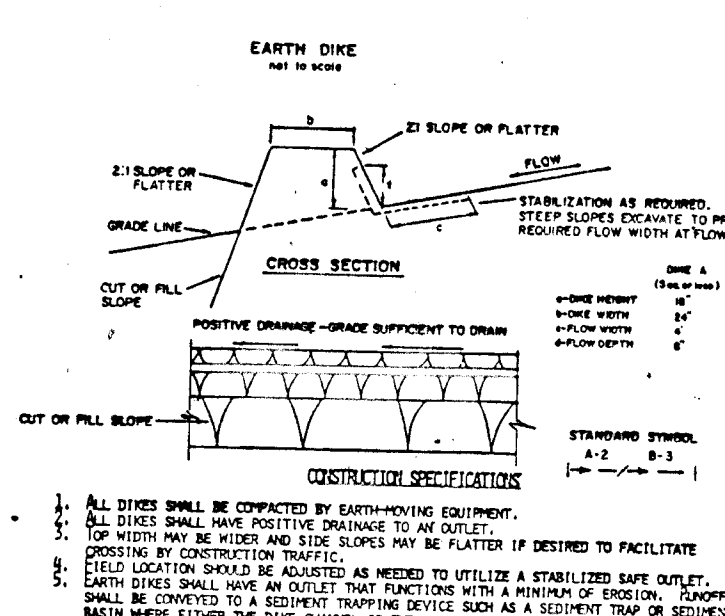

- CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATIONS**
- Stone Size - One 2" stone, or related or recycled concrete equivalent.
 - Length - As required, but not less than 50 feet (except on a single residence lot where a 25 foot minimum length would apply).
 - Thickness - Not less than six (6) inches.
 - Width - Ten (10) foot minimum, but not less than the full width at points where ingress or egress occurs.
 - Filter Cloth - Will be placed over the entire area prior to placing of stone. Filter will not be required on a single family residence lot.
 - Surface Finish - All surface water flowing or directed to and passing through entrance shall be piped across the entrance. If piping is impractical, a mountable beam with 2" diameter will be provided.
 - Maintenance - The entrance shall be maintained in a condition which will prevent tracking or flowing of sediment onto public right-of-way. This may require periodic top dressing with additional stone as conditions demand and rapid and/or cleanout of any weirs used to trap sediment. All sediment spilled, dropped, washed or tracked onto public right-of-way must be removed immediately.
 - Washing - Weirs shall be cleaned to remove sediment prior to entrance onto public right-of-way. When washing is required, it shall be done on an area stabilized with stone and which drains into an approved sediment trapping device.
 - Periodic inspection and needed maintenance shall be provided after each rain.



- EARTH DIKE CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATIONS**
- All dikes shall be constructed by earthmoving equipment.
 - All dikes shall have positive drainage to an outlet.
 - Top of dike shall be finished with a minimum of 12 inches of compacted earth.
 - Diagrams shall be provided to show the location of the dike, the location of the outlet, and the location of the sediment trap.

PERMANENT SEEDING NOTES

APPLY TO GRADED OR CLEARED AREA NOT SUBJECT TO IMMEDIATE FURTHER DISTURBANCE WHERE A PERMANENT LONG-LIVED VEGETATIVE COVER IS NEEDED.

SEEDING PREPARATION: LOOSEN UPPER THREE-INCHES OF SOIL BY RAKING, DISCING OR OTHER ACCEPTABLE MEANS BEFORE SEEDING. IF NOT PREVIOUSLY LOOSENED, SOIL AMENDMENTS: IN LIEU OF SOIL TEST RECOMMENDATIONS, USE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULES:

- PREFERRED - APPLY 2 TONS PER ACRE DOLOMITIC LIMESTONE (90 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) AND 400 LBS PER ACRE 10-10-10 FERTILIZER (14 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) BEFORE SEEDING.
- ACCEPTABLE - APPLY 30-0-0 UREAFORM FERTILIZER (4 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) AND 1000 LBS PER ACRE 10-10-10 FERTILIZER (23 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) BEFORE SEEDING. HARROW OR DISC INTO UPPER THREE-INCHES OF SOIL.

SEEDING: FOR THE PERIODS MARCH 1 THRU APRIL 30, AND AUGUST 1 THRU OCTOBER 15, SEED WITH 40 LBS. PER ACRE (1.4 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) OF KENTUCKY 31 TALL FESCUE. FOR THE PERIOD MAY 1 THRU JULY 31, SEED WITH 40 LBS. KENTUCKY 31 TALL FESCUE PER ACRE AND 2 LBS. PER ACRE (.05 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) OF WHEEPING LOVEGRASS. DURING THE PERIOD OF OCTOBER 15 THRU FEBRUARY 28, PROTECT SITE BY: OPTION (1) 2 TONS PER ACRE OF WELL ANCHORED STRAW MULCH AND SEED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE IN THE SPRING. OPTION (2) USE 300 LBS PER ACRE (30 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) OF UNWOTTED SMALL STRAIN STRAW IMMEDIATELY AFTER SEEDING. ANCHOR MULCH IMMEDIATELY AFTER APPLICATION USING MULCH ANCHORING TOOL OR 210 GALLONS PER ACRE (4 GAL/1000 SQ.FT.) OF EMULSIFIED ASPHALT ON FLAT AREAS. ON SLOPES 8 FEET OR HIGHER, USE 240 GALLONS PER ACRE (24 GAL/1000 SQ.FT.) FOR ANCHORING. MAINTENANCE: INSPECT ALL SEEDER AREAS AND MAKE REPAIRS, REPLACEMENTS AND RESEEDINGS.

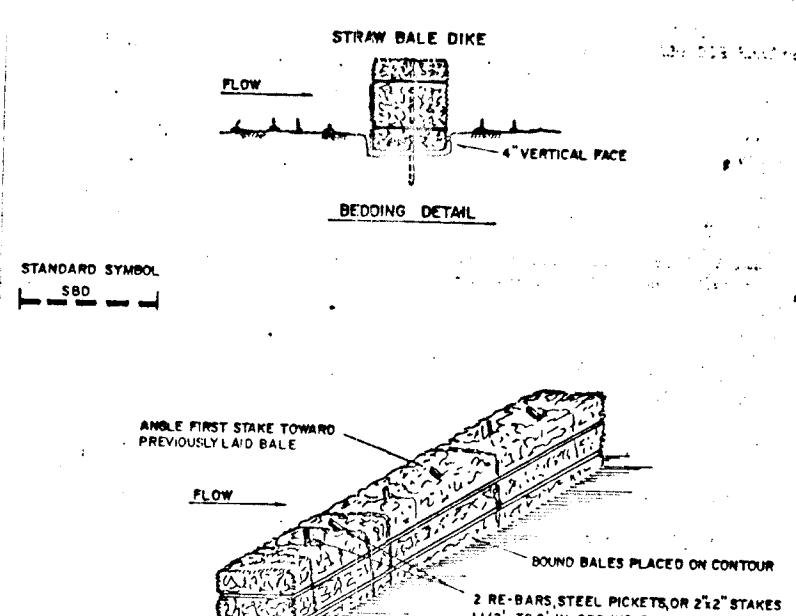

APPLY TO GRADED OR CLEARED AREAS SUBJECT TO BE REDISTURBED WHERE A SHORT-TERM VEGETATIVE COVER IS NEEDED.

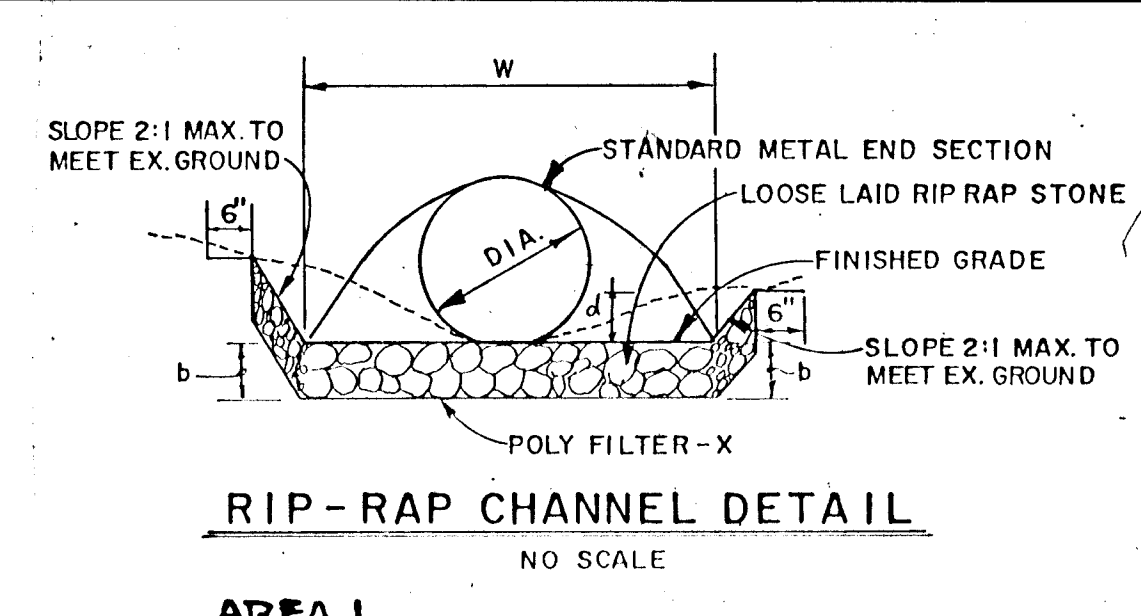
SEEDING PREPARATION: LOOSEN UPPER THREE-INCHES OF SOIL BY RAKING, DISCING OR OTHER ACCEPTABLE MEANS BEFORE SEEDING. IF NOT PREVIOUSLY LOOSENED, SOIL AMENDMENTS: APPLY 600 LBS PER ACRE 10-10-10 FERTILIZER (14 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.)

SEEDING: FOR PERIODS MARCH 1 THRU APRIL 30 AND FROM AUGUST 1 THRU NOVEMBER 15, SEED WITH 1/2 BUDEL PER ACRE OF ANNUAL RYE (32 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.). FOR THE PERIOD MAY 1 THRU APRIL 30, SEED WITH 1 LBS PER ACRE OF RYEGRASS (107 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.). FOR THE PERIOD NOVEMBER 16 THRU FEBRUARY 28, PROTECT SITE BY APPLYING 2 TONS PER ACRE (200 LBS/1000 SQ.FT.) OF UNWOTTED SMALL STRAIN STRAW IMMEDIATELY AFTER SEEDING. ANCHOR MULCH IMMEDIATELY AFTER APPLICATION USING MULCH ANCHORING TOOL OR 210 GAL PER ACRE (21 GAL/1000 SQ.FT.) OF EMULSIFIED ASPHALT ON FLAT AREAS. ON SLOPES 8 FT. OR HIGHER, USE 240 GAL PER ACRE (24 GAL/1000 SQ.FT.) FOR ANCHORING.

- STRAW BALE DIKE CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATIONS**
- Bales shall be placed in the toe of a slope or on the contour and in a row with ends tightly abutting the adjacent bales.
 - Each bale shall be covered in the soil a minimum of (6) inches, and placed so the openings are horizontal.
 - Bales shall be securely anchored in place by either two stakes on the inside of the dike, or one stake on the inside and one stake on the outside. Stakes shall be driven flush with the dike.
 - Inspection shall be provided and repair replacement shall be made promptly as needed.
 - Bales shall be removed when they have served their usefulness so as not to block or impede storm flow or drainage.



AREA 1 RIP-RAP CHANNEL DESIGN DATA

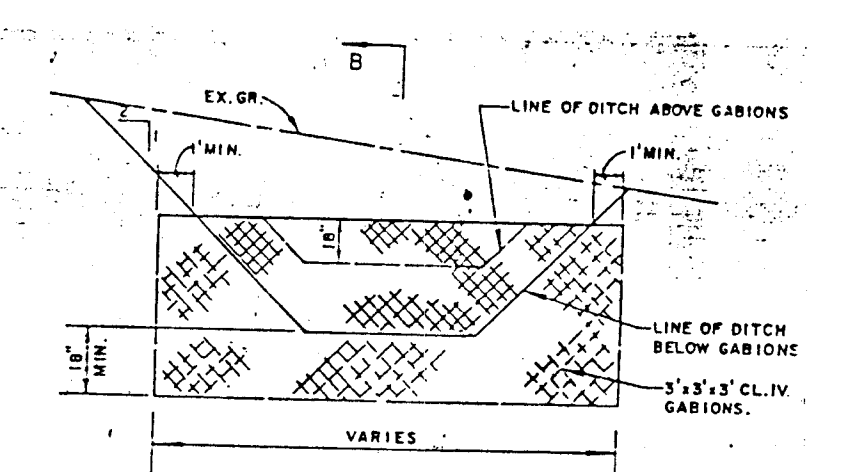
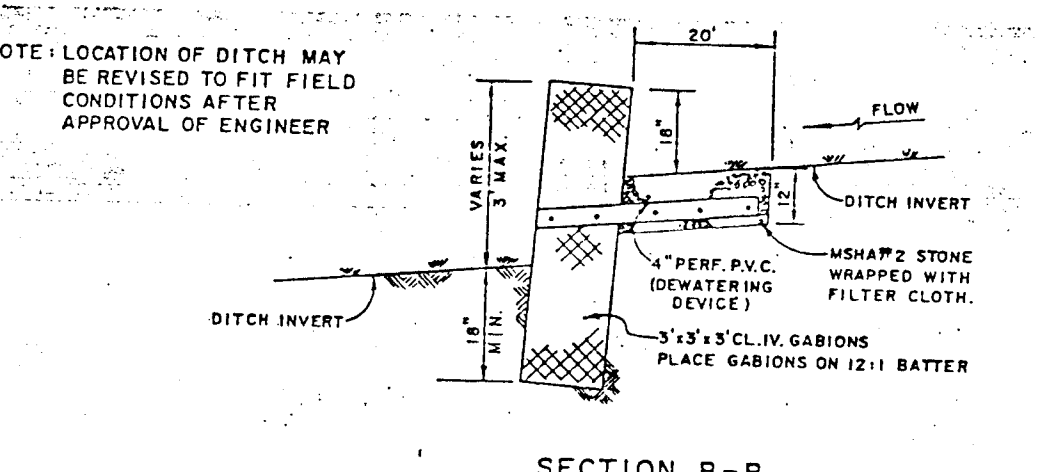
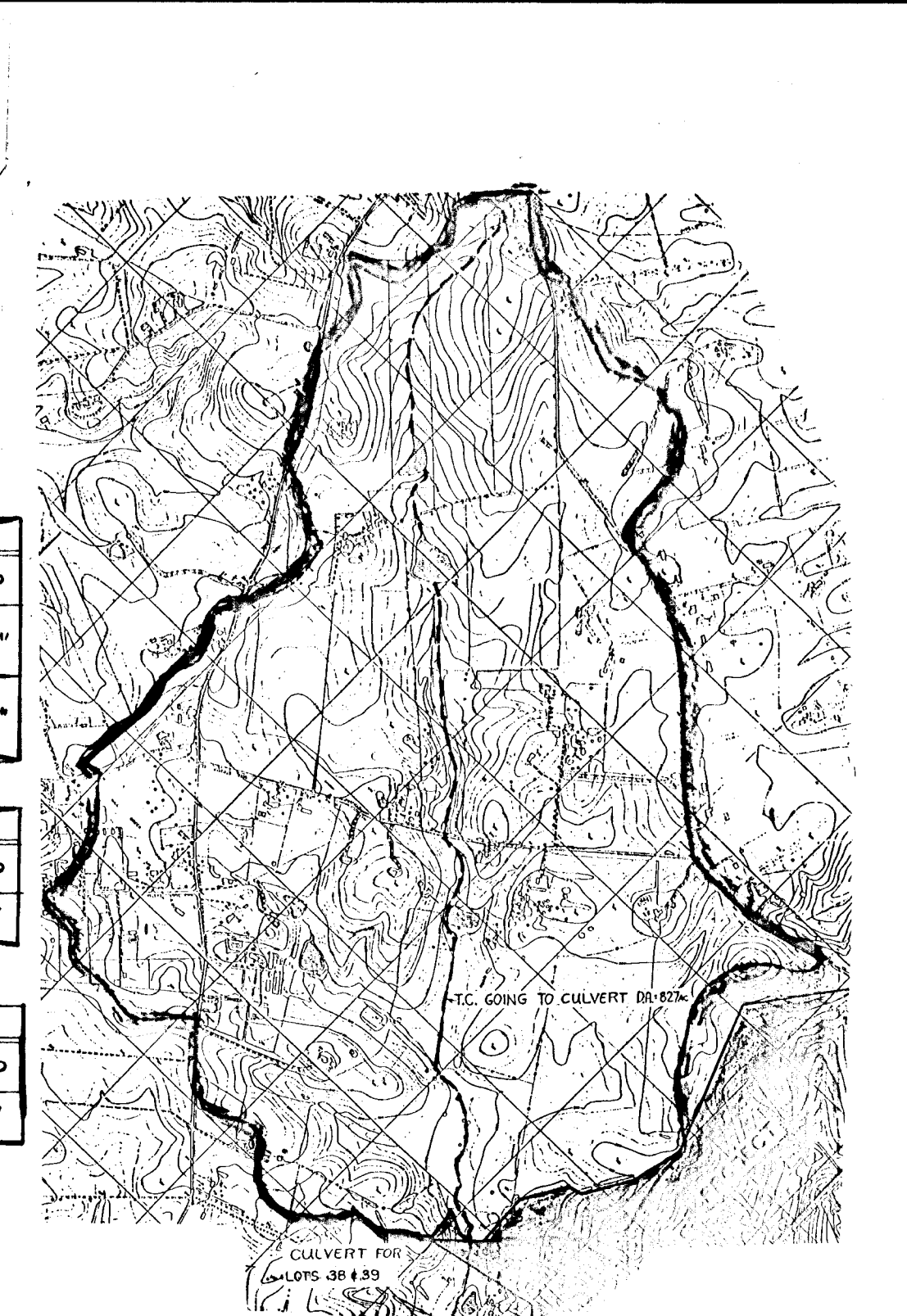

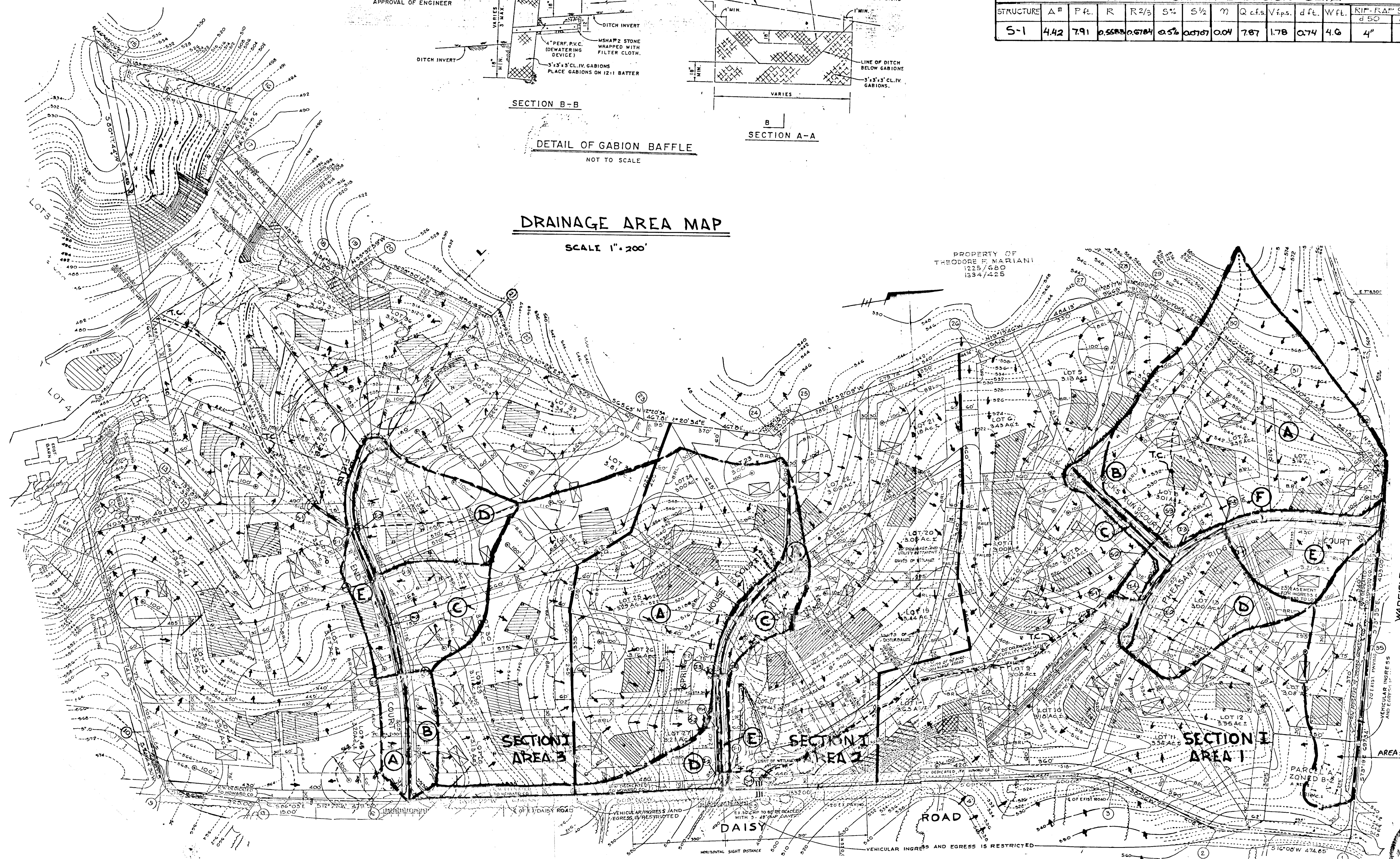
