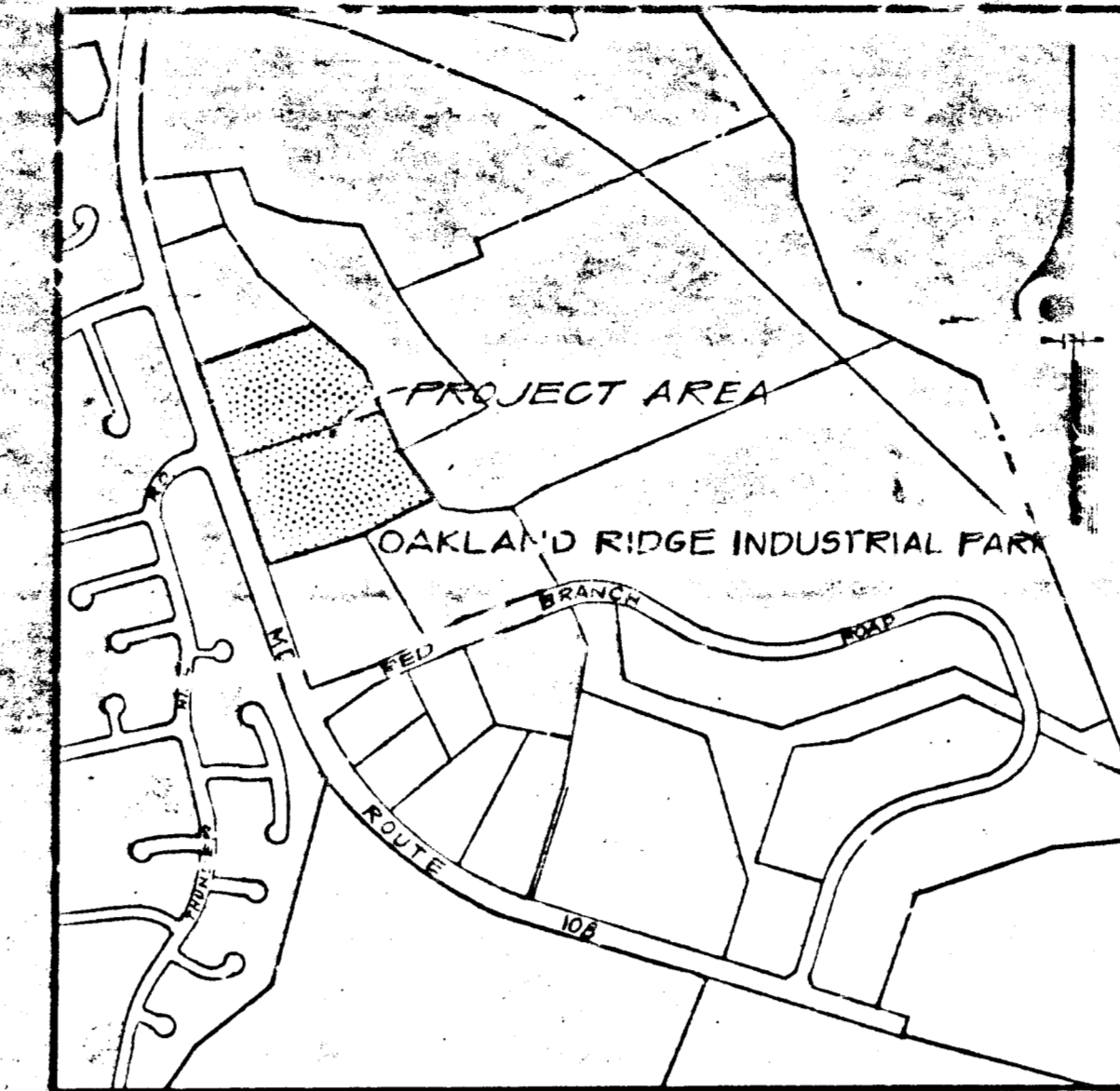

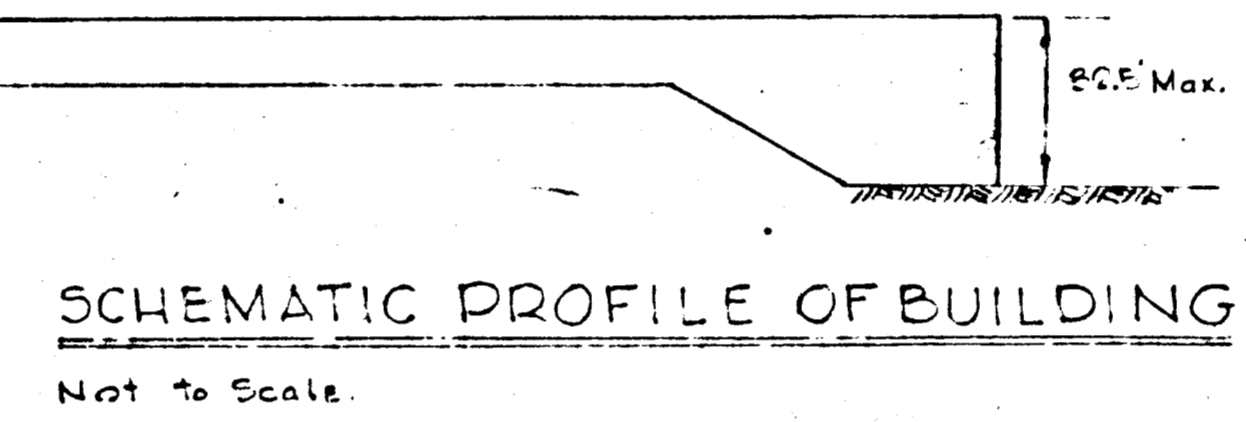
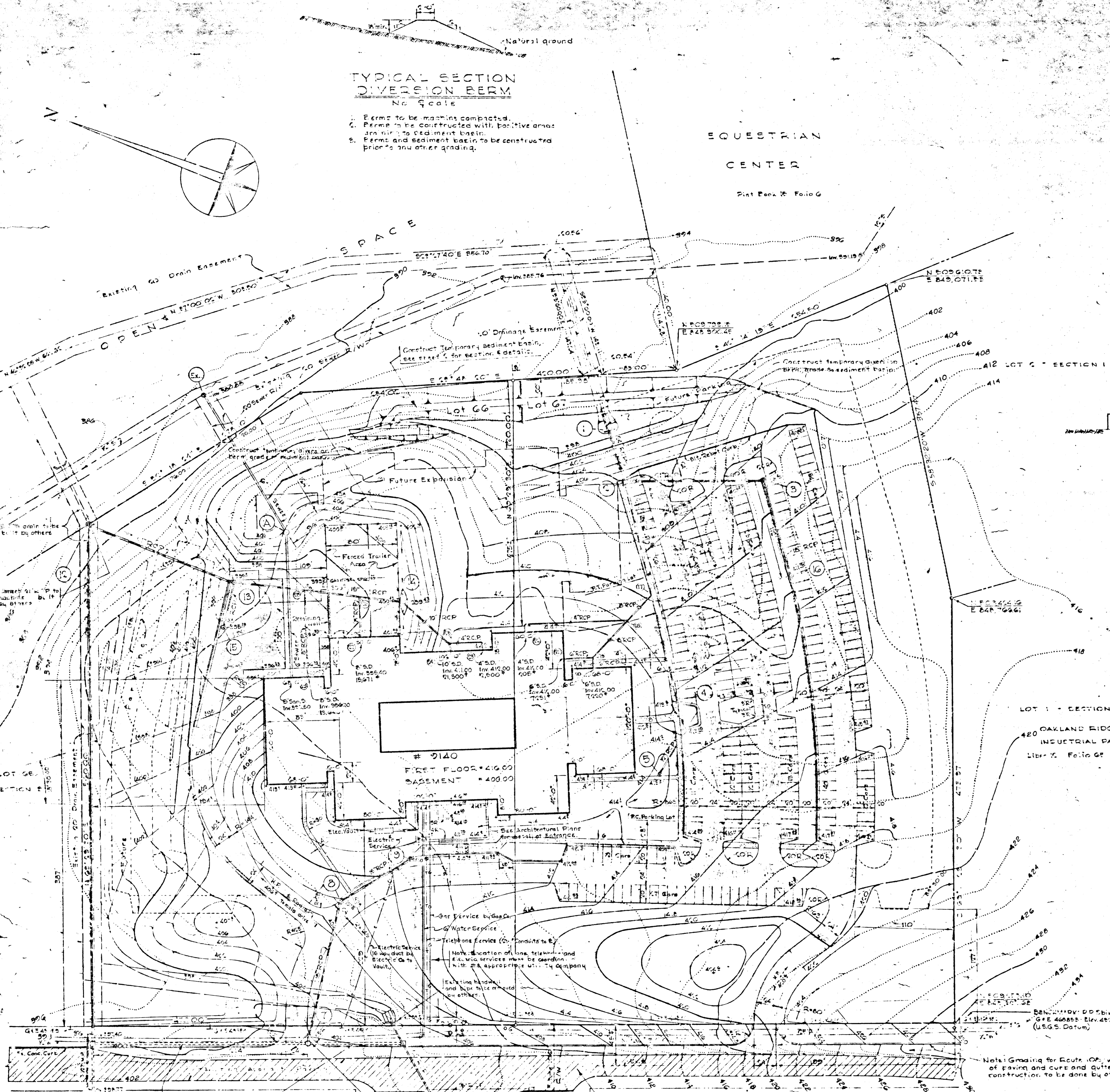

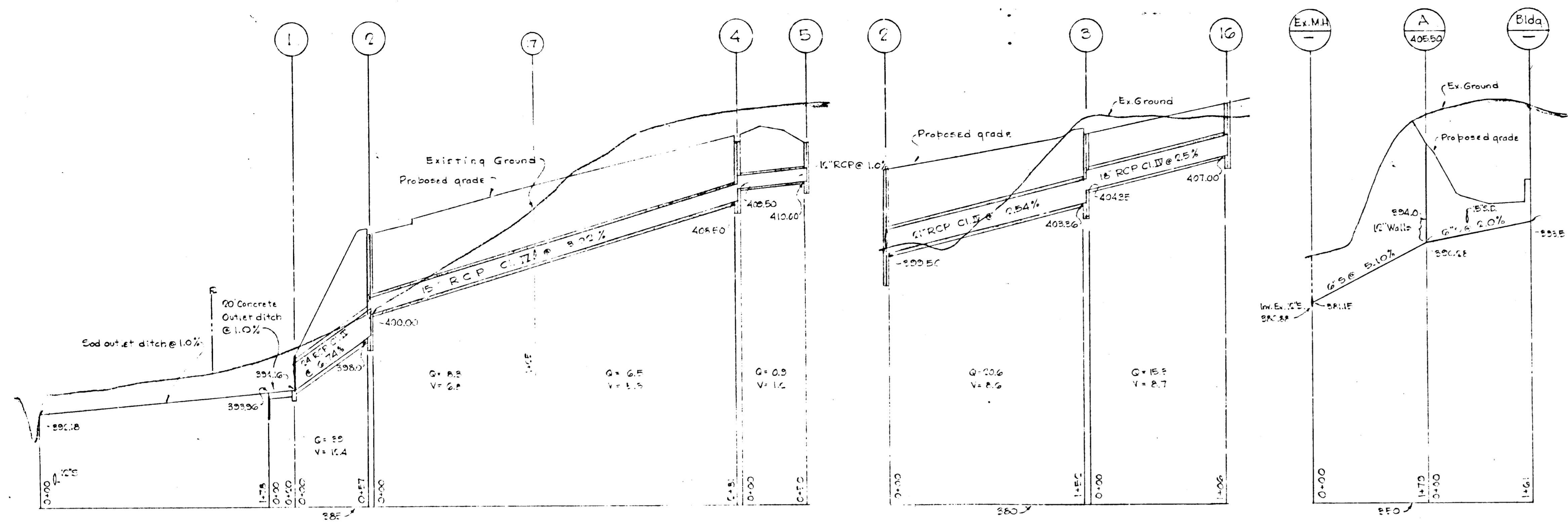

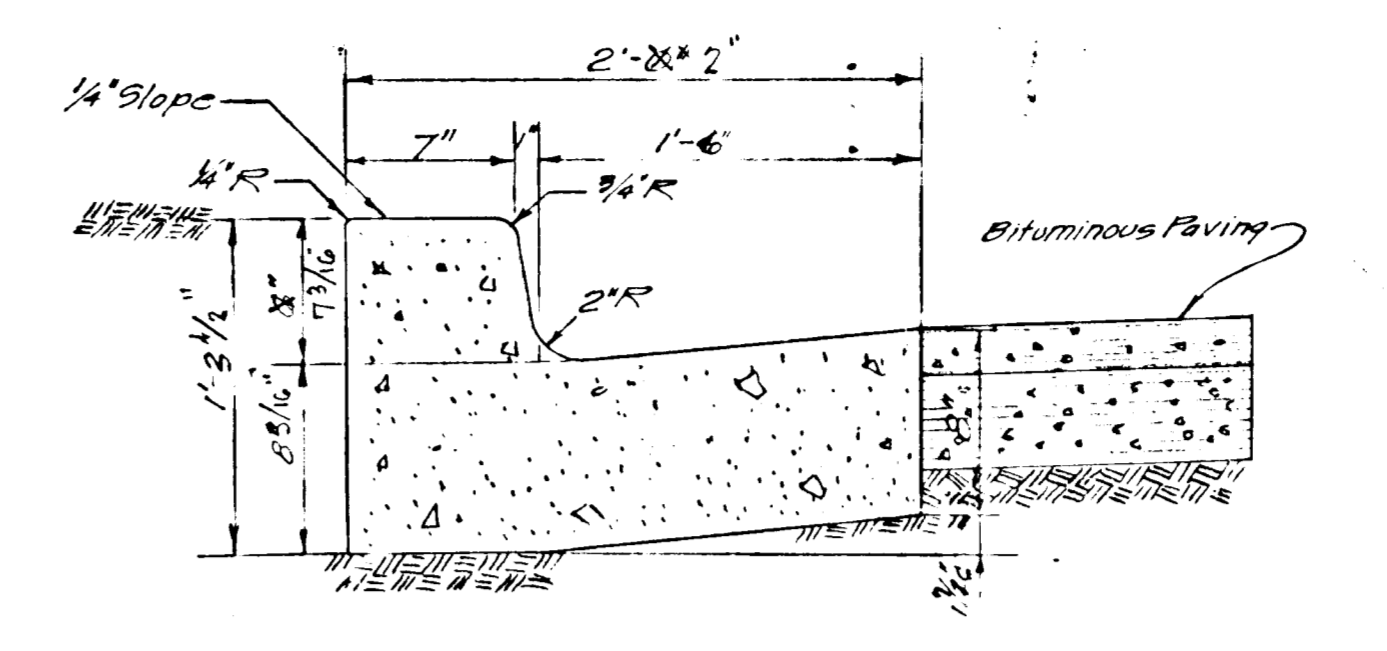

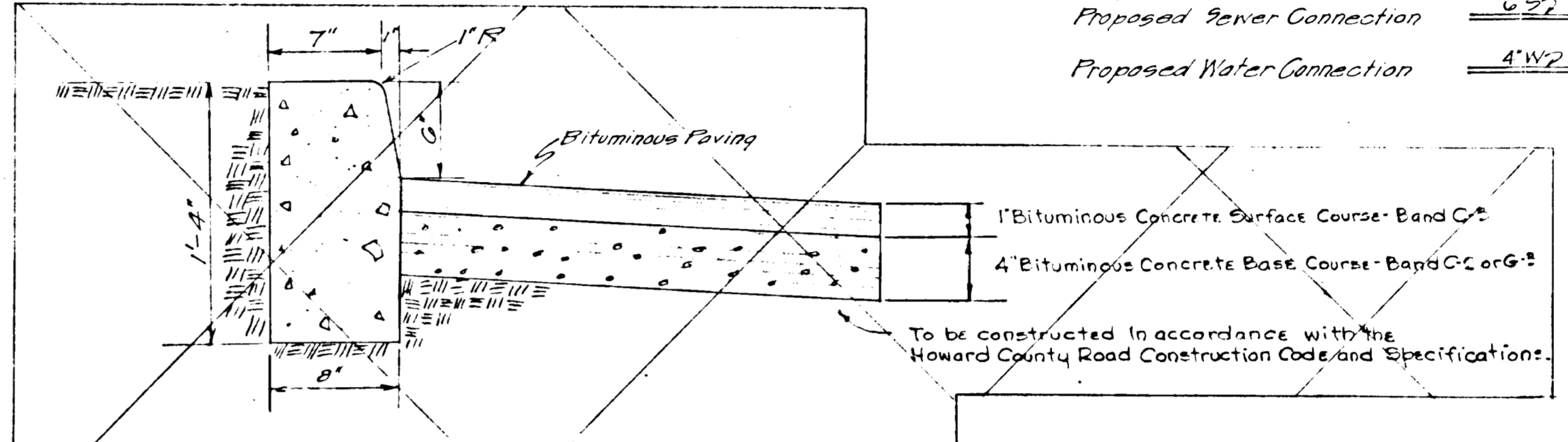

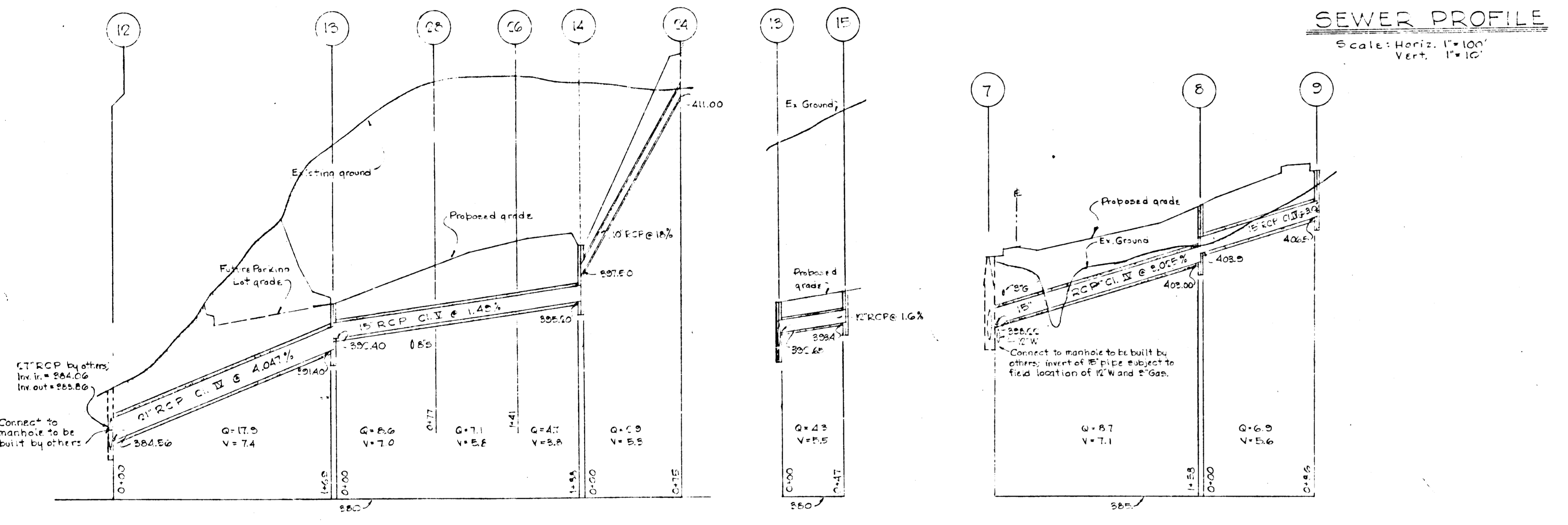
CONCRETE CURB AND GUTTER

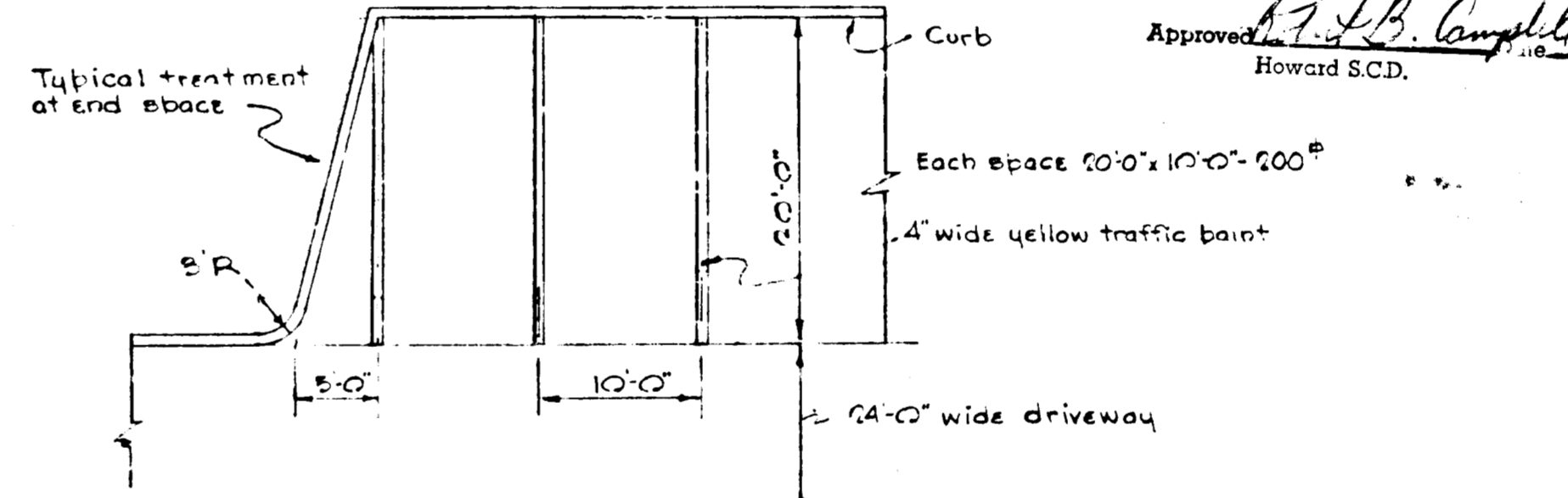
CONCRETE HEADER CURB

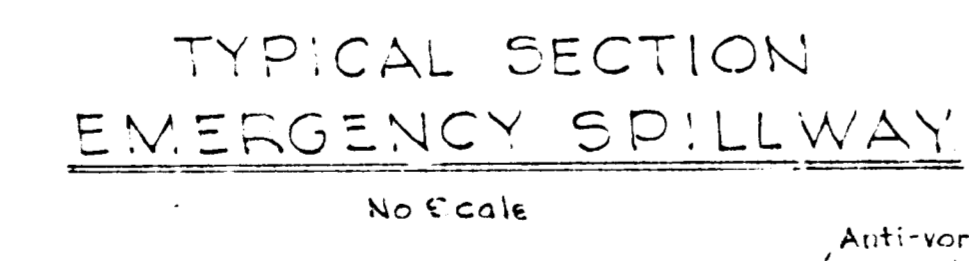

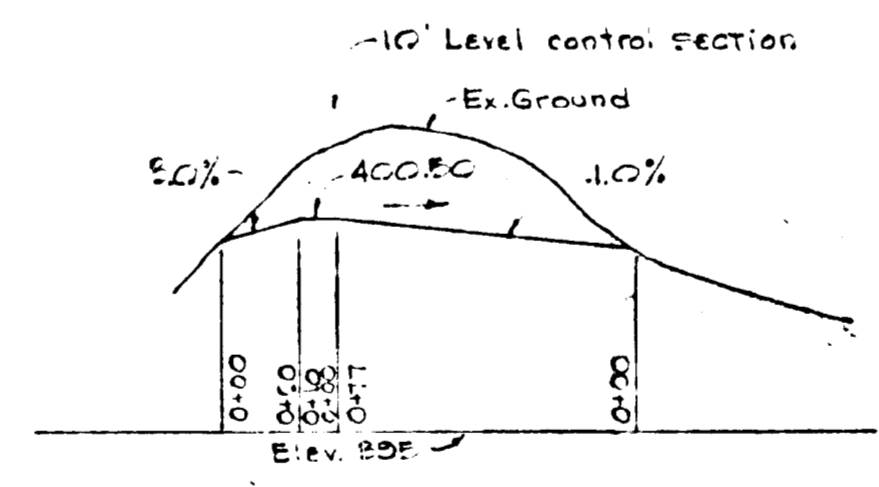

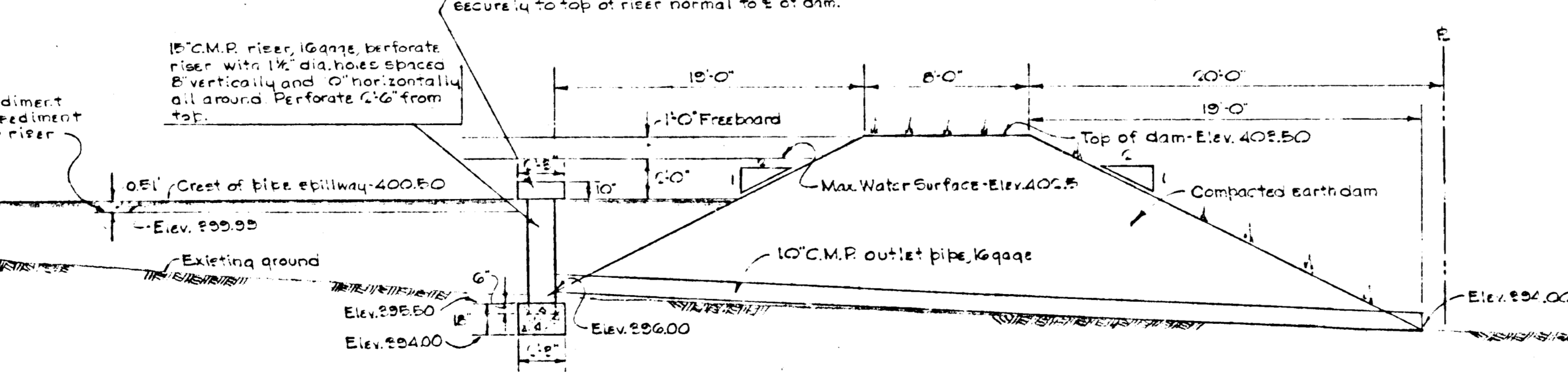
TYPICAL SECTION-CONCRETE OUTLET DITCH

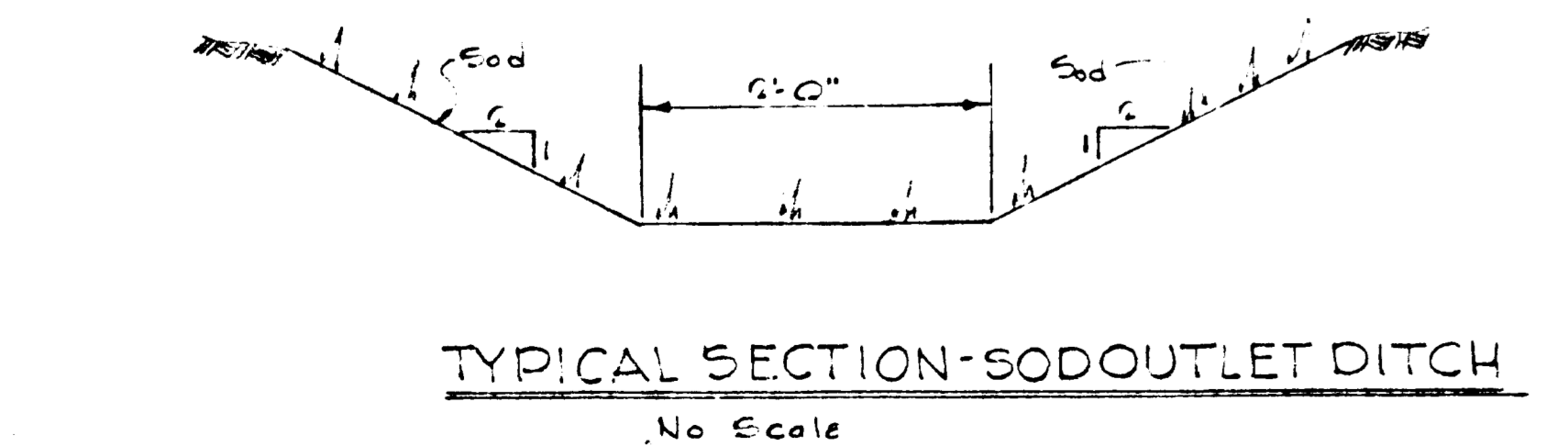
TYPICAL SECTION EMERGENCY SPILLWAY

SEDIMENT CONTROL BASIN
Scale: 1"=10'

- Site Preparation** - Areas under the embankment and any structural works shall be cleared, grubbed and the topsoil stripped to remove all trees, vegetation, roots or other objectional material. The soil area (measured at the top of the pipe opening) shall be cleared of all brush and trees.
- Embankment** - The fill material shall be taken from approved designated borrow areas. It shall be free of roots, wood, vegetation, waste stones, rocks or other objectionable materials. The use of frozen material will not be permitted. The contractor's embankment shall be raised to an elevation which provides for anticipated settlement to design elevation.
Placement - Areas on which fill is to be placed shall be scarified prior to placement of fill. Fill materials shall be placed in 6" maximum lifts which are to be continuous over the entire length of the fill.
Excavation - The movement of the hauling and spreading equipment over the fill shall be controlled so that the entire surface of each lift will be traversed by not less than one tread track of the equipment or conjection shall be achieved through use of a roller.
- Pipe Spillway Installation** - The riser shall be rigidly and securely fastened to the bars and the bottom of the riser shall be sealed watertight. All pipe joints shall be securely fastened and watertight.
- Emergency Spillway Installation** - Emergency spillways must be installed on undisturbed soil (fill on fill) by grading. Side slopes shall not be steeper than 2:1.
- Structural Backfill** - Backfill material shall be of the type and quality conforming to that specified for the adjoining fill material. The material shall be placed in maximum 4 inch lifts and hand compacted to equal or exceed the density of the adjoining fill.
- Seeding** - Stabilize embankment and emergency spillway by treatment (lime and fertilizer) and seeding or sodding and mulching. Seeding and mulching to be in accordance with the Howard County Soil Conservation District Specifications as listed below.
 - Seeding per acre:
 - 40-70 lbs. tall fescue (N-31)
 - 2 lbs. of white clover and/or
 - 8 lbs. of Korean lespedeza (for spring or summer seedings)
 - Lime + apply ground limestone at the rate of 2 tons per acre
 - Fertilizer - Apply 400 pounds of triple superphosphate (45% or the equivalent) work this into the top 3" of seeded and apply 1000 lbs per acre of 10-10-10 fertilizer or the equivalent.
 - Time of seeding to be immediately after final grading.
- Diversion Control** - Sediment control basin and diversion berm are to be constructed before any other grading. Graded areas that are not to be covered with paving or final sodding or seeding right away shall be temporarily seeded with the above seeding specification.

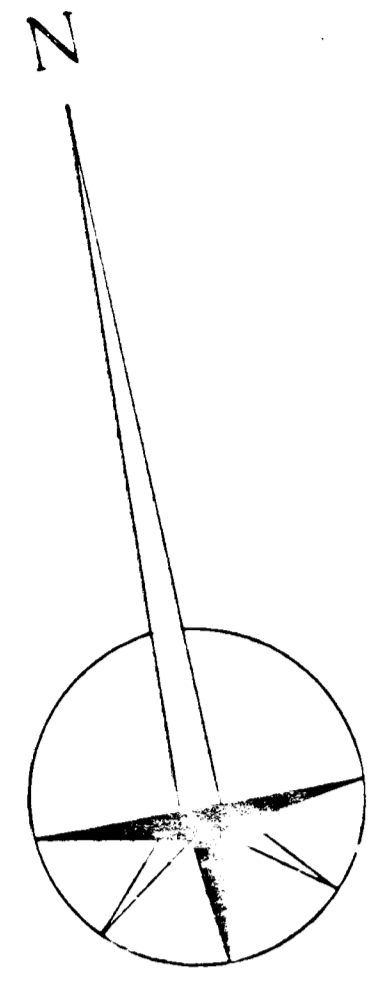

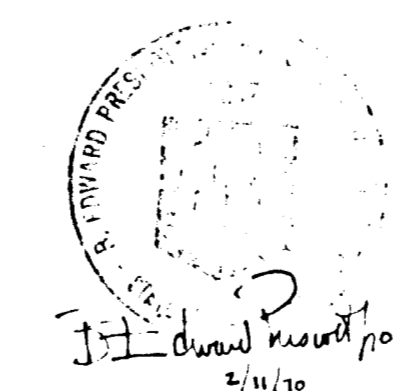

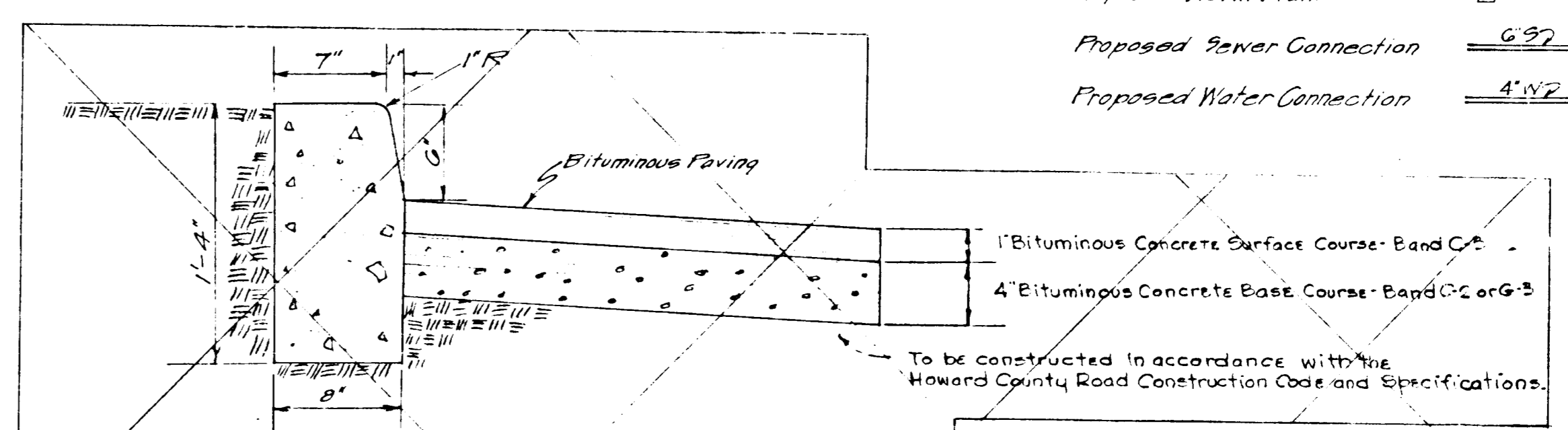

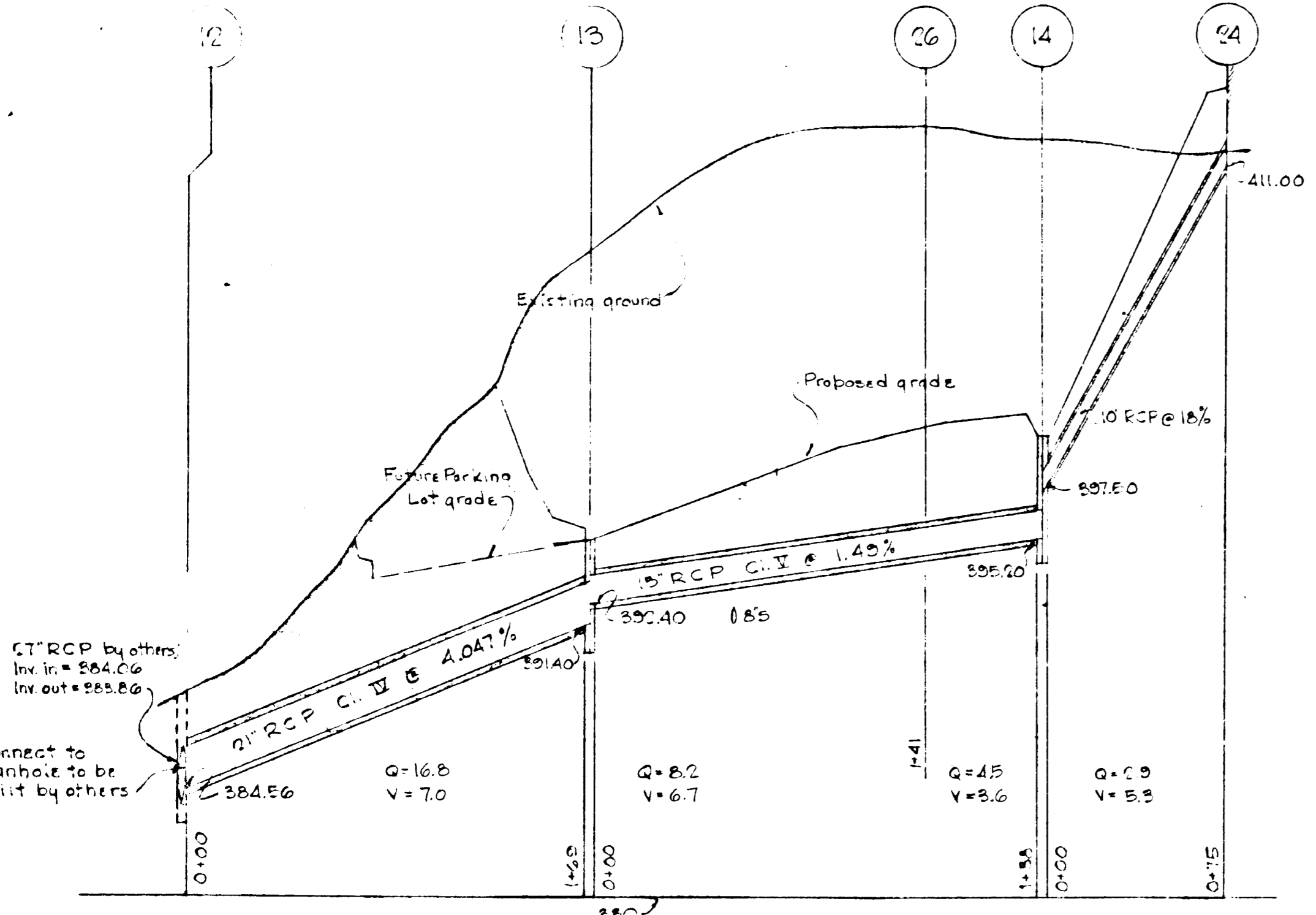
CONCRETE CURB AND GUTTER

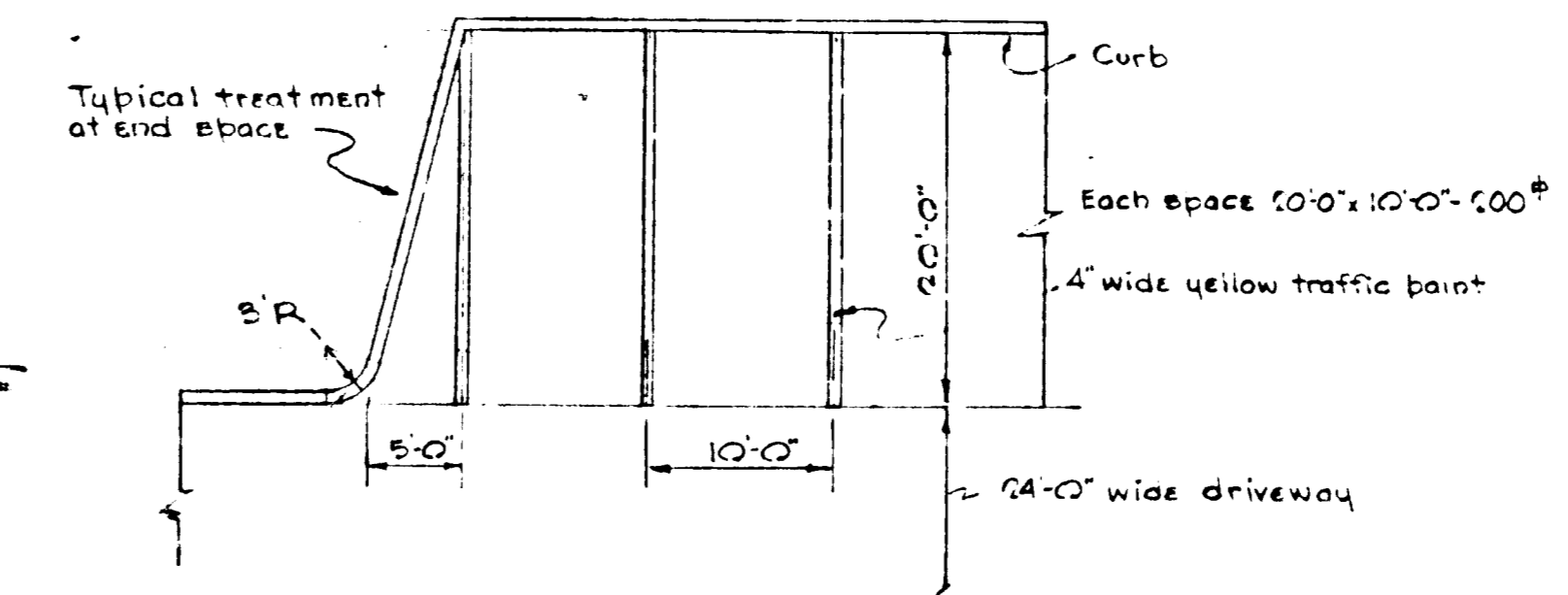
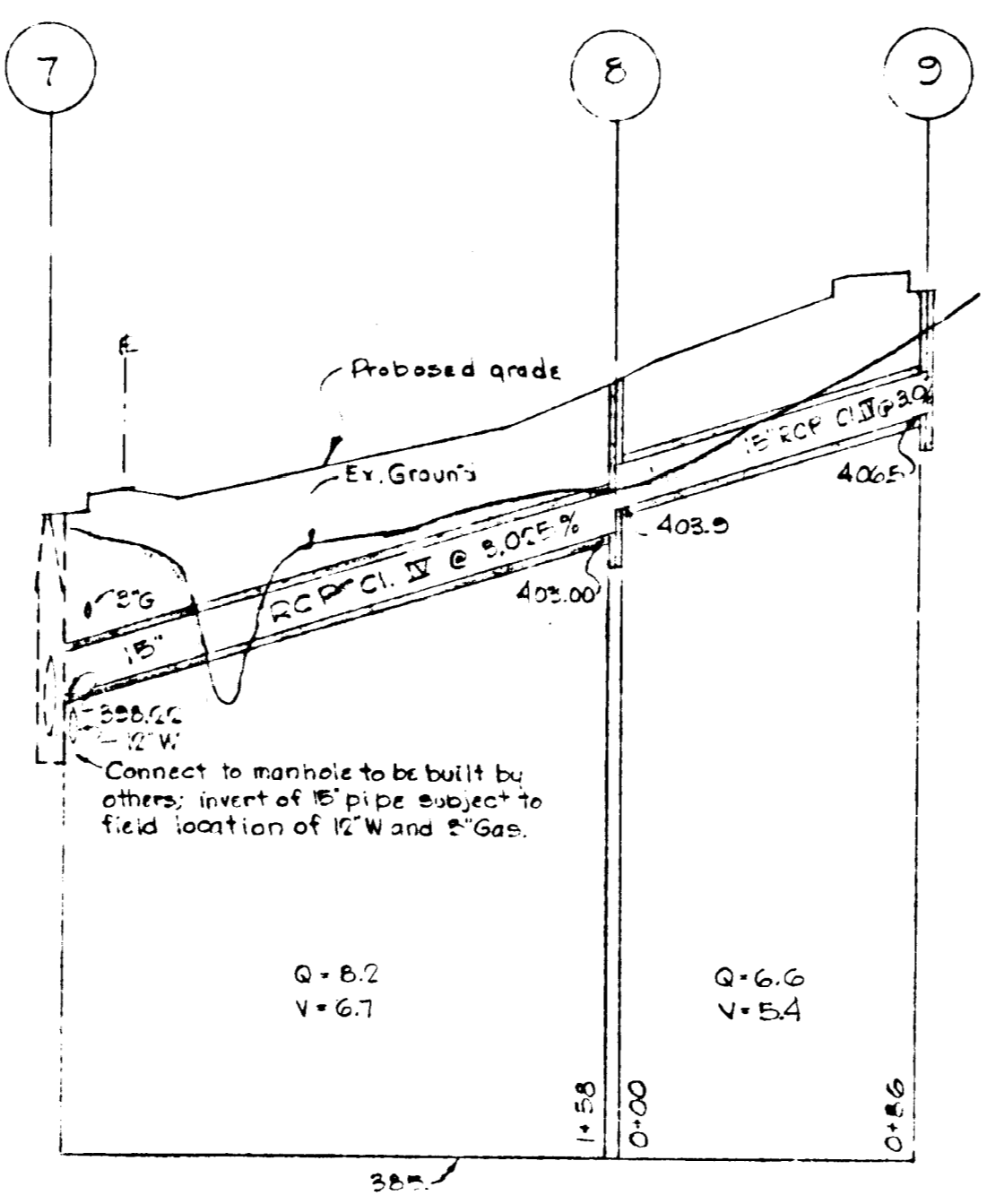

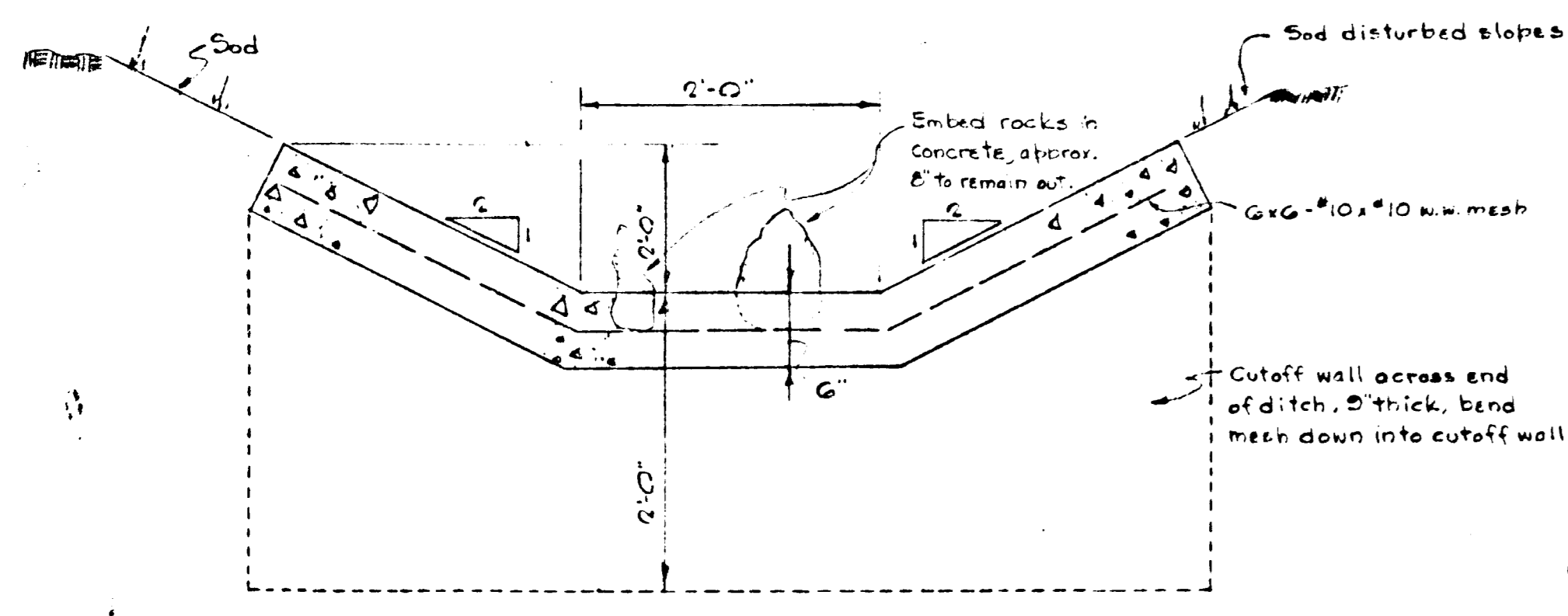


STORM DRAIN PROFILES

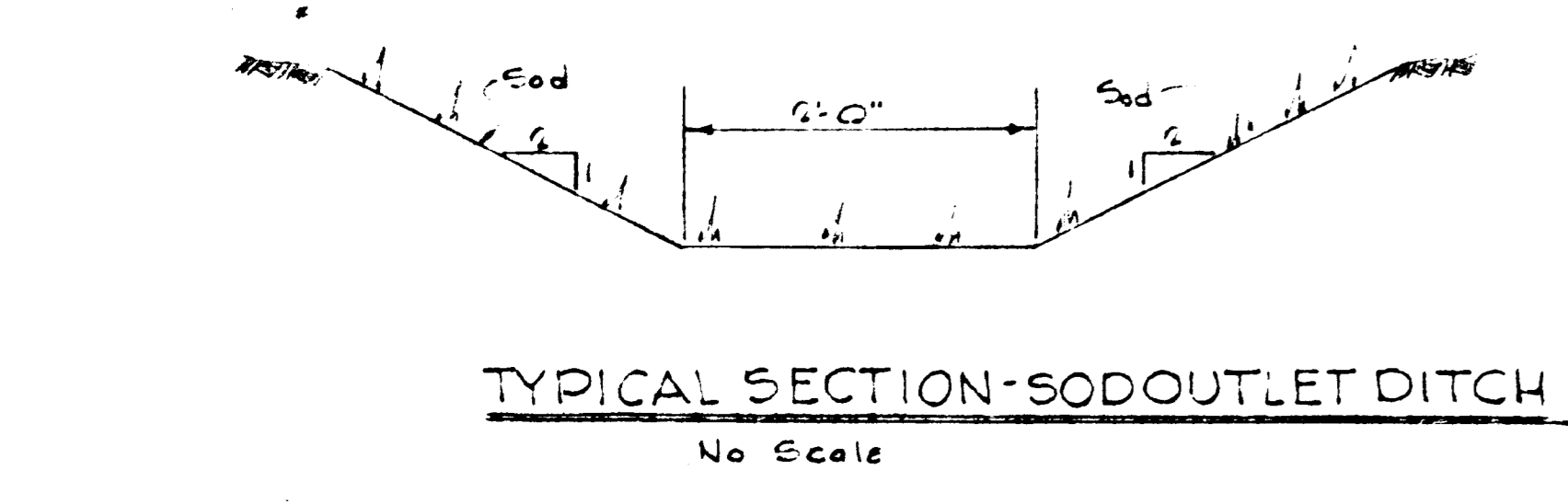

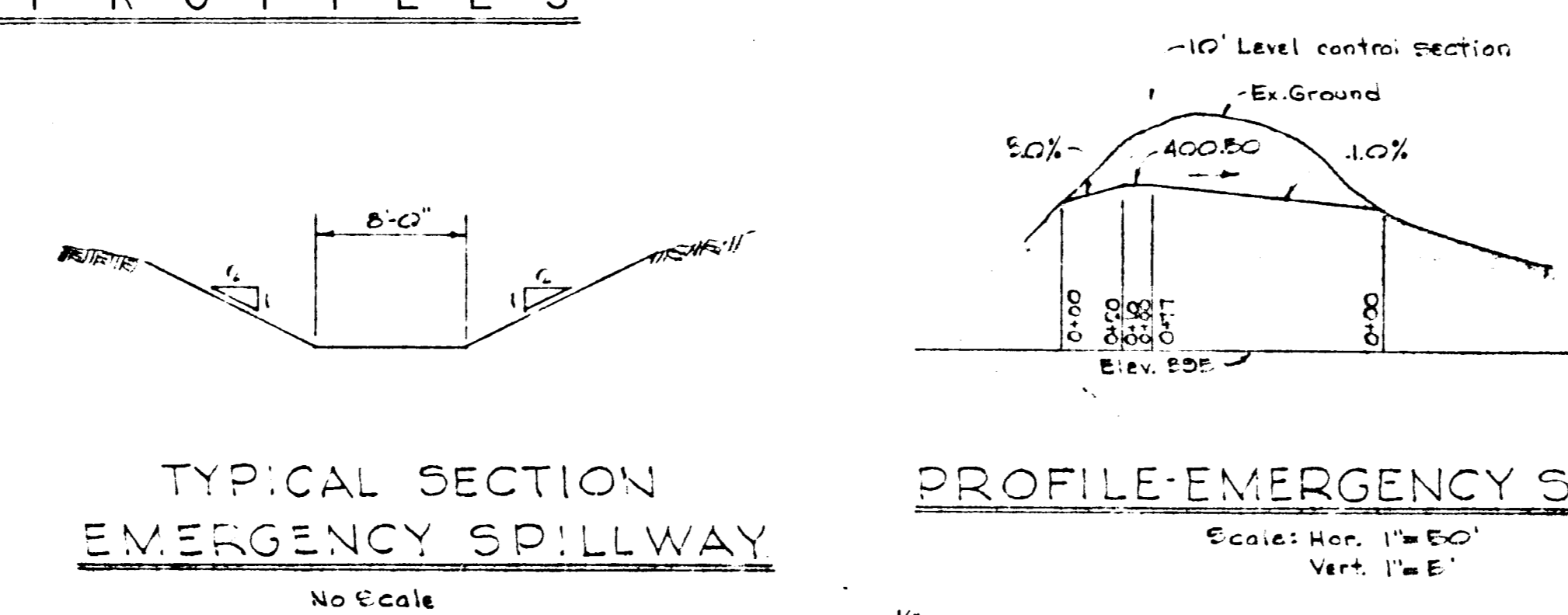
TYPICAL PARKING SPACE



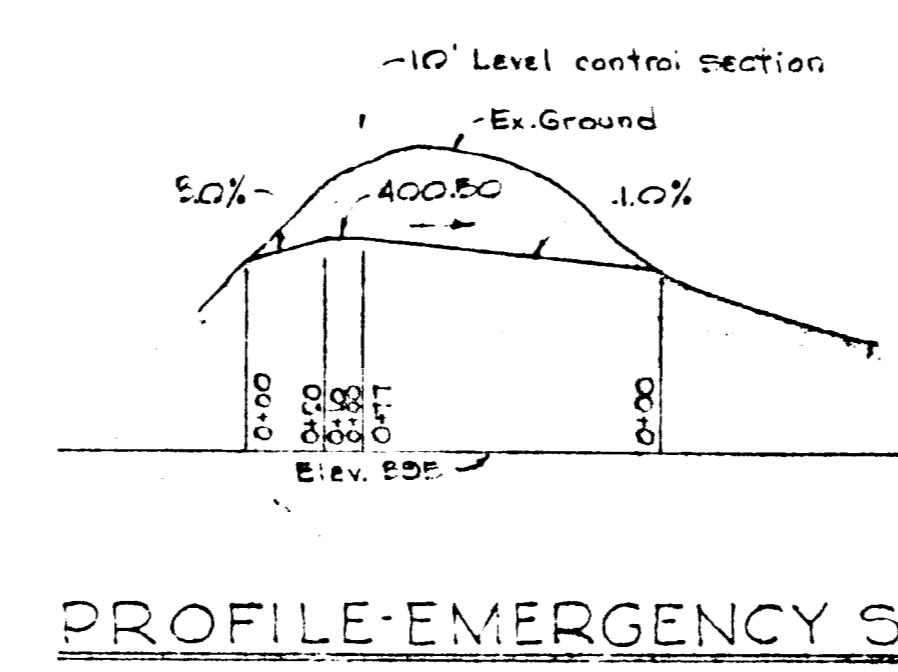
TYPICAL SECTION-CONCRETE OUTLET DITCH

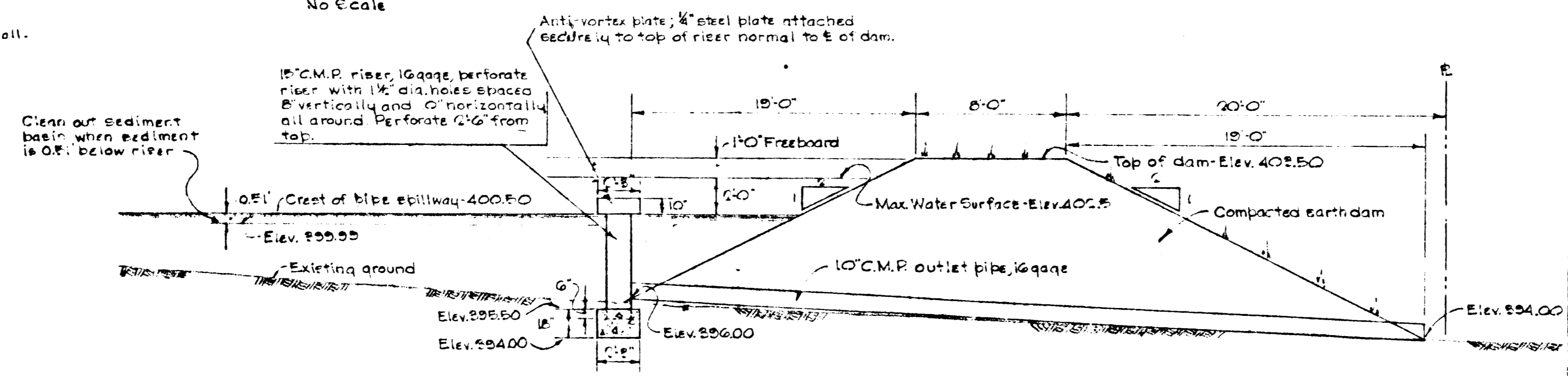
TYPICAL SECTION-SOD OUTLET DITCH

The use of frozen material will not be permitted. The constructed embankment shall be raised to an elevation which provides for anticipated settlement to design elevations.
- Placement** - Areas on which fill is to be placed shall be certified prior to placement of fill. Fill materials shall be placed in 6" maximum lifts which are to be continuous over the entire length of the fill.
- Compaction** - The movement of the hauling and spreading equipment over the fill shall be controlled so that the entire surface of each lift will be traversed by not less than one track of the equipment or compaction shall be achieved through use of a roller.
- Pipe Spillway Installation** - The riser shall be rigidly and securely fastened to the barrel and the bottom of the riser shall be sealed watertight. All pipe joints shall be securely fastened and watertight.
- Emergency Spillway Installation** - Emergency spillways must be installed on undisturbed soil (cut or fill) by grading. The slope shall not be steeper than 2:1.

 - Fertilizer - Apply 400 pounds of triple superphosphate (45% or the equivalent) top dress this into the top 3" of seeded and apply 1000 lbs per acre of 10-0-00 fertilizer or the equivalent.
 - Time of seeding to be immediately after final grading.
- Sediment Control** - Sediment control basin and diversion berm are to be constructed before any other grading. Graded areas that are not to be covered with paving or final sodding or seeding right away shall be temporarily seeded with the above seeding specification.

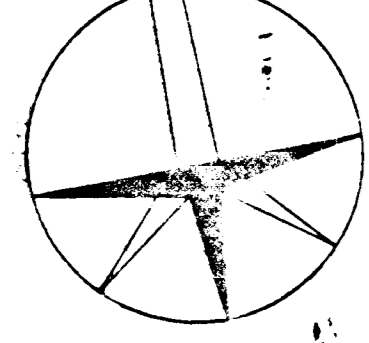
