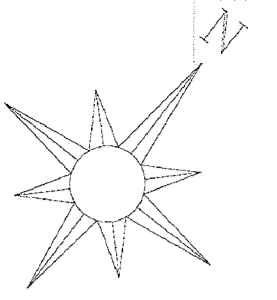

parking lot to remain usable for daycare facility while construction is underway.

Splash Pad to replace existing in-ground wading pool.

Existing concrete pool is 695 F² of water area inside of 2392 F² of concrete patio.

ADA accessible grades for all new areas within the splash pad.

10' Proposed replacement splash pad has no standing water inside of 2051 F² of concrete patio (impervious reduced). Pre-formed splash pad (Water Journeys) manufactured by Vortex Aquatics is to be installed on frost depth footers (18"Ø).

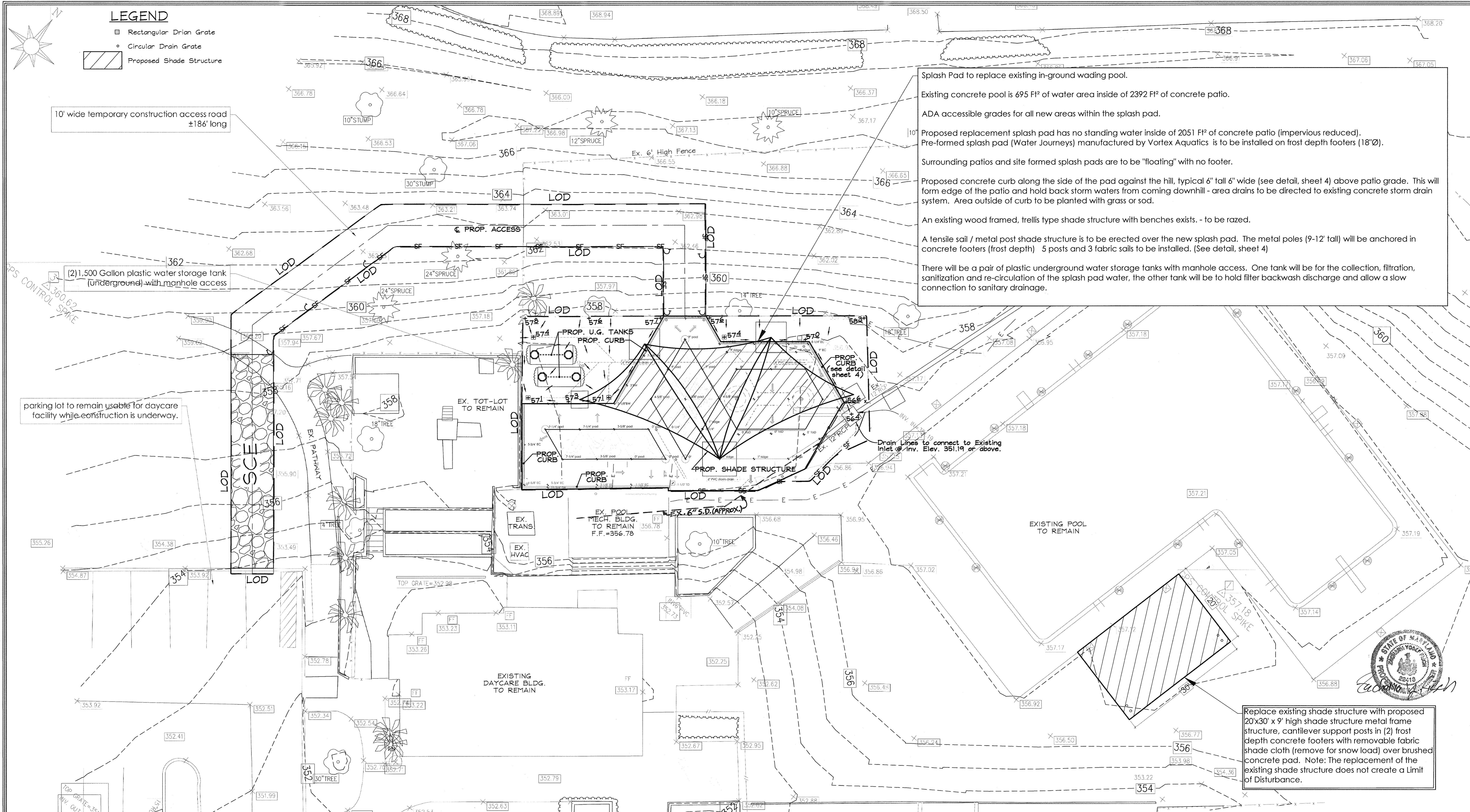
Surrounding patios and site formed splash pads are to be "floating" with no footer.

Proposed concrete curb along the side of the pad against the hill, typical 6" tall 6" wide (see detail, sheet 4) above patio grade. This will form edge of the patio and hold back storm waters from coming downhill - area drains to be directed to existing concrete storm drain system. Area outside of curb to be planted with grass or sod.

An existing wood framed, trellis type shade structure with benches exists. - to be razed.

A tensile sail / metal post shade structure is to be erected over the new splash pad. The metal poles (9-12' tall) will be anchored in concrete footers (frost depth) 5 posts and 3 fabric sails to be installed. (See detail, sheet 4)

There will be a pair of plastic underground water storage tanks with manhole access. One tank will be for the collection, filtration, sanitization and re-circulation of the splash pad water, the other tank will be to hold filter backwash discharge and allow a slow connection to sanitary drainage.



Drain Lines to connect to Existing Inlet @ Inv. Elev. 351.19 or above.

Replace existing shade structure with proposed 20'x30' x 9' high shade structure metal frame structure, cantilever support posts in (2) frost depth concrete footers with removable fabric shade cloth (remove for snow load) over brushed concrete pad. Note: The replacement of the existing shade structure does not create a Limit of Disturbance.

PLANNING BOARD REVIEW:
This addition was not reviewed by the Planning Board because it is a minor structure, under Section 125.0.G.3.b.

LIMITS OF DISTURBANCE:
The limits of disturbance area is 4,999 square feet, and is exempt from Storm-water management requirements. Any future disturbance where the total exceeds 5,000 s.f., SWM will need to be addressed.

B-3 STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS

SOIL PREPARATION, TOPSOILING, AND SOIL AMENDMENTS
Definition
Purpose
Conditions Where Practice Applies

The process of preparing the soils to sustain adequate vegetative stabilization.
To provide a suitable soil medium for vegetative growth.

Criteria
Where vegetative stabilization is to be established.

A. Soil Preparation
1. Temporary Stabilization

- a. Seeded preparation consists of loosening soil to a depth of 3 to 5 inches by means of suitable agricultural or construction equipment...

- b. Apply fertilizer and lime as prescribed on the plans.

- 2. Permanent Stabilization

- a. A soil test is required for any earth disturbance of 5 acres or more.

- iv. Soil contains sufficient pore space to permit adequate root penetration.

- 3. Graded areas must be maintained in a true and even grade as specified on the approved plan...

- 4. Mix soil amendments into the top 3 to 5 inches of soil by disking or other suitable means.

- B. Topsoiling

- 1. Topsoil to be placed over prepared subsoil prior to establishment of permanent vegetation.

- 2. Topsoil salvaged from an existing site may be used provided it meets the standards as set forth in these specifications.

- 3. Topsoiling is limited to areas having 2:1 or flatter slopes where:

- a. The texture of the exposed subsoil/parent material is not adequate to produce vegetative growth.

- b. The soil material is so shallow that the rooting zone is not deep enough to support plants or furnish continuing supplies of moisture and plant nutrients.

- c. The original soil to be vegetated contains material toxic to plant growth.

- d. The soil is so acidic that treatment with limestone is not feasible.

- 4. Areas having slopes steeper than 2:1 require special consolidation and design.

- 5. Topsoil Specifications: Soil to be used as topsoil must meet the following criteria:

- a. Topsoil must be a loam, sandy loam, clay loam, silt loam, sandy clay loam, or loamy sand.

- b. Topsoil must be free of noxious plants or plant parts such as thistles, grasses, weeds, and other plants.

- c. Topsoil substitutes or amendments, as recommended by a qualified agronomist or soil scientist and approved by the appropriate approval authority, may be used in lieu of natural topsoil.

- 6. Topsoil Application

- a. Erosion and sediment control practices must be maintained when applying topsoil.

- b. Uniformly distribute topsoil in a 2 to 4 inch layer and lightly compact to a minimum thickness of 1/2 inch.

- c. Topsoil must not be placed if the operation or subsoil is in a frozen or muddy condition, when the subsoil is excessively wet or in a condition that may otherwise be detrimental to proper grading and seeded preparation.

- C. Soil Amendments (Fertilizer and Lime Specifications)

- 1. Soil tests must be performed to determine the exact rates and application rates for both lime and fertilizer on sites having disturbed areas of 5 acres or more.

- 2. Fertilizers must be uniform in composition, free flowing and suitable for accurate application by appropriate equipment.

- 3. Lime materials must be ground limestone (hydrated or burnt lime may be substituted except when hydroxylic) which contains at least 90 percent total oxidium (calcium oxide plus magnesium oxide).

- 4. Lime and fertilizer are to be evenly distributed and incorporated into the top 3 to 5 inches of soil by disking or other suitable means.

- 5. Where the subsoil is either highly acidic or composed of heavy clays, spread ground limestone at the rate of 4 to 8 tons/acre (200-400 pounds per 1,000 square feet) prior to the placement of topsoil.

B-4 STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS

SEEDING AND MULCHING
Definition
Purpose
Conditions Where Practice Applies

The application of seed and mulch to establish vegetative cover.
To protect disturbed soils from erosion during and at the end of construction.

Criteria
To the surface of all perimeter controls, slopes, and any disturbed area not under active grading.

A. Seeding

- 1. Specifications

- a. All seed must meet the requirements of the Maryland State Seed Law.

- b. Mulch alone may be applied between the fall and spring seeding dates only if the ground is frozen.

- c. Inoculants: The inoculant for treating legume seed in the seed mixture must be a pure culture of nitrogen fixing bacteria prepared specifically for the species.

- d. Soil or seed must not be placed on soil which has been treated with soil sterilants or chemicals used for weed control until sufficient time has elapsed (14 days min) to permit dissipation of phytotoxic materials.

- 2. Application

- i. Incorporate seed into the subsoil at the rates prescribed on Temporary Seeding Table B.1.

- ii. Apply seed in two directions, perpendicular to each other.

- iii. Hydro-seeding: Apply seed uniformly with hydro-seeder (slurry includes seed and fertilizer).

- iv. If fertilizer is being applied at the time of seeding, the application rates should not exceed the following: Nitrogen, 200 pounds per acre; Phosphorus, 200 pounds per acre; Potassium, 200 pounds per acre.

- v. Mix seed and fertilizer on site and seed immediately and without interruption.

- vi. When hydro-seeding do not incorporate seed into the soil.

- B. Mulching

- 1. Mulch Materials (in order of preference)

- a. Straw consisting of thoroughly threshed wheat, rye, oat, or barley and reasonably bright in color.

- b. Wood Cellulose Fiber Mulch (WCFFM) consisting of specially prepared wood cellulose processed into a uniform fibrous physical state.

- c. WCFFM is to be dyed green or contain a green dye in the package that will provide an appropriate color to facilitate visual inspection of the uniformly spread slurry.

- d. WCFFM including dye, must contain no germination or growth inhibiting factors.

- e. WCFFM materials are to be manufactured and processed in such a manner that the wood cellulose fiber mulch will remain in uniform suspension in water under agitation and will blend with seed, fertilizer and other additives to form a homogeneous slurry.

- f. WCFFM material must conform to the following physical requirements: fiber length of approximately 10 millimeters, diameter approximately 1 millimeter, pH range of 4.0 to 8.5, and contain a percent maximum water holding capacity of 90 percent minimum.

- 2. Application

- a. Apply mulch to all seeded areas immediately after seeding.

- b. When straw mulch is used, spread 10 over all seeded areas at the rate of 2 tons per acre to a uniform loose depth of 1 to 2 inches.

- c. Wood cellulose fiber used as mulch must be applied at a net dry weight of 1500 pounds per acre. Mix the wood cellulose fiber with water to attain a mixture with a maximum of 50 pounds of wood cellulose fiber per 100 gallons of water.

- 3. Anchoring

- a. Perform mulch anchoring immediately following application of mulch to minimize loss by wind or water.

- b. A mulch anchoring tool is a tractor drawn implement designed to punch and anchor mulch into the soil surface to a minimum of 2 inches.

- c. Wood cellulose fiber may be used for anchoring straw.

- d. Synthetic binders such as Acrylic DLR (Ago-Tack), DCA-70, Permatex, T-11, Terra Tack, AK or other approved equal may be used.

- e. Lightweight plastic netting may be applied over the mulch according to manufacturer's recommendations.

- f. Netting is usually available in rolls 4 to 15 feet wide and 300 to 3,000 feet long.

Controlling the dispersion of dust particles from construction activities.

To prevent blowing and movement of dust from exposed soil surfaces to reduce on- and off-site damage including dust and noise hazards.

- 1. Mulches: See Section B-4-3 Soil Preparation, Topsoiling, and Soil Amendments, Section B-4-3 Seeding and Mulching, and Section B-4-4 Temporary Stabilization.

- 2. Yoniflour Cover: See Section B-4-4 Temporary Stabilization.

- 3. Tillage: Till to roughen surface and bring clods to the surface.

- 4. Barriers: Solid board fences, six foot, snow fences, torii fences, straw bales, and similar materials can be used to control air currents and soil blowing.

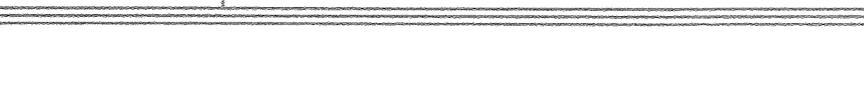
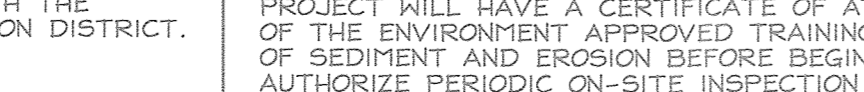
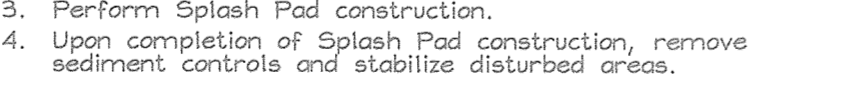
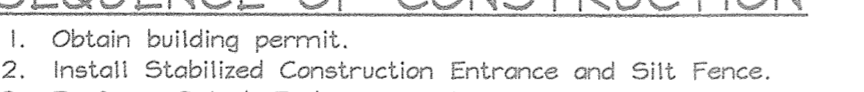
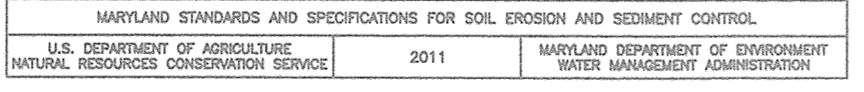
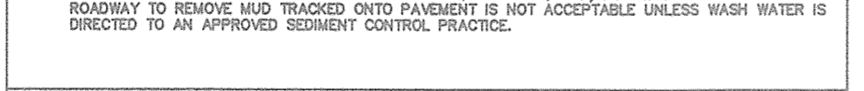
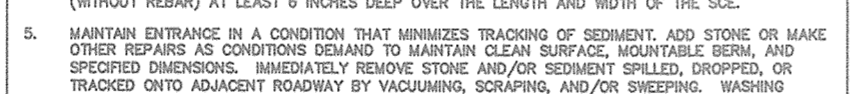
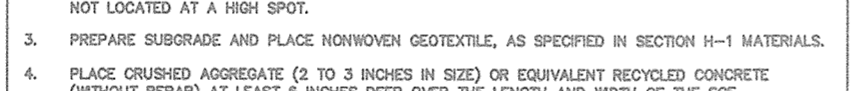
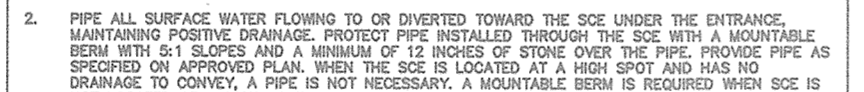
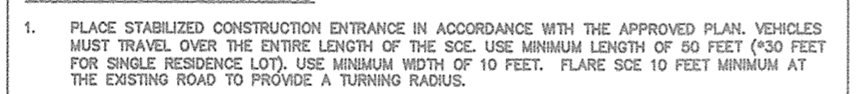
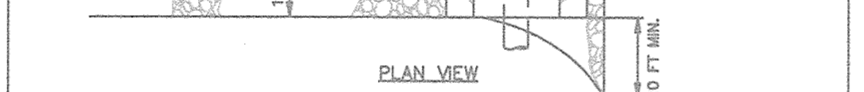
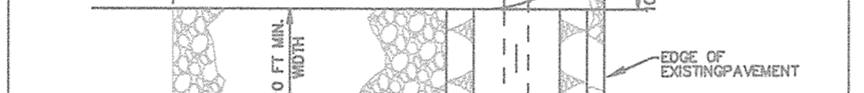
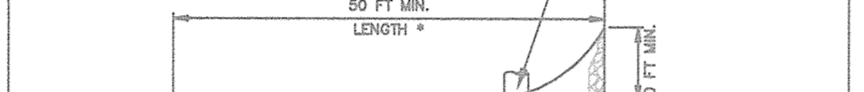
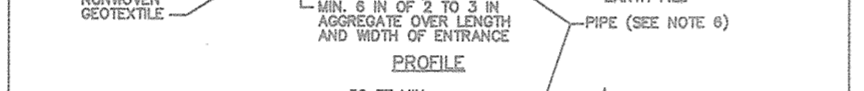
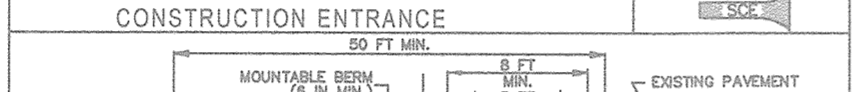
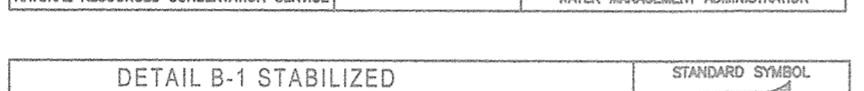
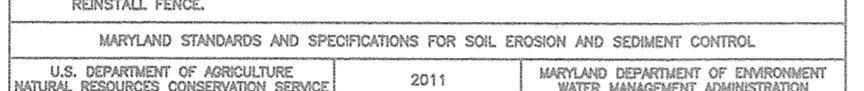
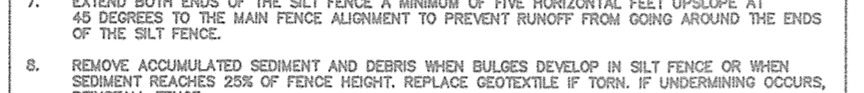
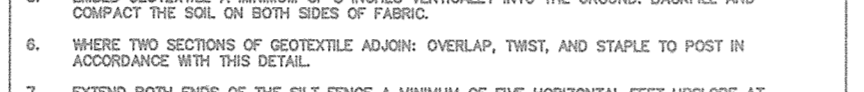
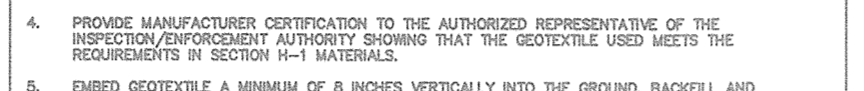
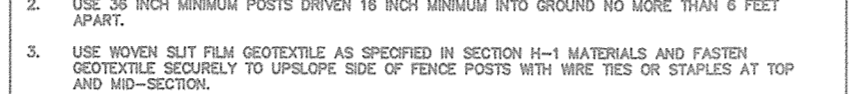
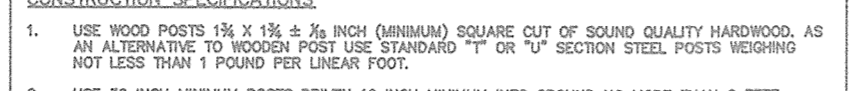
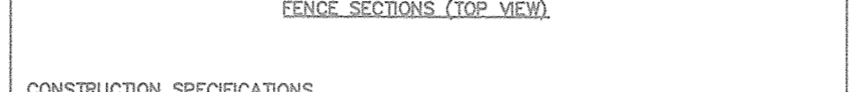
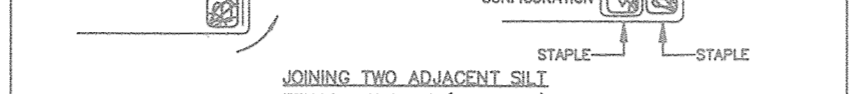
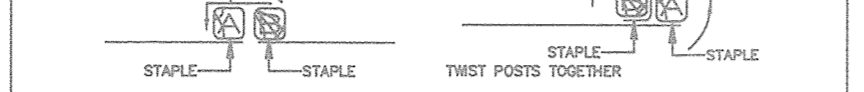
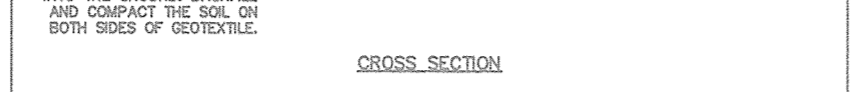
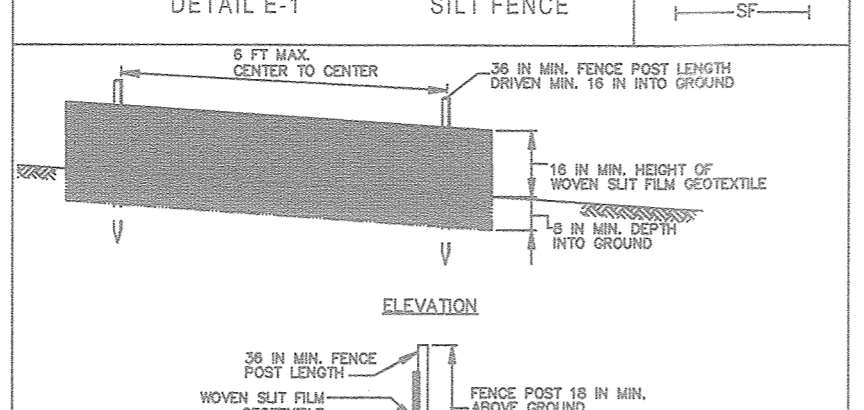

- 2. PROVIDE MANUFACTURER CERTIFICATION TO THE AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF THE INSPECTION AUTHORITY SHOWING THAT THE GEOTEXTILE MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS IN SECTION H-1 MATERIALS.
