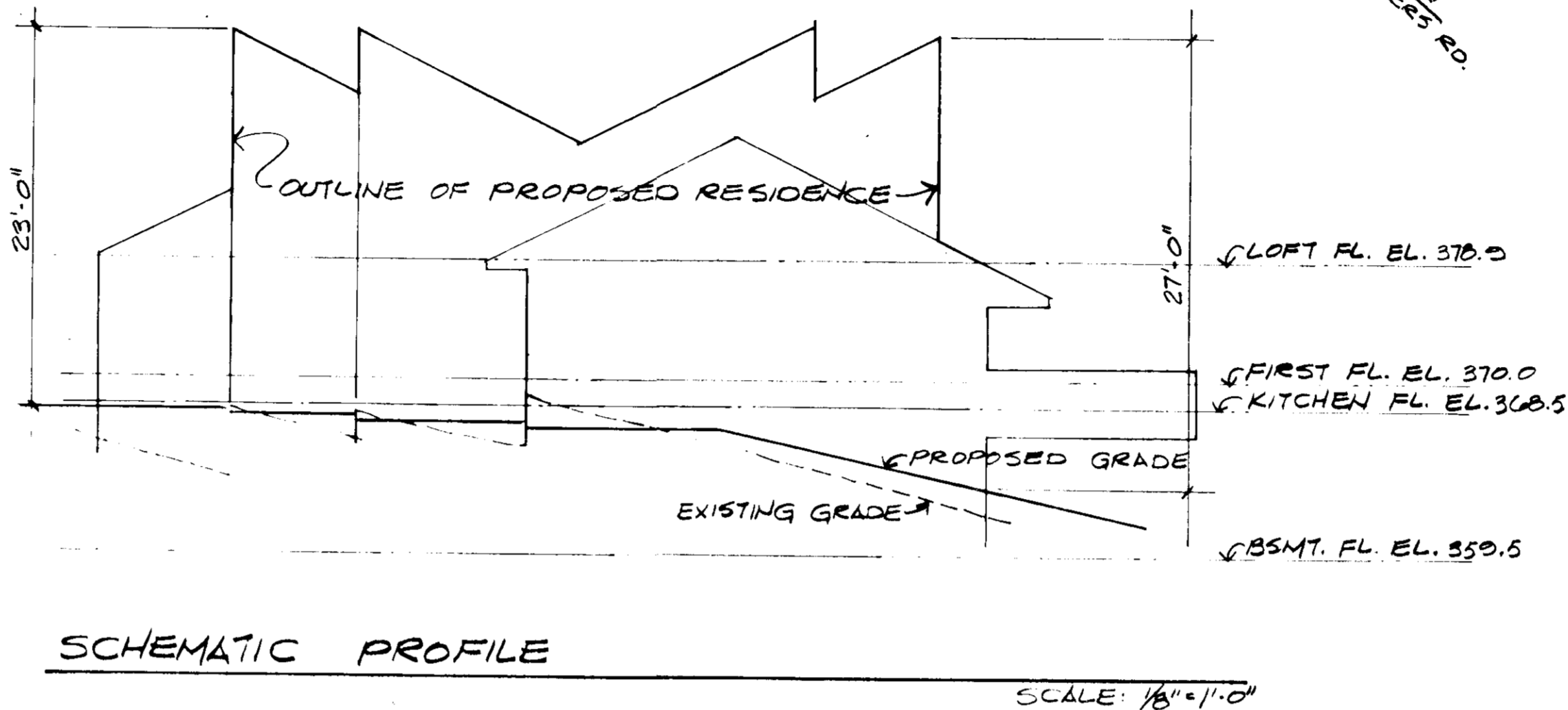
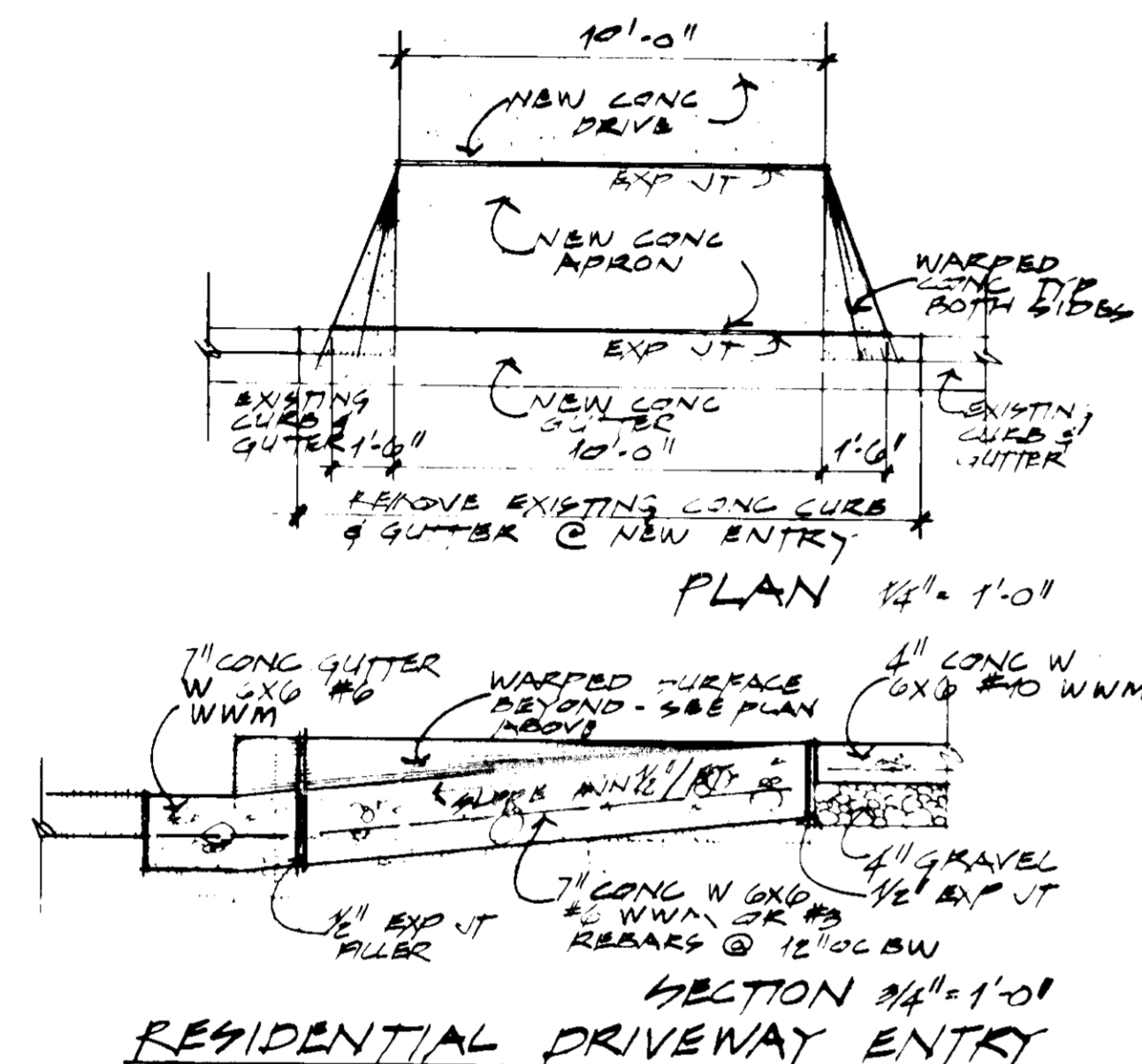


ENTRANCE NOTES:

1. STABILIZED CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCE SHALL BE MIN. 20'-0" LONG, 15'-0" WIDE AND 6" DEEP.
2. STONE SIZE SHALL BE M.S.H.A. NO. 2 (2 1/2"-1") OR AASH TO DESIGNATION M43 SIZE NO. 2 (2 1/2" TO 1 1/2"). USE CRUSHED STONE.
3. ENTRANCE SHALL BE REPAIRED OR TOP DRESSED PERIODICALLY AS REQUIRED.

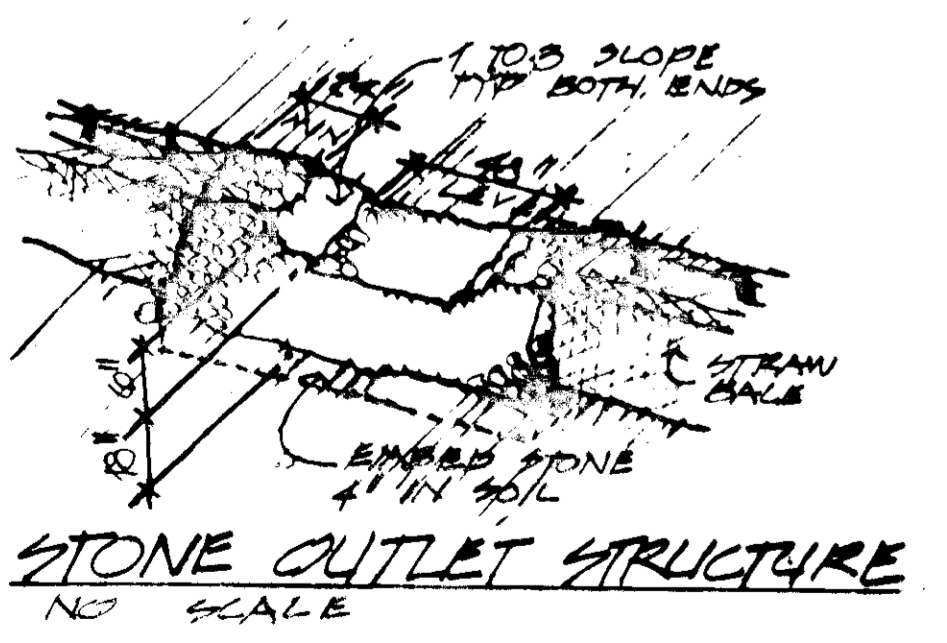

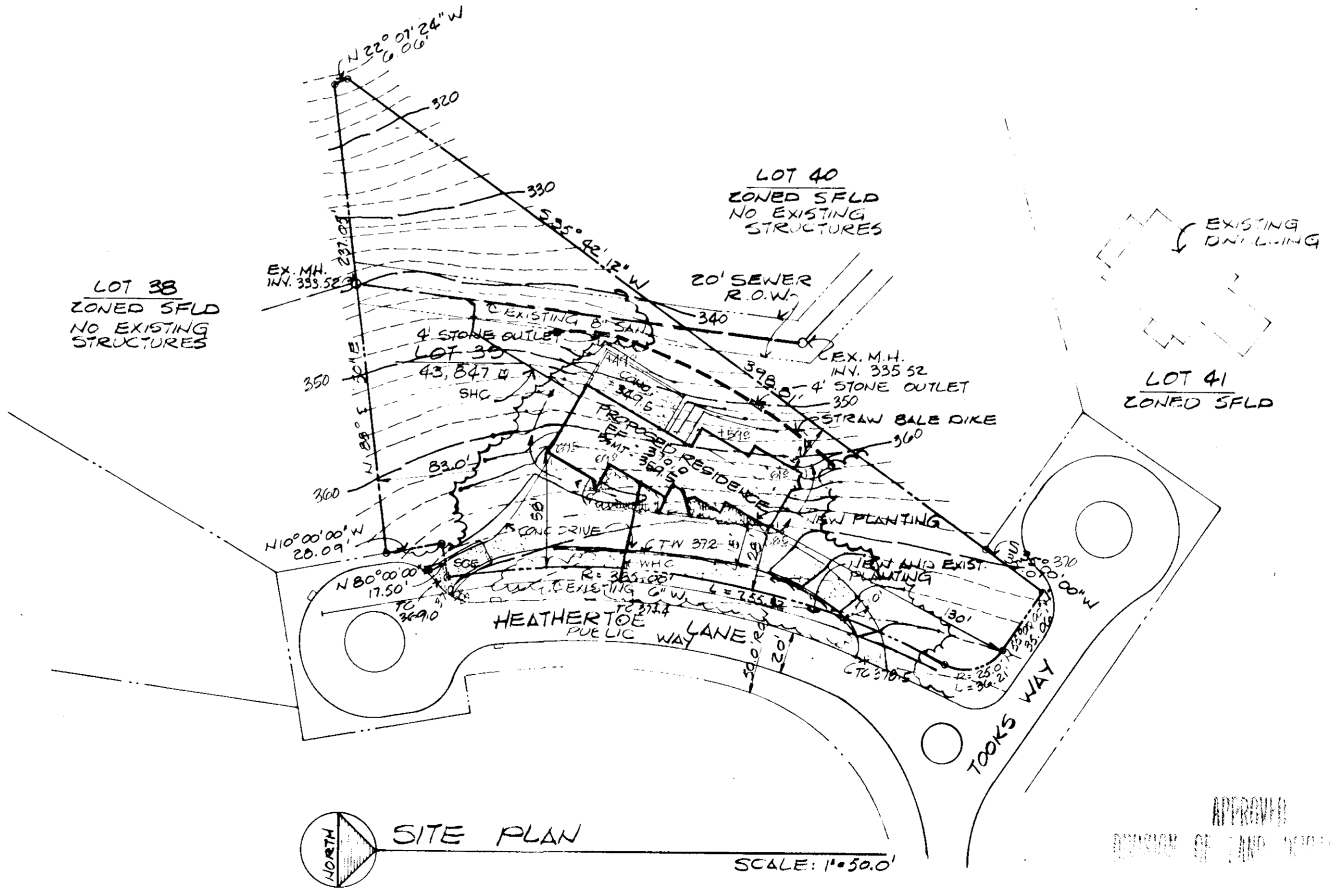
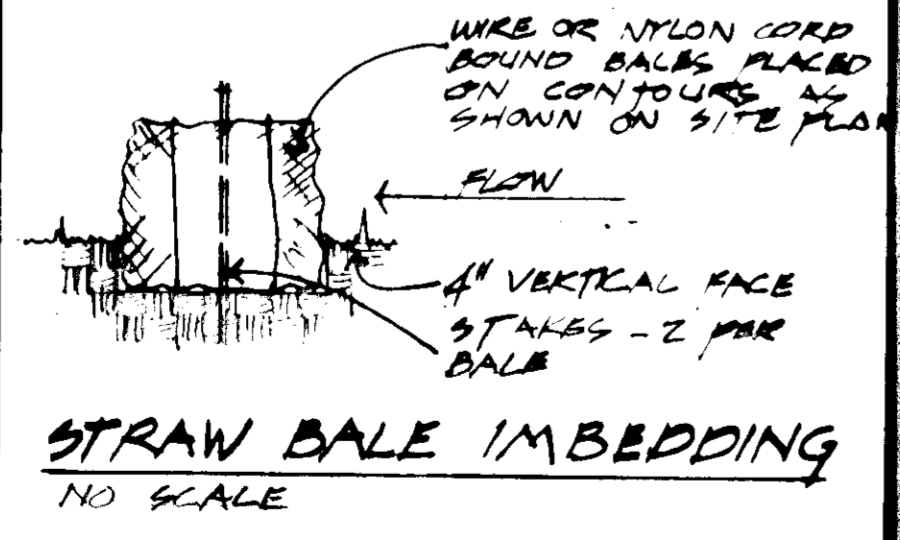
STONE OUTLET NOTES

1. STONE SHALL BE CRUSHED STONE OR GRAVEL. STONE SHALL MEET MSHA SIZE #2 OR AASH TO DESIGNATION M43 SIZE #2 OR 24.
2. CREST OF DIKE SHALL BE MIN 6" LOWER THAN TOP OF PAV AND SHALL BE LEVEL.
3. DIKE TO BE A MIN OF 24" WIDE ACROSS TOP.
4. EMBED STRUCTURE MIN 4" INTO SOIL.
5. STONE OUTLET STRUCTURE SHALL BE INSPECTED PERIODICALLY AND REPLACED IF SILTED UP.



STRAW BALE DIKE NOTES

1. BALES SHALL BE PLACED IN A ROW WITH ENDS TIGHTLY BUTTED.
2. EACH BALE SHALL BE EMBEDDED IN SOIL A MIN OF 4" - SEE DET. BELOW.
3. SECURELY ANCHOR BALES IN PLACE BY WOOD STAKES OR REBARS DRIVEN THROUGH BALES. THE FIRST STAKE IN EACH BALE SHALL BE ANGLED TOWARD PREVIOUSLY LAID BALE TO FORCE BALES TOGETHER.
4. INSPECT DIKE PERIODICALLY FOR DAMAGE, AND REPAIR OR REPLACE BALES AS NEEDED.
5. REMOVE DIKE COMPLETELY UPON COMPLETION OF THE WORK.
