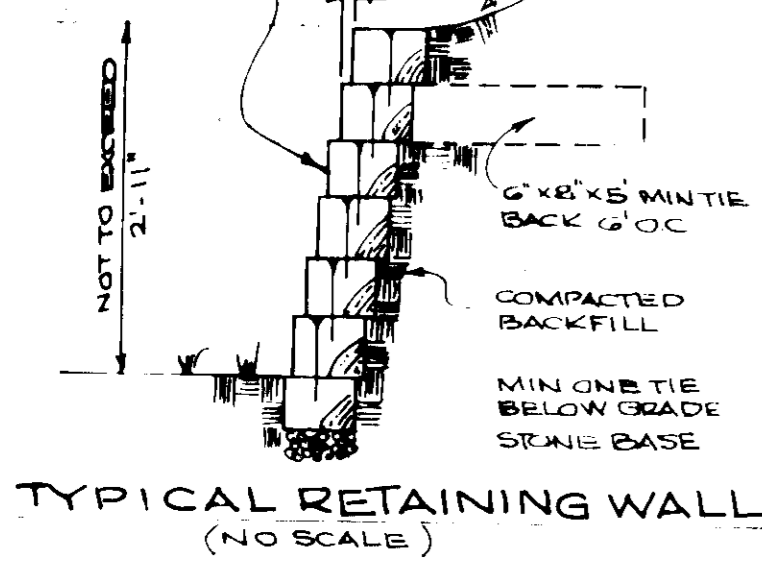


G.P. TREATED TIMBERS (R.P.T.) TIED TOGETHER WITH 4 DEBRIS 16" LONG 2" OC

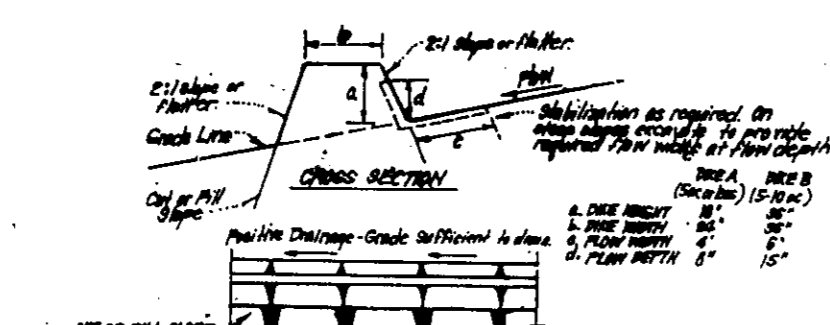

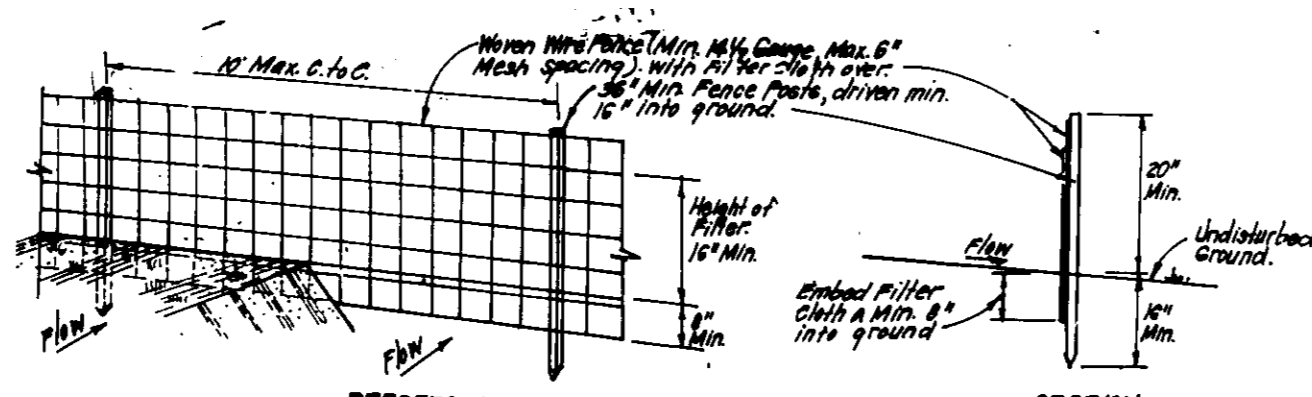

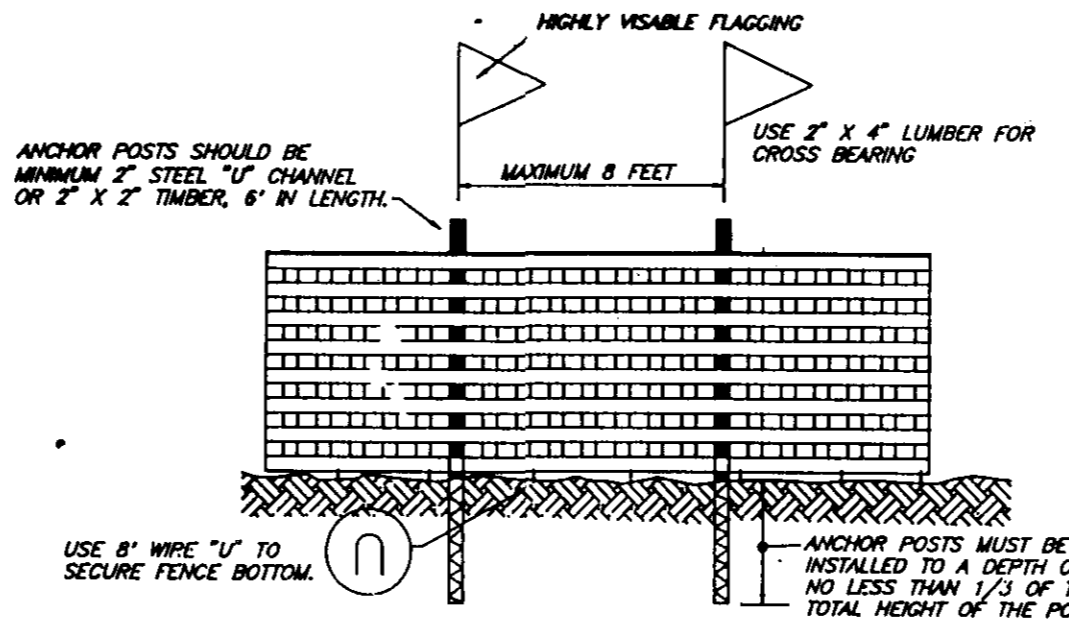
