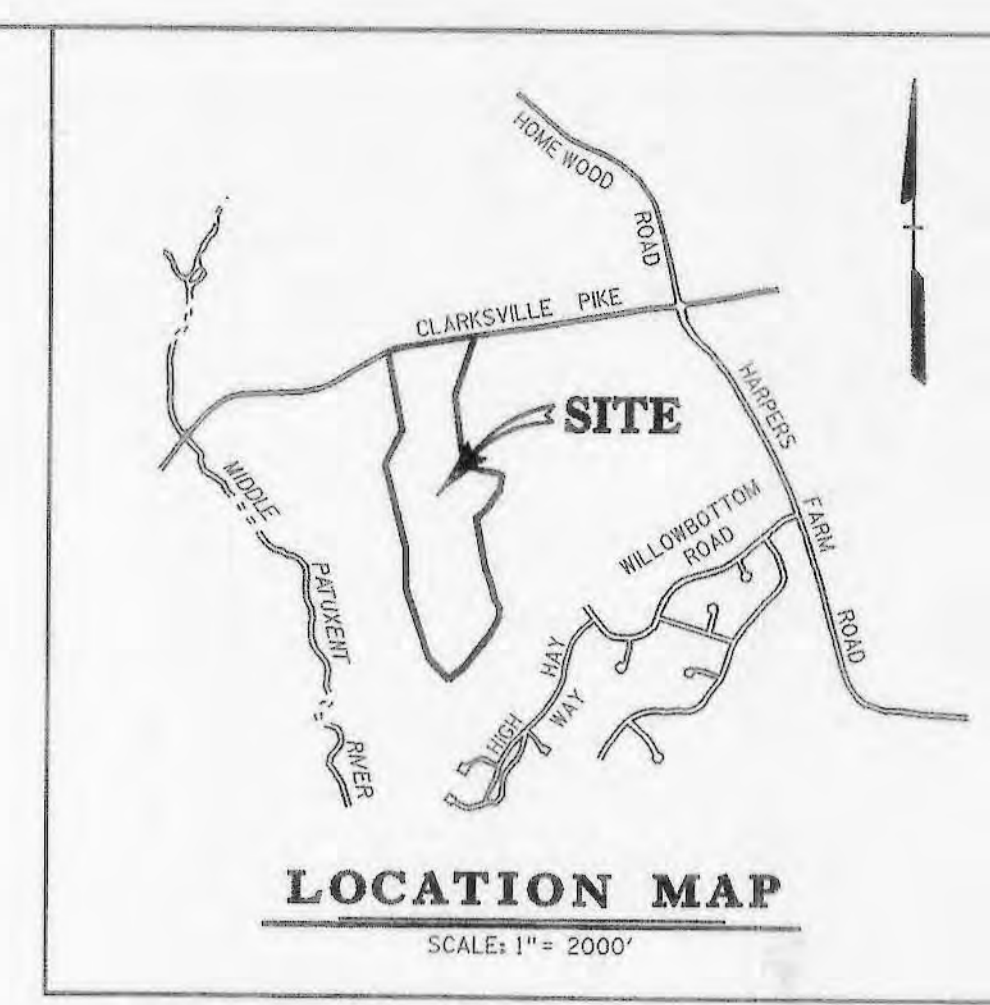


**CLARKSVILLE PIKE MD. RTE. 108**

**VEGETATIVE ANALYSIS CHART**

TYPE	COVERAGE	ANALYSIS
EASTERN RED CEDAR (JUNIPERUS VIRGINIANA)	3%	3" TO 8" CALIPER AND ARE MOSTLY IN THE OLD FENCE ROWS AND TREE LINES.
ARORVITAE (THUJA OCCIDENTALIS)	1%	10" TO 15" CALIPER AND A FEW ARE SCATTERED AMONGST THE RED CEDARS IN THE NORTH AREA OF THE SITE.
BLACK CHERRY (PRUNUS SEROTINA)	10%	2" TO 24" CALIPER AND OCCUR THROUGHOUT ALL THE WOODED AREAS (SOUTH AREA BELOW GAS LINE R/W AND TREE LINES.
WHITE POPLAR (POPULUS ALBA)	18%	2" TO 24" CALIPER AND OCCUR THROUGHOUT ALL THE WOODED AREAS (SOUTH AREA BELOW GAS LINE R/W AND TREE LINES.
VIRGINIA PINE (PINUS VIRGINIANA)	20%	1" TO 10" CALIPER AND OCCUR MOSTLY IN WOODED AREA FROM GAS LINE R/W SOUTH TO OLD TRAIL AND ARE DOMINANT SOUTH OF OLD TRAIL AREA.
TULIP TREE (LIRIODENDRON TULIPIFERA)	5%	5" TO 10" CALIPER AND OCCUR THROUGHOUT ALL WOODED AREAS AND ARE NORTH AND SOUTH OF THE GAS LINE R/W.
BLACK OAK (QUERCUS VELUTINA)	2%	20" TO 30" CALIPER SCATTERED THROUGHOUT WOODED AREAS.
PIN OAK (QUERCUS PALustris)	5%	20" TO 22" CALIPER MOSTLY ON NORTH SIDE ADJACENT TO THE GAS LINE R/W.
AMERICAN HORN BEAM (CARPINUS CAROLINIANA)	1%	2" TO 4" CALIPER OCCURRING ONLY ALONG STREAM VALLEY SOUTH OF THE GAS LINE R/W.

THE NORTH AREA OF THE SITE FROM THE GAS LINE R/W TO MD. RTE. 108 IS GENERALLY CLEARED WITH A FEW OLD TREE LINES AND FENCE ROWS. A FEW PATCHES OF CEDAR TREES AND SEVERAL SPECIMEN TREES AS SHOWN ON THIS PLAN. THE AREA WITHIN LOTS 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 22, 23, AND 24 IS A SECOND GROWTH WOODS CONSISTING MOSTLY OF VIRGINIA PINES AND POPLARS. FROM THE WETLANDS AREA SOUTH TO THE OLD TRAIL IS MOSTLY POPLARS, CHERRY, PINES, AND A FEW OAKS THAT RANGE FROM 10" TO 15" CALIPER. BELOW, OR SOUTH OF THE OLD TRAIL IS VIRGINIA PINES AND SOME MATURE OAKS AND POPLARS.
